Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Fussy cut 8 panels to 10-1/2" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 3" x 78-1/2" and (2) 3" x 63-1/2" paisley stripe borders. Fussy-cut (8) 5-1/8" x 14" floral stripe rectangles.

Fabric C - Cut (1) 12" strip, subcut (1) 6" x 12" piece [subcut into (2) 6" squares], (1) 11-1/4" square [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles], and (2) 11" squares


Fabric D - Cut (1) 10-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 10-7/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 4 triangles
Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces and (1) 5-1/2" square

Fabric F - Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips and (20) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (2) 6" squares, (1) 5-1/2" square, and (4) 1-1/2" x 16" strips
Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (7) 5-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 16" strips

Fabric H - Cut (1) 8" strip, subcut (4) 8" squares
Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (2) 6" squares and (4) 3" squares

Fabric I - Cut (1) 11-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 11-1/4" square [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles] and (2) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders
Cut (3) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 54-1/2" borders

Fabric J - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 5-1/2" squares, (4) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces, and (2) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces


Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 3-1/2" squares and (4) 3" squares

Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 16 triangles

Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (14) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces and (16) 2" squares

Fabric K - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (8) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 83-1/2" and (2) 2" x 66-1/2" borders

Fabric L - Cut (1) 5-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 5-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles] and (4) 4" squares [cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles]

Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces, (24) 3-1/2" squares, and (8) 3" squares

Fabric M - Cut (1) 11" strip, subcut (2) 11" squares. Cut remaining strip into (1) 3-1/2" x 15" strip [subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares] and (1) 3" x 13" strip [subcut (4) 3" squares].

Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (2) 6" squares. Cut remaining strip into (3) 2" x 29" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares.

Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 75-1/2" borders

Cut (3) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 58-1/2" borders

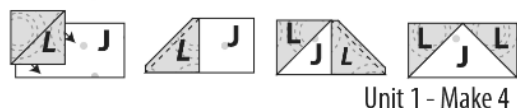
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2. Piecing Order:

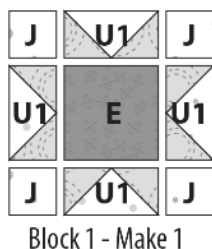
1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 16 each **Fabrics F** and **J** 3-1/2" squares and all **Fabric H** 8", **Fabric G** 5-1/2", **Fabric J** 5-1/2", **Fabric L** 3-1/2", **Fabric H** 3", **Fabric L** 3", **Fabric M** 3", and **Fabric M** 2" squares.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

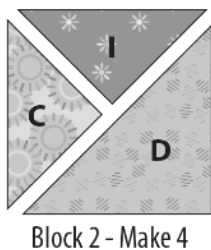
2. Arrange a marked **Fabric L** 3" square on 1 end of a **Fabric J** 3" x 5-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end. Make a total of 4 Unit 1 (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished).



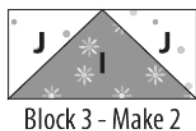
3. Arrange 4 Unit 1, 4 **Fabric J** 3" squares, and the **Fabric E** 5-1/2" square in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 1** (10-1/2" square unfinished).



4. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C** and **I** 11-1/4" triangles together along short edges as shown. Add a **Fabric D** 10-7/8" triangle along long edges. Make a total of 4 **Block 2** (10-1/2" square unfinished).



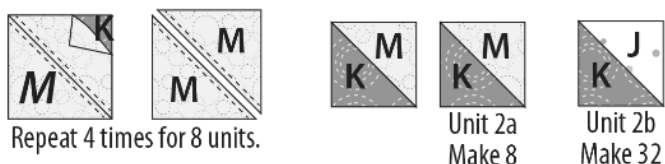
5. Referring to Step 2, make 2 **Block 3**, each with 2 marked **Fabric J** 5-1/2" squares and a **Fabric I** 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece (5-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).



