## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Starlet - Lilac (A), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2$ " square.
- (8) 2 " squares.
-(4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Starlet - Sky (B), cut:
-(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
-(4) 2 " x $31 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Starlet - Lime (C), cut:
-(1) $31 / 2 "$ square.
-(8) 2 " squares.
From the Starlet - Coral (D), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Starlet - Orange (E), cut:
-(1) $31 / 2 "$ square.
-(8) 2 " squares.
From the Starlet - Navy (F), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2$ " squares.
- (4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $31 / 2 "$ square.
- (8) 2 " squares.

From the Starlet - Teal (G), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2$ " square.
- (8) 2 " squares.
- (4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2$ " strips.
-(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Starlet - Yellow (H), cut:
-(1) $31 / 2$ " square.
-(8) 2 " squares.
-(4) 2 " x $31 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Starlet - Pink (I), cut:
-(1) $31 / 2$ " square.
- (8) 2 " squares.

From the Starlet - Purple (J), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Starlet - Royal (K), cut:
-(1) $31 / 2 "$ square.
-(8) 2 " squares.
-(4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Starlet - Red (L), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 "$ square.
- (8) 2 " squares.
- (4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $21 / 2$ " squares.
From the Starlet - Kiwi (M), cut:
-(1) $3^{1 / 2 "}$ square.
-(8) 2 " squares.
From the Starlet - Turq. (N), cut:
-(1) $31 / 2$ " square.
-(8) 2 " squares.
From the Starlet - Kelly (O), cut:
-(4) $2^{1 / 2 "}$ squares.
- (4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2$ " strips.

From the Starlet - Petal (P), cut:
-(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
-(4) 2 " x $31 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Starlet - Grey (Q), cut:
-(1) $31 / 2$ " square.
-(8) 2 " squares.
From the Starlet - Papaya (R), cut:
-(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

- (4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2$ " strips.


## Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Starlet - White (S), cut:

- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $11 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (5) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2" squares.
- (2) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2$ " $\times 291 / 2$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 \times 39 \times 1 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 331 / 2 \prime$ " WOF strips.


## From the Starlet - Black (T), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starlet - White (Backing), cut:

- (1) 41 " $\times 51$ " strip for the backing.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) $2^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B square to the left side of (1) $11 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ Fabric S strip to make (1) BS strip. Sew (1) BS strip to the top of (1) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric $S$ strip to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.
2. Place (1) 2" Fabric $S$ square on the left side of (1) 2" x $31 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 3).

3. Place another 2" Fabric S square on the right side of the 2" x $31 / 2$ " Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a $1 / 4$ "seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 strips total.

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 and follow Figure 6 for fabric locations to make (4) Unit 3 strips.
5. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 strip to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 squares total.

6. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each side of (1) $3^{1 / 2}$ " x $31 / 2$ " Fabric A square to make (1) middle block row. Pay attention to the Unit 4 orientations. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the top block row. Pay attention to the Unit 1 orientations. Repeat to make the bottom block row. Sew the top and bottom block rows to the middle block row, paying attention to the row orientations, to make (1) Block One (Fig. 8).
7. Repeat Steps 1-6 using Figures 9-19 for fabric identifications and fabric locations to make
(1) Block Two, (1) Block Three, (1) Block Four, (1) Block Five, (1) Block Six, (1) Block Seven, (1) Block Eight, (1) Block Nine, (1) Block Ten, (1) Block Eleven and (1) Block Twelve.

# STARLET BASICS 

## Quilt 1

## Quilt Top Assembly

## (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

8. Sew together (1) Block One, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric S strip, (1) Block Two, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric $S$ strip and (1) Block Three, in that order, to make Row One.
9. Sew together (1) Block Four, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric S strip, (1) Block Five, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric S strip and (1) Block Six, in that order, to make Row Two.
10. Sew together (1) Block Seven, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric $S$ strip, (1) Block Eight, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric S strip and (1) Block Nine, in that order, to make Row Three.
11. Sew together (1) Block Ten, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric $S$ strip, (1) Block Eleven, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric $S$ strip and (1) Block Twelve, in that order, to make Row Four.
12. Sew together to Row One, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 291 / 2 "$ Fabric $S$ strip, Row Two, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 291 / 2 "$ Fabric S strip, Row Three, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 291 / 2 "$ Fabric S strip and Row Four, in that order, to make the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 391 / 2$ " Fabric $S$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 33^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric S strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric T strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.
