

Block Assembly:

- 1. Sew (1) **B** 3" x 11" strip to the top of the **A1** 11" square. Sew (1) **C** 3" x 13-1/2" strip to the left side of the newly sewn block to make (1) **Unit 1** square (**Fig. 2**). Repeat to make (6) 13-1/2" **Unit 1** squares using the **A2** through **A6** square.
- **2.** Sew (1) **D** 3" x 13-1/2" strip to the bottom of (1) **Unit 1** square. Sew (1) **E** 3" x 16" strip to the right side of the **D** square. Sew (1) **F** 3" x 16" strip to the top of the newly sewn block to make (1) 16" x 18-1/2" **Unit 2** rectangle **(Fig. 3)**. Repeat to make (6) **Unit 2** rectangles total.
- **3.** Sew (1) **G** 3" x 18-1/2" strip to the left side of (1) **Unit 2** rectangle. Sew (1) **W** 3" x 18-1/2" strip to the bottom side of the **Unit 2** rectangle. Sew (1) **V** 3" x 21" strip to the right side of the newly sewn block to make (1) 21" **Block One** square **(Fig. 4)**. Repeat to make (6) **Block One** squares total.



4. Repeat **Steps 1-3** and refer to **Figure 5** for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) **Block Two** squares.



5. Repeat **Steps 1-3** and refer to **Figure 6** for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (8) **Unit 3** squares.



- **6.** Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- **7.** Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- **8.** Refer to the **Figure 7** to arrange and press the **E** Bird Body, **B** Bird Wing and **L** Beak onto (1) **Unit 3** square to make (1) Unit 4 square. Repeat to make (3) Unit 4 squares total.



- **9.** Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
- **10.** Using your favorite embroidery method, embroider the bird's eye and feet onto (1) **Unit 4** square to make (1) **Block Three** square **(Fig. 8)**.
- 11. Repeat Steps 8-10 to make (3) Block Three squares total.



12. Repeat Steps 8-10 and refer to Figures 9-12 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Six square and (2) Block Seven squares.









- **13.** Sew (1) **T** 5-1/2" x 21" strip, (1) **Block A1** square, (1) **Block Three** square, (1) **Block Four** square and (1) **Block A5** square together in that order from left to right to make **Row One** (**Fig. 13**).
- **14.** Repeat **Step 13** and refer to **Figure 13** for component identification, placement and orientation to make **Row Two**, **Row Three** and **Row Four**.
- **15.** Sew together the (4) **Rows** from **Steps 13-14**, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to the bottom, to make the 87-1/2" x 82-1/2" **Center Block (Fig. 13)**.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Diagram while assembling the quilt top.)

- **16.** Sew (1) **P** 3" x 87-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
- **17.** Sew (1) **S** 5-1/2" x 87-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.


Finishing

- **18.** Layer and quilt as desired.
- **19.** Sew the (10) \mathbb{N} 2-1/2" x WOF strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 20. Bind as desired.

Quilt Diagram