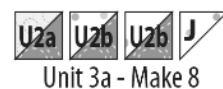
6. On the wrong side of 2 **Fabric H** 6" squares, 16 **Fabric J** 3-1/2" squares, and all **Fabric M** 3-1/2", 6", and 11" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



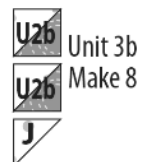
7. Arrange a marked **Fabric M** 3-1/2" square right sides together with a **Fabric K** 3-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 3" square. Make a total of 8 Unit 2a. In the same manner, make 32 Unit 2b with fabrics indicated.



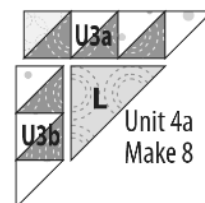
8. Arrange 1 Unit 2a, 2 Unit 2b, and 1 **Fabric J** 3-3/8" triangle in a row. Stitch into a row. Make a total of 8 Unit 3a (3" x 10-7/8" unfinished).



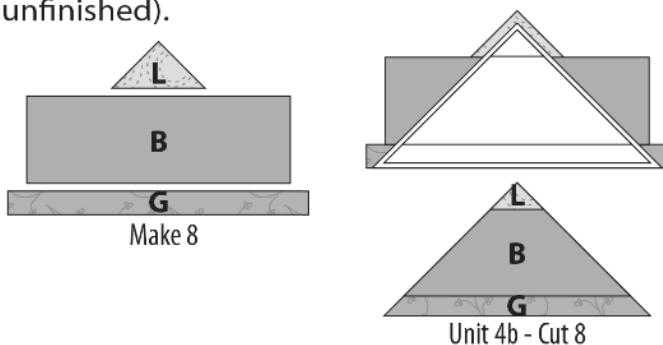
9. Arrange 2 Unit 2b, and 1 **Fabric J** 3-3/8" triangle in a vertical row. Stitch into a row. Make a total of 8 Unit 3b (3" x 8-3/8" unfinished).



10. Arrange 1 each Units 3a and 3b, and **Fabric L** 5-7/8" triangle in 2 rows as shown. Stitch Unit 3b and **L** triangle together. Add Unit 3a to top. Make a total of 8 Unit 4a (10-7/8" x 10-7/8" x 15-3/8" unfinished).

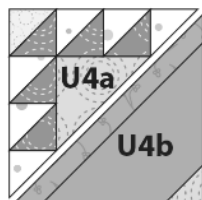


11. Sew a **Fabric B** 5-1/8" x 14" rectangle centered lengthwise on a **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x 16" strip. Sew a **Fabric L** 4" triangle centered on remaining long edge of the **B** rectangle. Using the template, cut a Unit 4b. Stay stitch short edges to prevent stretching. Make a total of 8 Unit 4b (10-7/8" x 10-7/8" x 15-3/8" unfinished).



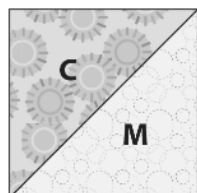
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12. Sew 1 each Units 4a and 4b together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 **Block 4** (10-1/2" square unfinished).



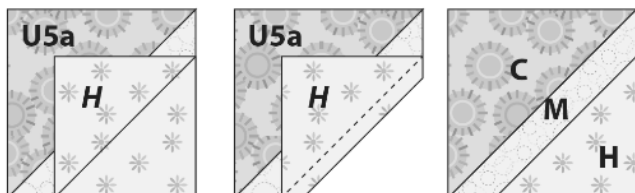

13. Referring to Step 7, arrange a marked **Fabric M** 11" square right sides together with a **Fabric C** 11" square. Stitch, press, and trim each to 10-1/2" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 5a.

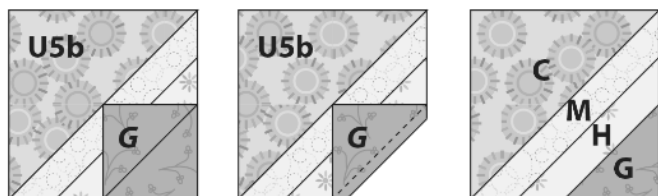
14. Arrange a marked **Fabric H** 8" square right sides together on the **Fabric M** corner of a Unit 5a, aligning edges. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Make a total of 4 Unit 5b (10-1/2" square unfinished).

