


Fabric & Cutting Chart

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting Directions
 Fabric A SB20053-101	1 1/8y	a. Snail blocks (1) 1" x WOF strip. Subcut (24) 1" x 1" squares and (4) 1" x 4" rectangles. (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 6", (4) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles and (12) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2 1/2" x 3" rectangles. b. Tulip blocks (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (24) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. (1) 1 3/4" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 1 3/4" x 3" rectangles. (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. c. Patch blocks (1) 7 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" and (2) 7 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. d. Sashing (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. e. Inner border (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" and (2) 2 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.
 Fabric B SB20053-520	1/8y	Snail blocks (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 6" rectangles.
 Fabric C SB20104-535	1/4y	Tulip blocks (1) 4 1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" rectangles and (8) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.
 Fabric D SB20104-835	1/8y	Tulip blocks (1) 1" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 1" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 3/4" rectangles.

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



 <p>Fabric E SB20157-310</p>	1/8y	<p>Snail blocks</p> <p>(1) 1" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 1" x 6 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>(1) 2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2" x 4" and (4) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles.</p>
 <p>Fabric F SB20157-545</p>	3/4y, including binding	<p>a. Snail blocks</p> <p>(1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2 1/2" x 6" rectangles.</p> <p>b. Tulip blocks</p> <p>(1) 4 1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" rectangles and (8) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.</p> <p>c. Binding</p> <p>(7) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.</p>
 <p>Fabric G SB20268-420</p>	1/4y	<p>a. Snail blocks</p> <p>(1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 6" rectangles.</p> <p>b. Tulip blocks</p> <p>(1) 4 1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" rectangles and (8) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.</p>
 <p>Fabric H SB20268-520</p>	1/8y	<p>Snail blocks</p> <p>(1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 6" rectangles.</p>
 <p>Fabric I SB20268-820</p>	3/8y	<p>Sashing strips</p> <p>(2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips.</p>
 <p>Fabric J SB20411-545</p>	5/8y	<p>Outer border</p> <p>(6) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 49 1/2" and (2) 3" x 54 1/2" strips.</p>
 <p>Fabric K SB20412-100</p>	1y	<p>Quilt center</p> <p>(1) 40 1/2" and 33 1/2" rectangle, centering design.</p>

Constructing tulip blocks

<p>1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$" x $1\frac{1}{2}$" print square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $1\frac{3}{4}$" x 3" Fabric A rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another $1\frac{1}{2}$" x $1\frac{1}{2}$" print square at the opposite corner. Make a total of (2) units.</p>	
<p>2. Sew step 1 units into a row unit. Add (1) $4\frac{1}{4}$" x $5\frac{1}{2}$" print rectangle to the bottom of row unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$" x $1\frac{1}{2}$" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom left corner of the sewn unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another $1\frac{1}{2}$" x $1\frac{1}{2}$" Fabric A square at the bottom right corner of the same sewn unit.</p>	
<p>3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$" x $1\frac{1}{2}$" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom left corner of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$" x $2\frac{3}{4}$" Fabric D rectangle, with the $2\frac{3}{4}$" side being the horizontal edge. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat using a $2\frac{1}{2}$" x $2\frac{1}{2}$" Fabric A square at the top right corner of the same Fabric D rectangle.</p>	
<p>4. Repeat step 3 to make a mirror-imaged unit. Sew both units to the opposite long sides of (1) 1" x $2\frac{1}{2}$" Fabric D rectangle to make a row unit. Add row unit to the bottom of step 2 unit to complete (1) tulip block. Block measures $5\frac{1}{2}$" x $7\frac{1}{2}$" unfinished.</p> <p>Make (2) blocks each for Fabric C, F, G.</p>	

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Constructing snail blocks

<p>1. Sew together the following rectangles: (1) 1 ½" x 6" Fabric G, (1) 1 ½" x 6" Fabric H, (1) 1 ½" x 6" Fabric B and (1) 2 ½" x 6" Fabric F. Unit measures 5 ½" (horizontal) x 6" (vertical). Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of the sewn unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric A square at the top right, and (2) 1" x 1" Fabric A squares at the bottom left and bottom right corners of the same unit.</p>	
<p>2. Add (1) 1 ½" x 6" Fabric A rectangle to the right of step 1 unit, followed by (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric A rectangle to the top.</p>	
<p>3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1" x 1" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 1" x 6 ½" Fabric E rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Add sewn unit to the bottom of step 2 unit.</p>	
<p>4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1" x 1" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of (1) 2" x 4" Fabric E rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1" x 1" Fabric A square at the top right corner of the same Fabric E rectangle. Add (1) 1" x 4" Fabric A rectangle to the right of sewn unit, followed by (1) 2 ½" x 3" Fabric A rectangle to the top.</p>	
<p>5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1" x 1" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at the top right corner of (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric E rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric A square at the bottom left corner of the same Fabric E rectangle.</p>	
<p>6. Sew step 5 unit to the bottom of step 4 unit. Then, add to the left of step 3 unit to complete (1) snail block. Block measures 8 ½" x 7 ½" unfinished. Make a total of (2) blocks.</p> <p>Repeat to make (2) mirror-imaged blocks. Note individual unit construction.</p>	

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Quilt Top Assembly

1. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top, and (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to the bottom of Fabric K quilt center.



2. Arrange and sew together (2) snail blocks, (3) tulip blocks, (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A and (1) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (2) pieced rows, referring to quilt image for block placement guide. Add pieced rows to the top and bottom of quilt center. Then, add another $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the bottom.



3. Border strips: Sew longer strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by shorter strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

Inner border: Sew (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strips to sides of quilt center then (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strips to top and bottom of quilt center.

Outer border: Sew (2) 3" x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strips to sides of quilt center then (2) 3" x $49\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strips to top and bottom of quilt center.



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Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.

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
