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Fabric Requirements

Fabric A ½ yd 8245-88 Red Words & Stars (includes binding)
Fabric B ½ yd 8249-77 Blue Stars & Circles
Fabric C ½ yd 8250-44 Cream Star Flower Toss

<u>I fat quarter of the following</u>

8247-66 Green Stripe 8248-55 Brown Star Wreath 8249-66 Green Stars & Circles 8068-62 Star Flower Basics <u>1/8 yd of the following:</u> 8245-44, T1 Words & Stars 8246-35, 55, T1 Swirly Stars 8247-35, T1 Stripe

8068-33, 46, 87 Star Flower Basics

1 ¼ yd Backing

Also needed: light weight fusible for appliqué Recommended: ½" bias bars for stems

Note: Seam allowance is 1/4". WOF=width of fabric. Please read through the instuctions before beginning the project.

- Cutting Requirements Fabric A Red Words & Stars (4) 2 ½" × WOF strips, pieced together end to end for binding Fabric B Blue Stars & Circles (1) 2 ½" × 25 ½" (2) 2 ½" × 20 ½" (1) 2 ½" × 15 ½" (2) 2 ½" × 3 ½" Fabric C Cream Star Flower Toss
- (1) 16 ½" × 16 ½" square for appliqué background

Appliqué (basic appliqué skills are required)

- 1. Transfer appliqué shapes to template plastic.
- Follow manufacturer's instructions for fusible webbing. If you are using the needle-turn method, add a seam allowance to the shapes.
- 3. Trace (5) center pieces from assorted gold fabrics.
- 4. Trace (25) petal shapes from assorted red fabrics.

- Trace Basket body & handle shapes onto 8248-55 Brown Star Wreath.
- 6. Trace star on Blue Star Wreath.
- Assorted green fabric: trace four leaf shapes and five 1 ½" x about 18" bias strips for stems*. Use your preferred method to make bias stems. *½" bias bars are recommended.
- 8. Arrange the appliqué pieces on the Cream Star Flower Toss background. Fuse or stitch into place.
- 9. Trim the background to 15 1/2" x 15 1/2".

Pieced Blocks and Pieced Border

From the remainder of your assorted fabrics cut: <u>For Blocks:</u> Cut a total of:

- (11) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares gold for block centers
- (44) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles
- (44) 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares for HST

<u>Pieced Border</u>

(2) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares


(35) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles for pieced border

Block Construction

- Pair two contrasting 2 7/8" × 2 7/8" squares. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of one square. Place the squares right sides together and stitch '4" from each side of the drawn line.
- 2. Cut apart on the line. Press. This will give you (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ HST units. Make (4).




Arrange the block pieces as shown and stitch together.
Use the assorted 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles and 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" gold squares. These blocks are completely scrappy, so feel free to put the fabrics in any combination that is pleasing to you.




Make (11) blocks. They measure 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" unfinished.

Quilt Top Assembly


1. Sew three blocks together and join to the top of the appliqué block.



- 2. Sew four blocks together and join to the left side of the appliqué block.
- Sew (10) assorted 2 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles into a strip.
 Sew a 2 ½" x 20 ½" Blue Stars & Circles border strip to one side of the pieced strips. Make (3).




4. Sew to one to each side of the quilt top as shown: (



5. Sew a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ Blue Stars & Circles rectangle to an assorted 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ squares. Make (2) end units $3\frac{1}{2}$ x $3\frac{1}{2}$



Use the contract of the end units to one end of the remaining (10) unit pieced strip.




- 7. Add a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Blue Stars & Circles strip to this unit. Note placement of end unit.
- 8. Now, sew one of the remaining blocks to the other end of the strip. Sew to the top of the quilt.

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- Sew remaining (5) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" assorted rectangles together. Add the remaining end unit from step 5 to one end.
- 10. Add the 2 $1/2^{"} \times 15 1/2^{"}$ Blue Stars & Circles border strip. Note placement of end unit.
- 11. Join remaining three bocks together, add to the border unit.

12. Sew to the bottom of the quilt top.



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