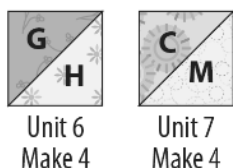
Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

15. In the same manner, repeat Step 14 with a **Fabric G** 5-1/2" square on the **Fabric H** corner of Unit 5b. Make a total of 4 **Block 5** (10-1/2" square unfinished).

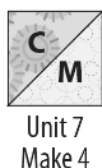


Block 5 - Make 4

16. Referring to Step 7, arrange a marked **Fabric H** 6" square right sides together with a **Fabric G** 6" square. Stitch, press, and trim each to 5-1/2" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 6 (5-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 7 with fabrics indicated.

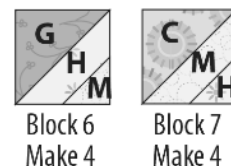

17. Referring to Step 14, arrange a marked **Fabric M** 3" square on **H** corner of a Unit 6. Stitch, trim, and press. Make a total of 4 **Block 6**

18. Referring to Step 2, use the same stitch and flip technique to



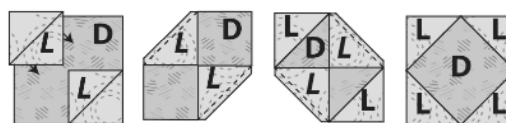

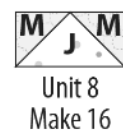
make 2 each **Blocks 8a** and **8b** each with a **Fabric G** 5-1/2" square and a **Fabric E** 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece (5-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).

19. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric L** 3-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric D** 6-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 6 **Block 9** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



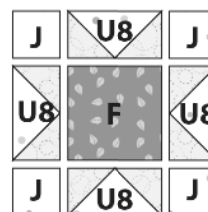

20. Referring to Step 2, make 16 Unit 8 each with 2 marked **Fabric M** 2" squares and a **Fabric J** 2" x 3-1/2" piece (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished).

21. Arrange a **Fabric F** 3-1/2" square, 4 **Fabric J** 2" squares, and 4 Unit 8 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 10** (6-1/2" square unfinished).

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22. Referring to Step 2, make 8 Unit 9a each with 2 marked **Fabric J** 3-1/2" squares and a **Fabric F**

3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 Unit 9b with fabrics indicated.

23. Stitch 1 each Units 9a and 9b together as shown. Make a total of 8 **Block 11** (6-1/2" square unfinished).

24. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 5) for arrangement and placement of blocks, **Fabric A** 10-1/2" squares, and borders.

25. Arrange **Blocks 1-8** and **Fabric A** 10-1/2" squares in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (50-1/2" x 60-1/2" unfinished).

26. Sew **Fabric I** 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric I** 2" x 54-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

27. Arrange **Blocks 9-11** in rows above and below bordered quilt center. Stitch into rows (6-1/2" x 54-1/2" unfinished). Sew rows to top and bottom of bordered quilt center. Quilt center now measures (54-1/2" x 75-1/2" unfinished).

28. Sew **Fabric M** 2-1/2" x 75-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric M** 2" x 58-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

29. Sew **Fabric B** 3" x 78-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric B** 3" x 63-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

30. Sew **Fabric K** 2" x 83-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric K** 2" x 66-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

