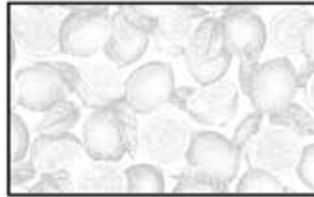

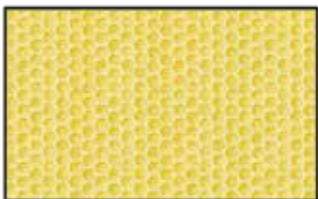

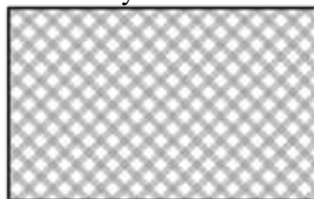

Materials

1 panel	Lemon Panel 24 In x 44 In - Yellow (A)	599P-36
½ yard	Folio Basics - Early Green (B)	7755-62
½ yard	Diagonal Plaid - Gray (C)	595-90
1 ¾ yards	Packed Lemons & Flowers - Yellow (D)	590-36
1 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Dark Gray (E)	1063-91*
⅞ yard	Tossed Lemons - Gray (F)	591-90
⅞ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (G)	1063-90
⅓ yard	Tossed Bees - Yellow (H)	597-33
⅓ yard	Tossed Lemon's Flowers - Gray (I)	596-36
4 ⅓ yards	Large Tossed Lemons & Words - Yellow (Backing)	589-30

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Lemon Panel 24 In x 44 In - Yellow (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 32 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Folio Basics - Early Green (B), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 2 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x 32 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 25 ½" WOF strips.

From the Diagonal Plaid - Gray (C), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 34 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x 32 ½" WOF strips.

From the Packed Lemons & Flowers - Yellow (D), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 59 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5 ½" x 61 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed, and (11) 4 ½" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Dark Gray (E), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (88) 2 ½" squares.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Lemons - Gray (F), cut:

- (10) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (88) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (G), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (88) 2 ½" squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 56 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips.

From the Tossed Bees - Yellow (H), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 2 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Lemon's Flowers - Gray (I), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) 4 ½" squares.

From the Large Tossed Lemons & Words - Yellow (Backing), cut:

- (2) 77" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 69" x 77" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 32 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 34 ½".

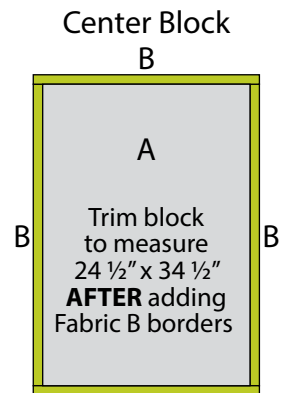

2. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric G square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 3).

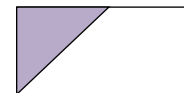

3. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).

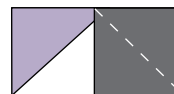

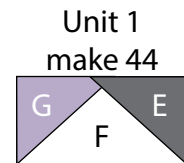

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (44) Unit 1 squares total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (44) Unit 2 squares.

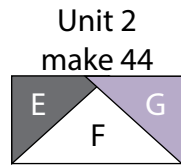

6. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric H square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric I square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 8 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (11) Block One squares total.

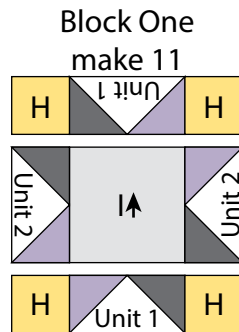

7. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric B square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 8 1/2" Block Two square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (11) Block Two squares total.

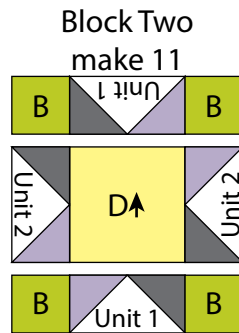

8. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 9).

9. Sew together (3) Block Two squares and (2) Block One squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 10).

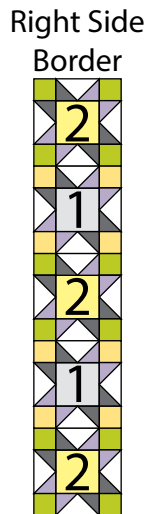

10. Sew together (3) Block Two squares and (3) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 11). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

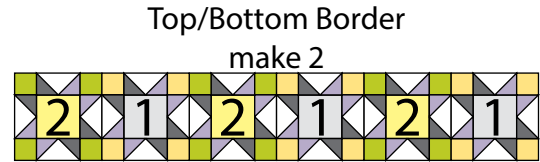

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

11. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 34 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 32 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew the Left Side and Right Side Borders to the left and right sides of the Center Block.
14. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) 2" x 56 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 51 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 59 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 61 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

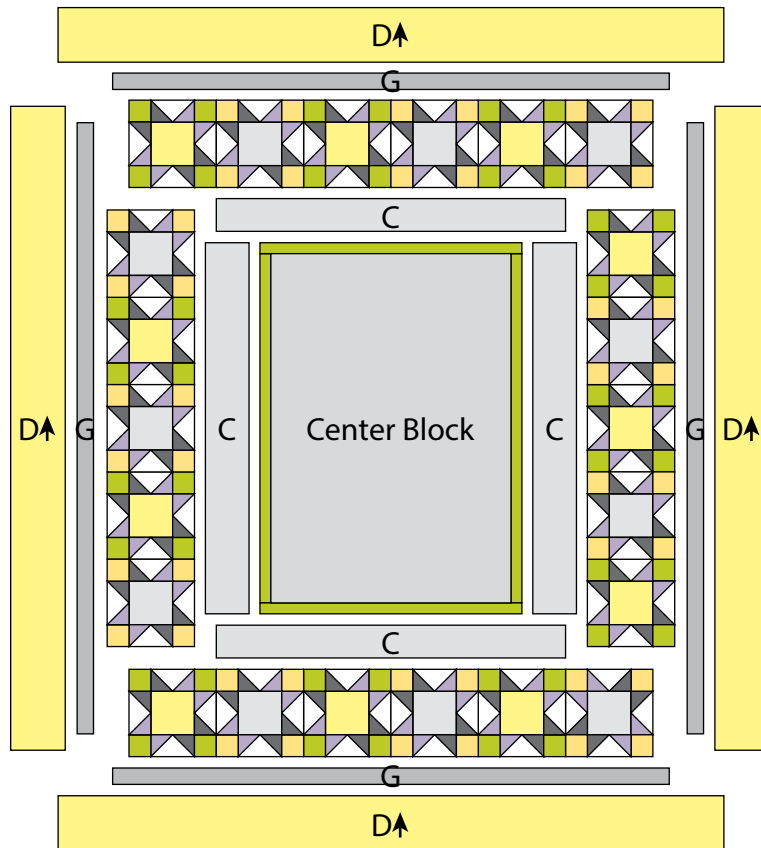
17. Layer and quilt as desired.

18. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

19. Bind as desired.
