½ yard	Folio - Spruce (B)	7755-74
¾ yard	Folio - Grape (C)	7755-58
²⁄₃ yard	Forest Fern - Royal (D)	3015-77
²⁄₃ yard	Folio - Powder Blue (E)	7755-07
⅓ yard	Mushrooms - Forest (F)	3016-66
⅓ yard	Fairy Silhouettes - Royal (G)	3014-77
1 1/8 yards	Rainbow Ferns - Lilac (H)	3018-55
1 1/8 yards	Flower Meadow - Forest (I)	3013-66*
3 ½ yards	Fairies Allover - Lilac (Backing)	3012-55

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Blocks - Royal (A):

• Fussy cut (12) 6 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Folio - Spruce (B), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

From the Folio - Grape (C), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" squares.
- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 7 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 9 ½" strips.

From the Forest Fern - Royal (D), cut:

- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 11 ½" strips.

From the Folio - Powder Blue (E), cut:

• (8) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2" x 3 1/4" strips.

From the Mushrooms - Forest (F), cut:

• (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" x 3 1/4" strips.

From the Fairy Silhouettes - Royal G), cut:

• (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" x 3 1/4" strips.

From the Rainbow Ferns - Lilac (H), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 59 ½" strips.
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (3) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

From the Flower Meadow - Forest (I), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 65 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 53 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Fairies Allover - Lilac (Back), cut:

• (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 76" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure** 7 ½" x 7 ½". Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Unit 2 squares total.







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3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (12) Unit 3 squares total.



4. Sew together (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric F strip, (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip and (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric G strip, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make (1) 2" x 11 ½" Unit 4 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (48) Unit 4 strips total.



5. Sew (1) 2" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 14 ½" Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.




6. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) 1 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric H strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four

7. Sew together the (4) Rows from Step 6 in numerical order and the (3) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric H strips, lengthwise and alternating the from top to bottom, to make the 44 ½" x 59 ½" Center Block (Fig. 6).




Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
8. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 9. Sew (1) 2" x 65 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 53 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 10. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 11. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 12. Bind as desired.