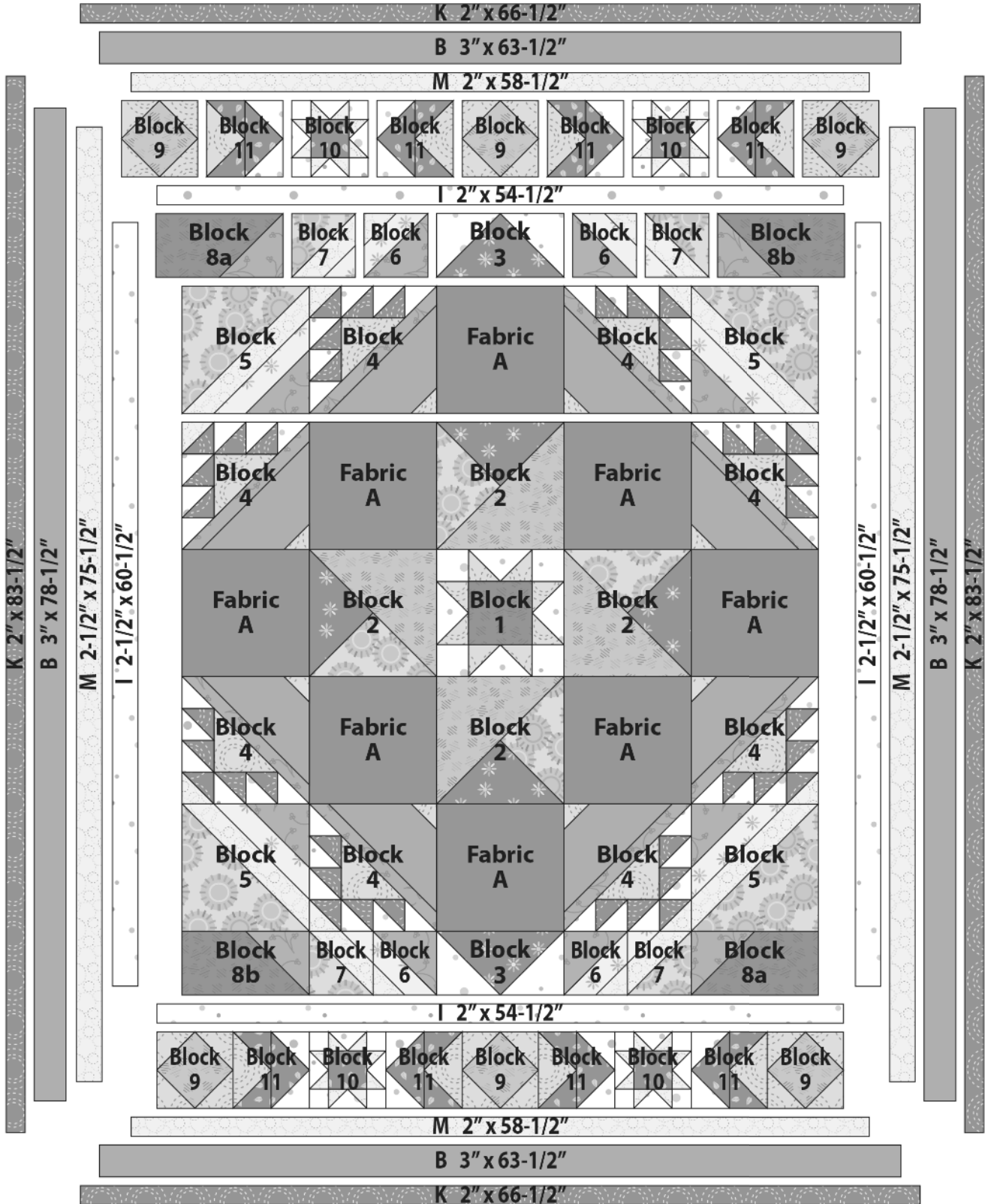
31. The quilt measures approximately 66-1/2" x 86-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric N**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

32. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric M**) and enjoy!!

