# Wild Woods Lodge by PDR, LLC



Throw Quilt: 55 1/2" x 74 1/2"



Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 2 panels to approximately 9" x 23-1/2" and 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 46" multi-stripe borders, 1 with tree stripe on top, 1 with tree stripe on bottom

Fabric C - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (6) 5-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 5-1/2" x 65" and (2) 5-1/2" x 56" borders Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" and (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips

Fabric G - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

**Fabric H** - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabric I** - Cut (5) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/2" squares and (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Fabric J - Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 13" and (8) 1-1/4" x 12" strips

Fabric K - Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 24" and (4) 1-1/2" x 11" strips

Fabric L - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces


#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch Fabric K 1-1/2" x 24" strips to sides of a 9" x 23-1/2" Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 11" Fabric K strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 10" x 24-1/2" (unfinished). Make a total of 2 Block 1.


Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.



1-1/4" x 12" strips to sides of an 11-1/2" square Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 13" Fabric J strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished). Make a total of 4 Block 2.




3. Stitch a **Fabric D** 3-1/2" square to end of a Fabric E 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip. Make a total of 4 Unit 1 (3-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



4. Stitch a Fabric E 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to the left of a Fabric C 6-1/2" square. Add a Fabric F  $3-1/2" \times 9-1/2"$  strip to the top and then a Fabric F 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to the right side of the unit. Make a total of 2 Unit 2a (9-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished). In a similar manner, make 2 Unit 2b noting orientation and placement of strips.





Unit 2a - Make 2

5. Stitch a Unit 1 to each Unit 2a and 2b as shown. Make a total of 2 each **Blocks 3** and **4** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

6. Sew a **Fabric I** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece between 2 **Fabric L** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 3 (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).




Unit 3 - Make 8

7. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabric I** 3-1/2" squares *only as shown*.




Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.


8. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 3-1/2" square on 1 end of a **Fabric G** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on opposite end of the **Fabric G** piece. Make a total of 24 Unit 4 (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).




9. Arrange 3 Unit 4 and 1 Unit 3 in a vertical row. Stitch units together. Make a total of 8 **Block 5** (6-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



10. Referring to Quilt Center
Layout arrange **Blocks 2-5** in
4 rows. Stitch blocks into rows.
Sew the top 2 rows together
and add a **Block 1** to the left
side. Stitch bottom 2 rows together and sew
the remaining **Block 1** to the right. Sew top
and bottom halves of the quilt center
together (46" x 48-1/2" unfinished)






Quilt Center - Make 1

- 11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3 for arrangement and placement of quilt center and borders.
- 12. Sew **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 46" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 13. Stitch **Fabric D** 5-1/2" x 65" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **D** 5-1/2" x 56" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 14. The quilt measures approximately 56" x 75" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!




