# Wild Woods Lodge

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvege to selvege, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

*If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.*

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 2 panels to approximately 9" x 23-1/2" and 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvege: (2) 8-3/4" x 100" and (2) 8-3/4" x 81" multi-stripe borders with tree stripe on bottom; and (2) 8-3/4" x 46" multi-stripe borders, 1 with tree stripe on top, 1 with tree stripe on bottom

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares

**Fabric D** - Cut (6) 5-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 5-1/2" x 65" and (2) 5-1/2" x 56" borders  
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" and (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

**Fabric F** - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips

**Fabric G** - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips  
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 75" and (2) 2-1/2" x 60" borders

**Fabric H** - Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabric I** - Cut (5) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/2" squares and (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

**Fabric J** - Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 13" and (8) 1-1/4" x 12" strips

**Fabric K** - Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 24" and (4) 1-1/2" x 11" strips

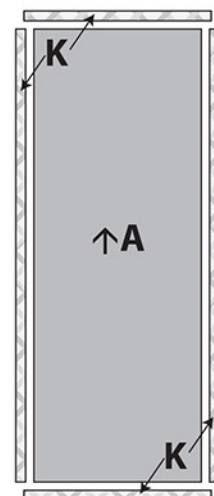
**Fabric L** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

**Fabric M** - Cut (9) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 95-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 82-1/2" borders

## 2. Piecing Order:

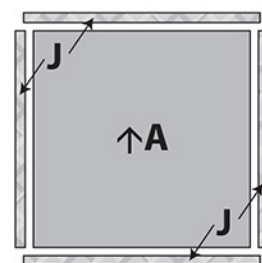
1. Stitch **Fabric K** 1-1/2" x 24" strips to sides of a 9" x 23-1/2" **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 11" **Fabric K** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 10" x 24-1/2" (unfinished).** Make a total of 2 **Block 1**.

Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.



Block 1 - Make 2

2. Stitch **Fabric J** 1-1/4" x 12" strips to sides of an 11-1/2" square **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 13" **Fabric J** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished).** Make a total of 4 **Block 2**.



Block 2 - Make 4

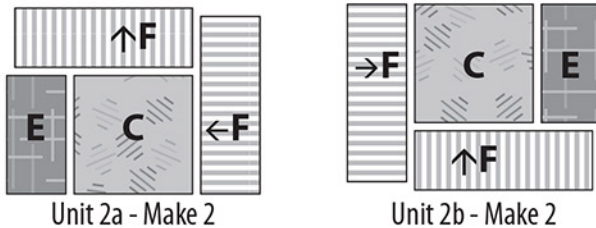
3. Stitch a **Fabric D** 3-1/2" square to end of a **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip. Make a total of 4 Unit 1 (3-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



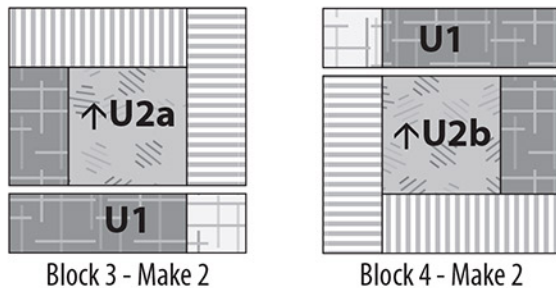
Unit 1 - Make 4

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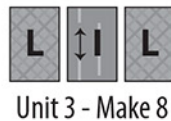
4. Stitch a **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to the left of a **Fabric C** 6-1/2" square. Add a **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to the top and the a **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to the right side of the unit. Make a total of 2 Unit 2a (9-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished). In a similar manner, make 2 Unit 2b noting orientation and placement of strips.



5. Stitch a Unit 1 to each Unit 2a and 2b as shown. Make a total of 2 each **Blocks 3** and **4** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



6. Sew a **Fabric I** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece between 2 **Fabric L** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 3 (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).

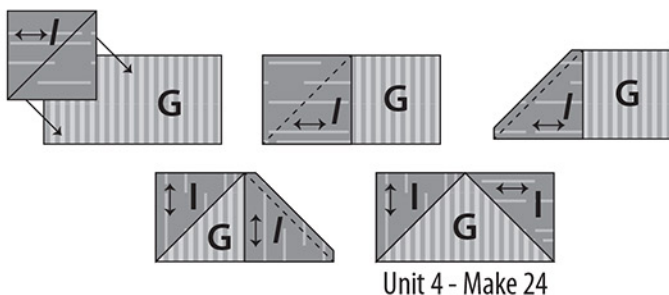


7. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabric I** 3-1/2" squares *only as shown*.