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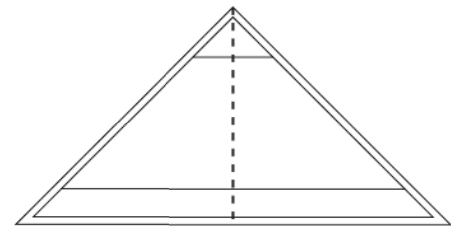
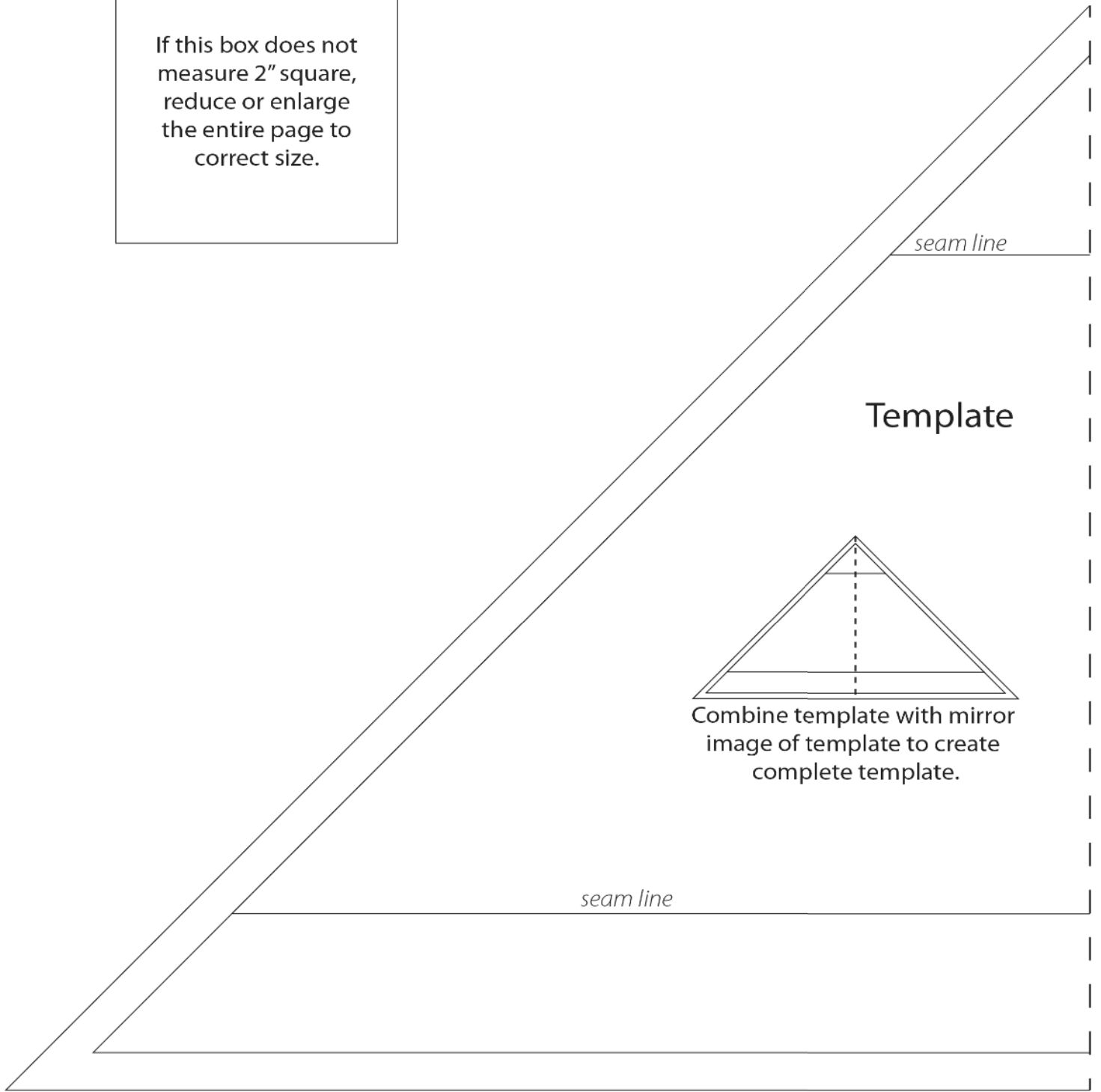
QUILT LAYOUT
