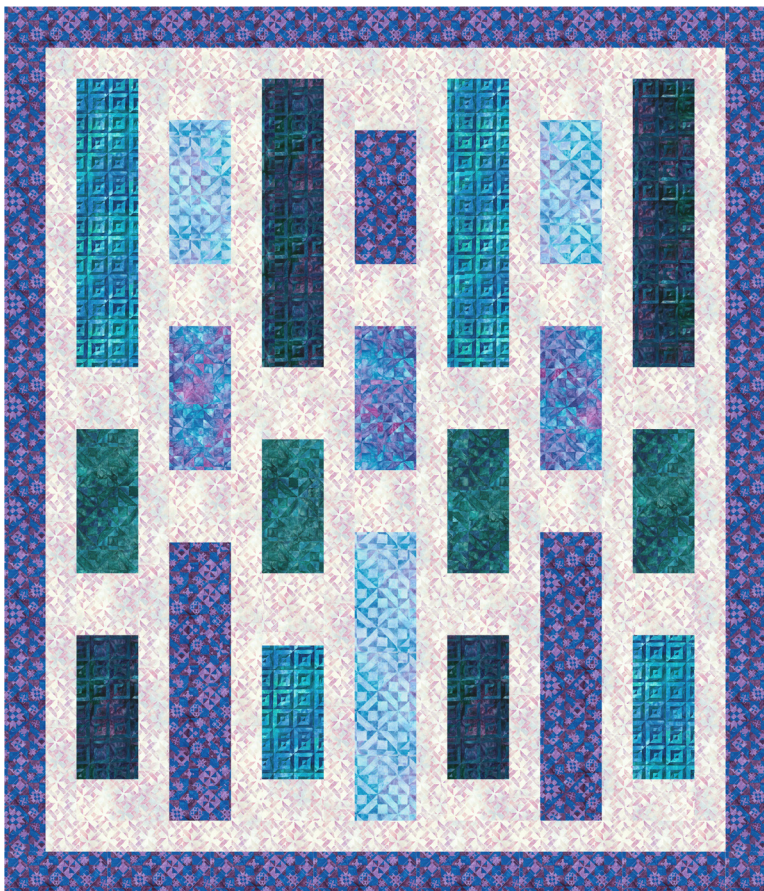

E – 80918-74 (Lengthwise Backing)	E – 80916-38 (Lengthwise Backing)	E – 80915-61 (Lengthwise Backing)	5 1/2 yds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cut in half x <b>WOF</b> to get 2 – 100" pieces (approx.)</li> <li>Sew the two pieces together along the selvage edges to get a backing piece measuring approximately 86" x 100"</li> </ul>

## Assembly of Vertical Rows

1. Follow the chart below and refer to the finished quilt image to assemble seven vertical rows:

## Completing the Quilt Top

2. Trim 8 – 3 ½ x LOF Fabric A strips to 72 ½".
3. Starting and ending with a Fabric A strip, sew vertical rows together (Row 1, Row 2...), adding a Fabric A strip between each row. Note direction of each strip by referring to the finished quilt image.
4. Trim the remaining Fabric A strips to 66 ½" and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
5. Join the 8 – 4 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together end to end. From this long strip, cut 2 – 4 ½" x 78 ½" border strips and sew to each side of the quilt top. Then cut 2 – 4 ½" x 74 ½" border strips and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

6. To prepare binding, join the Fabric B binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Fold in half wrong sides together along the length of the strip and press.
7. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
