

		(1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2 ½" x 3" rectangles.
		b. Tulip blocks
		(1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (24) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares.
		(1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 1 ¾" x 3" rectangles.

Fabric F SB20157-545	3/4y, including binding	 a. Snail blocks (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2 ½" x 6" rectangles. b. Tulip blocks (1) 4 ¼" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 4 ¼" x 5 ½" rectangles and (8) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. c. Binding (7) 2 ¼" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.
Fabric G SB20268-420	1/4y	 a. Snail blocks (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 6" rectangles. b. Tulip blocks (1) 4 1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" rectangles and (8) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.
Fabric H SB20268-520	1/8y	Snail blocks (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 6" rectangles.
Fabric I SB20268-820	3/8y	Sashing strips (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" strips.
Fabric J SB20411-545	5/8y	Outer border (6) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 49 ½" and (2) 3" x 54 ½" strips.
Fabric K SB20412-100	1y	Quilt center (1) 40 ½" and 33 ½" rectangle, centering design.

Constructing tulip blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" print square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 1 ¾" x 3" Fabric A rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 ½" x 1 ½" print square at the opposite corner. Make a total of (2) units.	
2. Sew step 1 units into a row unit. Add (1) 4 ¼" x 5 ½" print rectangle to the bottom of row unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom left corner of the sewn unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric A square at the bottom right corner of the same sewn unit.	
3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom left corner of (1) 2 ½" x 2 ¾" Fabric D rectangle, with the 2 ¾" side being the horizontal edge. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat using a 2 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric A square at the top right corner of the same Fabric D rectangle.	
4. Repeat step 3 to make a mirror-imaged unit. Sew both units to the opposite long sides of (1) 1" x 2 ½" Fabric D rectangle to make a row unit. Add row unit to the bottom of step 2 unit to complete (1) tulip block. Block measures 5 ½" x 7 ½" unfinished. Make (2) blocks each for Fabric C, F, G.	

Constructing snail blocks



Quilt Top Assembly

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric I strip to the top, and (1) 1 ½' x 40 ½" Fabric A strip to the bottom of Fabric K quilt center.



2. Arrange and sew together (2) snail blocks, (3) tulip blocks, (3) 1 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric A and (1) 7 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric A rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (2) pieced rows, referring to quilt image for block placement guide. Add pieced rows to the top and bottom of quilt center. Then, add another 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric I strip to the bottom.



3. Border strips: Sew longer strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by shorter strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

Inner border: Sew (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strips to sides of quilt center then (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strips to top and bottom of quilt center.

Outer border: Sew (2) 3" x 54 ½" Fabric J strips to sides of quilt center then (2) 3" x 49 ½" Fabric J strips to top and bottom of quilt center.





Finishing

- 1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
- 2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to complete the quilt.

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