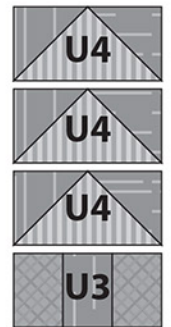
*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.*

8. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 3-1/2" square on 1 end of a **Fabric G** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim



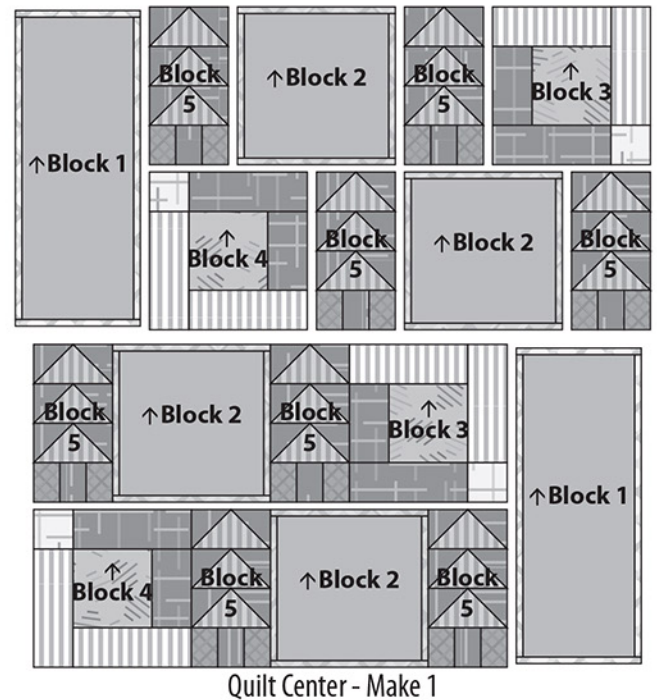
seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on opposite end of the **Fabric G** piece. Make a total of 24 Unit 4 (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).

9. Arrange 3 Unit 4 and 1 Unit 3 in a vertical row. Stitch units together. Make a total of 8 **Block 5** (6-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



Block 5 - Make 8

10. Referring to Quilt Center Layout arrange **Blocks 2-5** in 4 rows. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew the top 2 rows together and add a **Block 1** to the left side. Stitch bottom 2 rows together and sew the remaining **Block 1** to the right. Sew top and bottom halves of the quilt center together (46" x 48-1/2" unfinished)



11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4 for arrangement and placement of quilt center and borders.

12. Sew **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 46" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

*Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.*

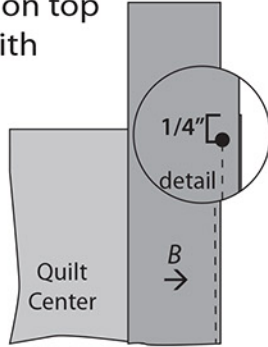


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13. Stitch **Fabric D** 5-1/2" x 65" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **D** 5-1/2" x 56" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

14. Stitch **Fabric G** 2-1/2" x 75" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **G** 2-1/2" x 60" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

15. Center **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 100" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 81" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the stripe orientated as indicated. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



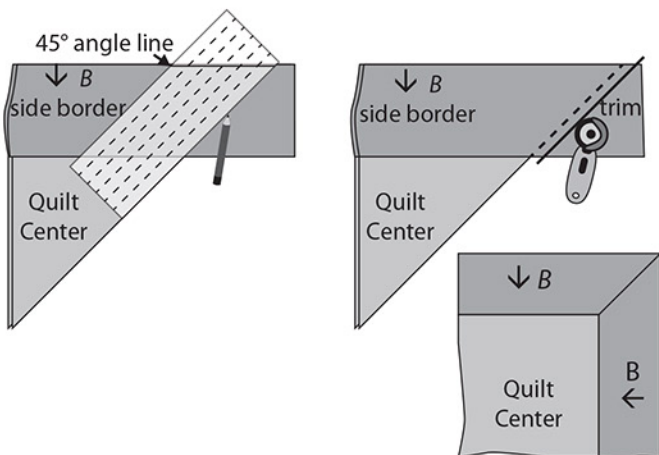

17. Stitch **Fabric M** 3-1/2" x 95-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **M** 3-1/2" x 82-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

18. The quilt measures approximately 82-1/2" x 101-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric N**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

19. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!

16. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.

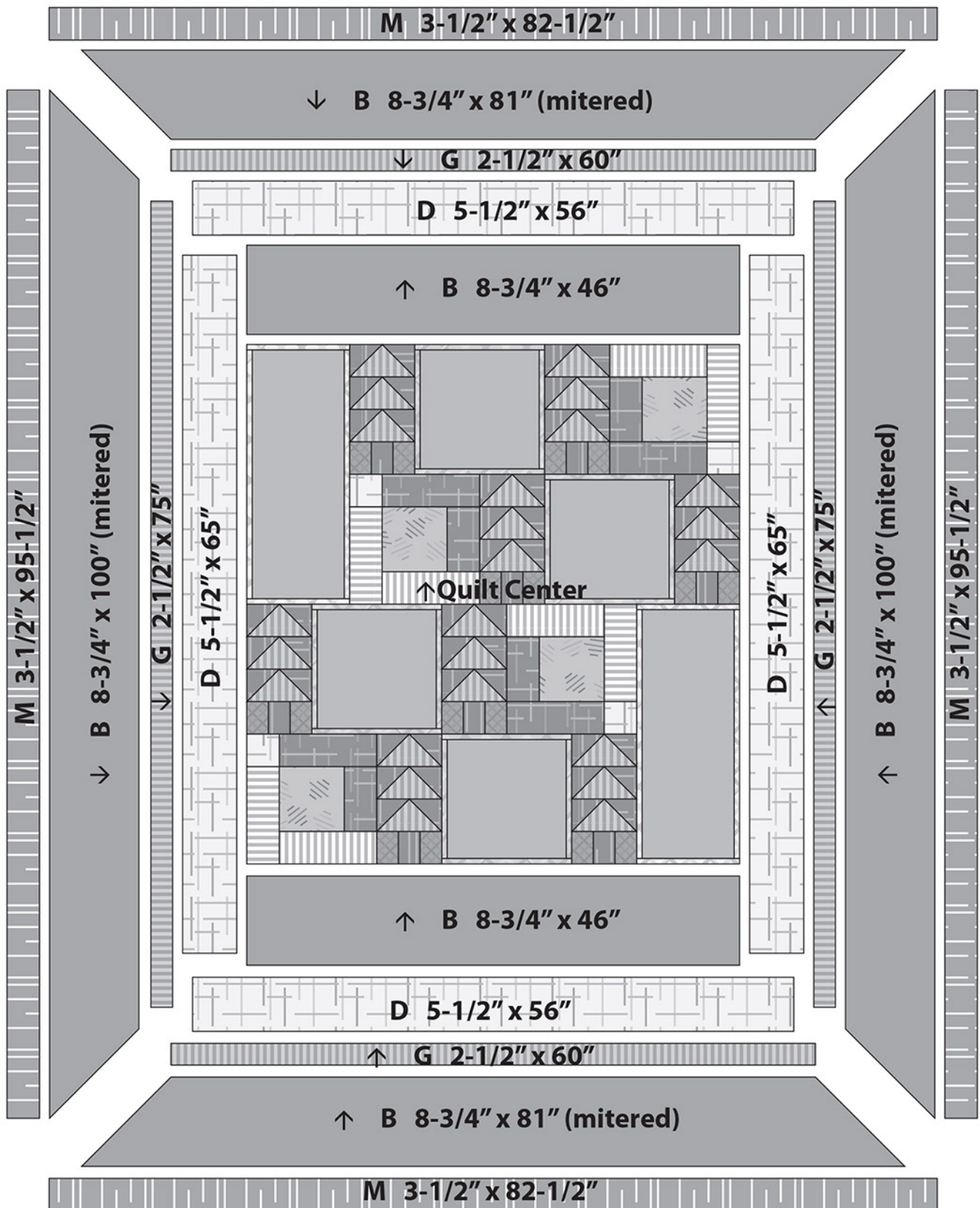


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## QUILT LAYOUT

Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.





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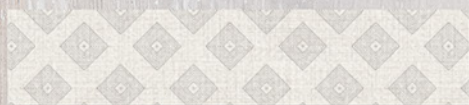

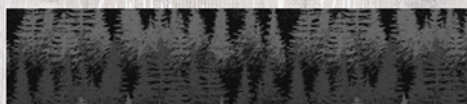

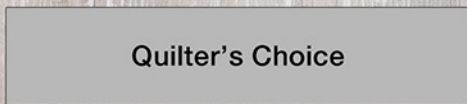
