Windsong Meadows

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Cut (2) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (9) 6-7/8" squares

Fabric B - Cut (2) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (8) 6-7/8" squares

Cut (7) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 70-1/2" and (2) 3" x 57-1/2" borders

Fabrics C and D - From each fabric: Cut (2) 5" strips, subcut (9) 5" squares

Fabrics E, J, and O - From each fabric: Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (24) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric F - Cut (3) 3-1/8" strips, subcut (36) 3-1/8" squares cut in half diagonally // for a total of 72 triangles Cut (5) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (36) 2-3/4" x 5"

Fabric G - Cut (3) 3-1/8" strips, subcut (32) 3-1/8" squares [cut in half diagonally 🖊 for a total of 64 triangles] and (4) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Cut (4) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (32) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabrics H and M - From each fabric: Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (16) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric I - Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (24) 2-3/4" squares

Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 66-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders

Fabric K - Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 63-1/2" and (2) 2" x 48-1/2" borders

Fabrics L and N - From each fabric: Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/4" squares

Fabrics P and Q - From each fabric: Cut (6) 3-1/4" strips, subcut (70) 3-1/4" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. On the wrong side of all Fabric Q 3-1/4" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Arrange a marked Fabric Q 3-1/4" square right sides together with a Fabric P 3-1/4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 2-3/4" square. Make a total of 140 Unit 1.









Repeat 70 times for 140 units.

3. Draw a diagonal line across all the Fabrics E, H, I, J, L, M, N, and **O** 2-3/4" squares.



4. Arrange a marked **Fabric J** 2-3/4" square on 1 end of a **Fabric G** 2-3/4" x 5" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end. Make a total of 6 Unit 2a (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished).

5. In the same manner, make the number of Units 2b-2p listed with fabrics indicated.













6. Arrange 4 Unit 1, 2 Unit 2a, 2 Unit 2b, and 1 Fabric C 5" square in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 3 **Block 1a** (9-1/2" square unfinished).




7. In the same manner, make the number of **Blocks 1b-1h** listed with units and 5" squares indicated.






8. Stitch 2 Fabric F 3-1/8"

triangles to adjoining **Fabric P** edges of a Unit 1. Make a total of 36 Unit 3a





 $(5-3/8" \times 5-3/8" \times 7-5/8" \text{ unfinished}).$ In the same manner, make 32 Unit 3b each with a Unit 1 and 2 Fabric G 3-1/8" triangles.

9. Stitch 4 Unit 3a on edges of a Fabric A 6-7/8" square. Make a total of 9 Block 2a (9-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner make 8 Block 2b, each with 4 Unit 3b and a Fabric B 6-7/8" square.



- 10. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 11. Arrange blocks in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing guilt center (45-1/2" x 63-1/2" unfinished).
- 12. Sew **Fabric K** 2" x 63-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add Fabric K 2" x 48-1/2" borders to top and bottom of guilt center.
- 13. Sew **Fabric I** 2-1/2" x 66-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric I 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders to top and bottom of auilt.
- 14. Sew **Fabric B** 3" x 70-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric B 3" x 57-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 15. The quilt measures approximately 57-1/2" x 75-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric R) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric G) and enjoy!!
