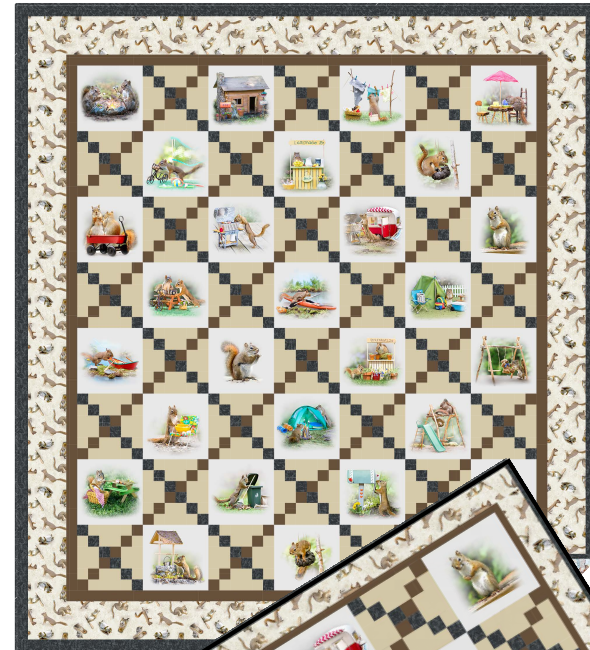

# Secrets

Before you begin, please read all the instructions carefully. I recommend decreasing your stitch length (from 2.5 to 2.0) as we are going to be pressing our seams open to decrease bulk. All seams are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise noted. Lightly starching when pressing seams open helps the seam stay flat.

SC means to sub-cut your strips into smaller units.

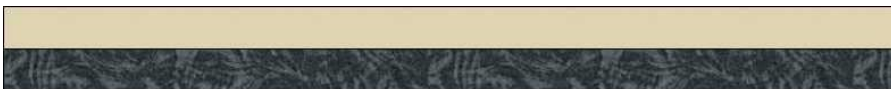
Quilt instructions are in Red, Table Runner instructions are in Blue, Placemat instructions are in Black

## Cutting Instructions:

| <b>Allover Fabric:</b><br>cut strips for 2nd border   | (6) 4" strips by WOF                          | (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips by WOF           | (12) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips by WOF SC into<br>(12) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ "<br>(12) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $23\frac{1}{2}$ " |

## Unit & Block Construction:

**Step 1:** Using (4,1,3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Accent 1 strips and (4,1,3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Background strips make (4,1,3) of the strip set below. Press seams open.



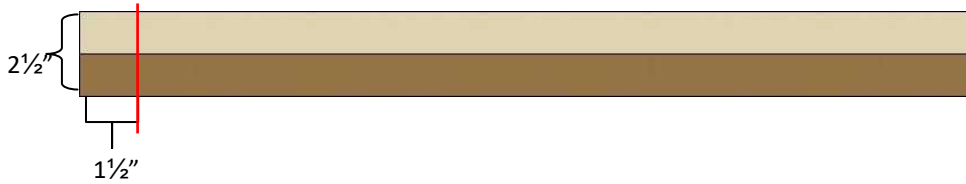
**Step 2:** Cut the Step 1 units into (112,28,72)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.



**Step 3:** Using (4,1,3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Accent 2 strips and (4,1,3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Background strips make (4,1,3) of the strip set below. Press seams open.



**Step 4:** Cut the **Step 3** units into (112,28,72) 1½" x 2½" rectangles.



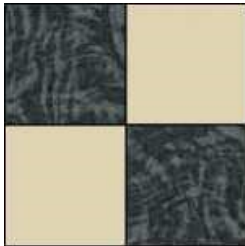
**Step 5:** Using (2,1,2) 1½" Accent 1 strips and (2,1,2) 1½" Accent 2 strips make (2,1,2) of the strip set below. Press seams open.



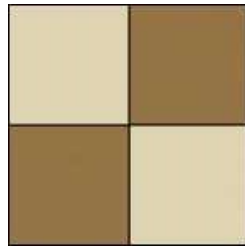
**Step 6:** Cut the **Step 5** units into (56,14,36) 1½" x 2½" rectangles.



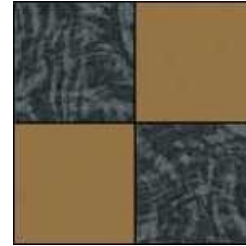
**Step 7:** Using the **Step 2** units, the **Step 4** units and the **Step 6** units make the 4-patch units below. Press seams open.

**Step 8:** Using the **Step 7** units and the 2½" background squares make the block below. Press row seams toward background squares and press final seams open.

# Assembly Instructions:

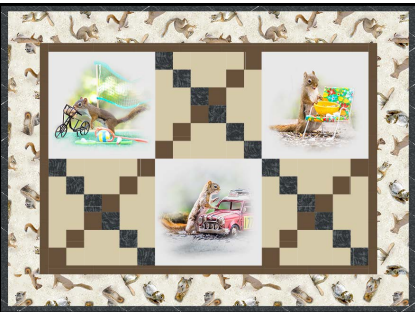
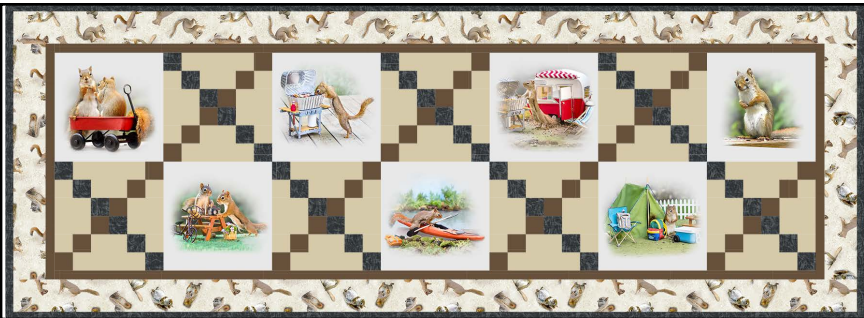
**Step 9:** Using the **Step 8** Blocks and the 6½" Panel pictures layout your project as seen below. Sew into rows and press seams toward the pictures. Sew the rows together and press seams open.

**Step 10:** Add the 1st, 2nd and 3rd (quilt only) Borders. Press seams away from quilt center.



**Step 11:** Layer Backing, Batting & top and quilt as desired.

**Step 12:** Bind your project with your preferred width binding.

**Step 13:** Enjoy!!
