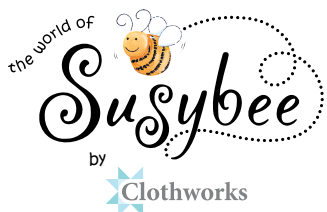




Finished quilt size: 40" x 40"
 Backing: 42" x 48" (1 3/8y of 42" wide fabric
OR 2 3/4 yards to allow overage for longarm quilting)
 Suggested: SB20411-545

Fabric and Cutting Chart

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting Directions
 Fabric A SB20053-101	1/2y	a. Inner border #1 (4) 1 5/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1 5/8" x 25 1/4" and (2) 1 5/8" x 27 1/2" strips. b. Inner border #3 (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1 1/2" x 33 1/2" and (2) 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" strips.
 Fabric B SB20053-520	1/8y	Inner border #2 (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.
 Fabric C SB20104-535		
 Fabric D SB20157-420	1/2y, includes binding	a. Inner border #2 (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares. b. Binding (5) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.

 Fabric F SB20157-545	1y	Quilt center (1) 25 1/4" x 25 1/4" square, centering design.
 Fabric G SB20409-545		
 Fabric H SB20411-100	1/2y	Outer border (4) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 3" x 35 1/2" and (2) 3" x 40 1/2" strips.

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Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner Border #1

Sew (1) 1 5/8" x 25 1/4" Fabric A strip to each side of 25 1/4" x 25 1/4" Fabric G quilt center, followed by (1) 1 5/8" x 27 1/2" Fabric A strip to the top and (1) to the bottom side of quilt center.



2. Inner Border #2

Arrange and sew (9) assorted 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" print squares to make a column unit. Make (2) column units. Sew to the opposite sides of quilt center.



Arrange and sew (11) assorted 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" print squares to make a row unit. Make (2) row units. Sew to the top and bottom of quilt center.



3. Inner Border #3 and Outer Border

Border strips - sew shorter strips to each side of quilt center, followed by longer strips to the top and bottom of quilt center:

Inner border #3: (2) 1 1/2" x 33 1/2" Fabric A strips, then (2) 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" Fabric A strips

Outer border: (2) 3" x 35 1/2" Fabric H strips, then (2) 3" x 40 1/2" Fabric H strips



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Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.

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
