Fabric A: DBSE 4832 PA	1 panel
Fabric B: DBSE 4836 LB	3/8 yard
Fabric C: DBSE 4837 MU	1/2 yard
Fabric D: DBSE 4839 B	3/4 yard
Fabric E: DBSE 4839 LB	1/4 yard
Fabric F: SERE 4492 BV	3/4 yard
Backing: DBSE 4836 LB suggested	3 yards
Batting	53" x 63"

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut panel 31 1/2" x 41 1/2" keeping design centered.

From Fabric B:

1. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut thirty-two 2 1/2" squares. (Fish Block)
2. Cut one 3" strip; subcut eight 3" squares. (Fish Block)

From Fabric C:

1. Cut three 4 1/2" strips; subcut two 4 1/2" x 17 1/2" strips, two 4 1/2" x 27 1/2" strips and four 4 1/2" squares. (Second Border)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut four 1 1/2" strips; subcut two 1 1/2" x 31 1/2" strips. Sew one piece of each of the remaining two pieces to each of the full length strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From these pieced strips, cut two 1 1/2" x 43 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)

2. Cut six 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut one 1 1/2" strip; subcut sixteen 1 1/2" squares. (Fish Block)
2. Cut one 2 1/2" strip; subcut eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (Fish Block)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut six 2 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 2 1/2" x 41 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2" x 55 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)
2. Cut one 3" strip; subcut eight 3" squares. (Fish Block)
3. Cut one 4 1/2" strip; subcut sixteen 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (Fish Block)

Piecing Instructions:

Fish Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back side of each 2 1/2" B square. With right sides together, place one marked square at one end of one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" F rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press toward the triangle corner. Repeat at opposite end of F rectangle to complete one flying-geese unit. Repeat to make sixteen units. (Figure 1)

2. Draw a diagonal line on the back side of each 3" B square. With right sides together, place one marked square on one 3" F square. Sew 1/4" on each side of marked line. Cut apart on the line and press toward F. Using a ruler with a 45-degree line, square and trim the units to 2 1/2". Repeat to make sixteen half-square-triangle units. (Figure 2)

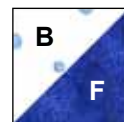

3. With right sides together, place one 1 1/2" E square on the F corner of one Step 2 HST unit. Sew diagonally across the square from corner to corner. Trim seam to 1/4" and press toward E triangle corner. Repeat for each HST unit. (Figure 3)

4. Sew together two Step 3 units, as shown. Press seam open. Repeat to make eight units. (Figure 4)

5. Referring to diagram sew together two flying-geese units, one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" E rectangle and one Step 4 unit. Press seams open or to one side. Repeat to complete eight blocks. (Figure 5)

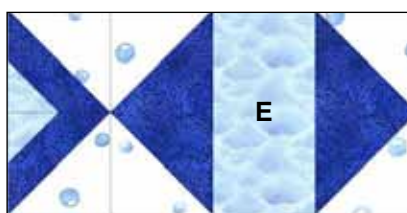

Quilt Assembly: Refer to the Quilt Diagram

1. Sew one 1 1/2" x 31 1/2" D strip to both sides of 31 1/2" x 41 1/2" panel rectangle. Press toward D. Sew one 1 1/2" x 43 1/2" D strip to the top and bottom of the rectangle; press.
2. Referring to Quilt Diagram for correct placement, sew two Fish Blocks to both ends of one 4 1/2" x 17 1/2" C strip. Blocks should be facing in the same direction. Press toward C. Repeat. Sew one border unit to both sides of the framed panel rectangle. Press.
3. Sew two Fish Blocks to both ends of one 4 1/2" x 27 1/2" C strip. Blocks should be facing in the same direction. Press toward C. Sew one 4 1/2" square to both ends. Press towards the fish block. Repeat. Sew one border unit to the top and bottom of the panel rectangle. Press.

4. Sew one 2 1/2" x 41 1/2" F strip to both sides of the quilt center. Press toward F. Sew one 2 1/2" x 55 1/2" F strip to the top and bottom of quilt center; press.

Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with vertical seam/s. Press seams open. Trim to 53" x 63".
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join six 2 1/2" D binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method
6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.

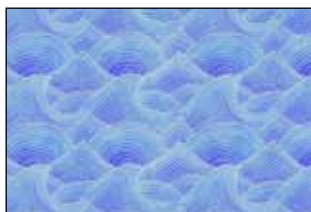
