Finished quilt size: 40 " $\times 40^{\prime \prime}$
Backing: 42" $\times 48^{\prime \prime}$ ( $13 / 8 y$ of $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide fabric
OR $2^{3 / 4}$ yards to allow overage for longarm quilting)
Suggested: SB20411-545


All seams $1 / 4$ ", WOF=Width of Fabric, LOF=Length of Fabric

## Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner Border \#1

Sew (1) $15 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 25$ 1/4" Fabric A strip to each side of $251 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 251 / 4$ " Fabric G quilt center, followed by (1) $15 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 271 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to the top and (1) to the bottom side of quilt center.

2. Inner Border \#2

Arrange and sew (9) assorted $31 / 2 " \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ print squares to make a column unit. Make (2) column units. Sew to the opposite sides of quilt center.


Arrange and sew (11) assorted $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ print squares to make a row unit. Make (2) row units. Sew to the top and bottom of quilt center.


## 3. Inner Border \#3 and Outer Border

Border strips - sew shorter strips to each side of quilt center, followed by longer strips to the top and bottom of quilt center:

Inner border \#3: (2) $11 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 331 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strips, then (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 351 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strips
Outer border: (2) 3 " $\times 351 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strips, then (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strips


## Triendship Path



Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
