## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Blocks - Royal (A):

- Fussy cut (12) $61 / 2 "$ squares, each centered on a block.


## From the Folio - Spruce (B), cut:

-(4) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
-(6) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
From the Folio - Grape (C), cut:

- (3) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $2 "$ squares.
- (5) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ x $71 / 2 "$ strips.
- (6) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Forest Fern - Royal (D), cut:
-(6) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ x $91 / 2 "$ strips.
-(8) $1 \frac{1}{2} " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ x $111 / 2 "$ strips.

## From the Folio - Powder Blue (E), cut:

-(8) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) $2 " \times 31 / 4 "$ strips.
From the Mushrooms - Forest (F), cut:
-(4) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $2 " \times 31 / 4 "$ strips.

## From the Fairy Silhouettes - Royal G), cut:

-(4) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $2 " \times 31 / 4 "$ strips.

## From the Rainbow Ferns - Lilac (H), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 591 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (3) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Flower Meadow - Forest (I), cut:

- (4) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 651 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 531 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Fairies Allover - Lilac (Back), cut:
-(2) $61 " x$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61 " x 76 " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure $71 / 29 \times 71 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Unit 2 squares total.

3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 11 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (12) Unit 3 squares total.

4. Sew together (1) $2 " \times 31 / 4 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) $2 " \times 31 / 4 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) 2 " $\times 31 / 4 "$ Fabric E strip and (1) $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make (1) $2 " \times 11^{1 / 2 "}$ " Unit 4 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (48) Unit 4 strips total.

5. Sew (1) 2" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $141 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.

6. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric H strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four.
7. Sew together the (4) Rows from Step 6 in numerical order and the (3) $11 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric H strips, lengthwise and alternating the from top to bottom, to make the $441 / 2 " \times 591 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 6).

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 8. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 591 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ " $\times 501 / 2$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 65^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $531 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
12. Bind as desired.
