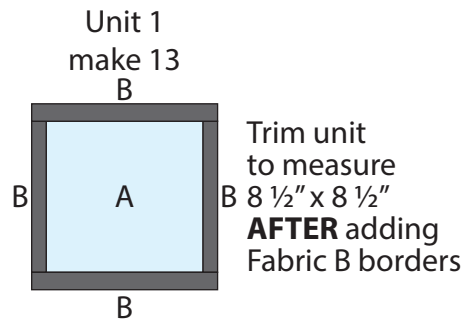

A	Country Christmas Boxes 14003-99 Multi	2/3 yd	Fussy cut (13) 7-1/4" x 7" rectangles, each centered on a box.	
B	Jolly Snow 14011-12 Black	2/3 yd	(7) 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) 1-3/4" x 9-1/4" strips. (5) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) 1-1/2" x 7" strips.	
C	Jolly Plaid 14007-10 Red	3/4 yd	(7) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. (7) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips.	
D	Jolly Snowmen 14004-55 Sky Blue	3/8 yd	(2) 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5-1/2" squares.	
E	Holly Jolly Lights 14010-09 White	1 yd	(7) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3" x 5-1/2" strips. (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips.*	
F	Jolly Plaid 14007-44 Green	2/3 yd	(7) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 3" squares.	
G	Holiday Drinks 14001-55 Sky Blue	1/2 yd	(4) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3" squares.	
H	Jolly Candy Canes 14012-12 Black	5/8 yd	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.*	
I	Country Christmas Stripe 14002-99 Multi	1-2/3 yds	(4) 6-1/2" x 56 1/2" LOF strips.	
J	Jolly Red Trucks 14008-12 Black	1/4 yd	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6-1/2" squares.	
K	Jolly Snow 14011-10 Red	5/8 yd	(7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, BINDING.	

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

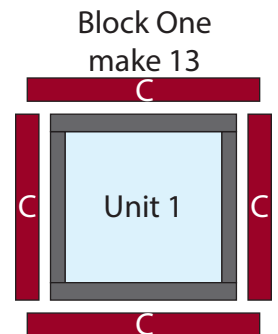
BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 7" strip to each side of (1) **A** 7-1/4" x 7" rectangle. Sew (1) **B** 1-3/4" x 9-1/4" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** rectangle to make (1) **Unit 1** square. **Trim the unit to measure 8-1/2" x 8-1/2"**. Repeat to make (13) **Unit 1** squares total.



2. Sew (1) **C** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **Unit 1** square. Sew (1) **C** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Unit 1** square to make (1) **Block One** square. Repeat to make (13) **Block One** squares total.



3. Place (1) **F** 3" square on the left side of (1) **E** 3" x 5-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

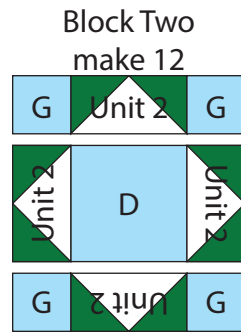


4. Place another **F** 3" square on the right side of the **E** 3" x 5-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 2** strip.

5. Repeat **Steps 3-4** to make (48) **Unit 2** strips total.



6. Sew (1) **G** 3" square to each end of (1) **Unit 2** strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) **Unit 2** strip to each side of (1) **D** 5-1/2" square to make the middle row. Sew together (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10-1/2" **Block Two** square. Repeat to make (12) **Block Two** squares total.

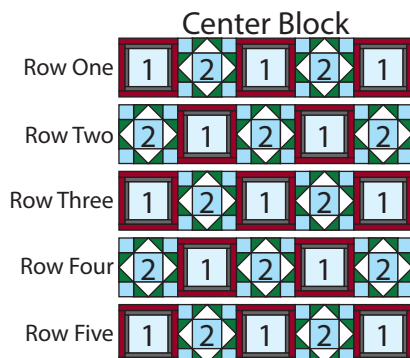


QUILT ASSEMBLY

7. Sew together (3) **Block One** squares and (2) **Block Two** squares, alternating them from left to right, to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three** and **Row Five**.

8. Sew together (3) **Block Two** squares and (2) **Block One** squares, alternating them from left to right, to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four**.

9. Sew together the (5) **Rows** from **Steps 7-8**, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 50-1/2" x 50-1/2" **Center Block**.



BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE H, E AND I BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

10. Sew (1) **H** 2-1/2" x (50-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **H** 2-1/2" x (54-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

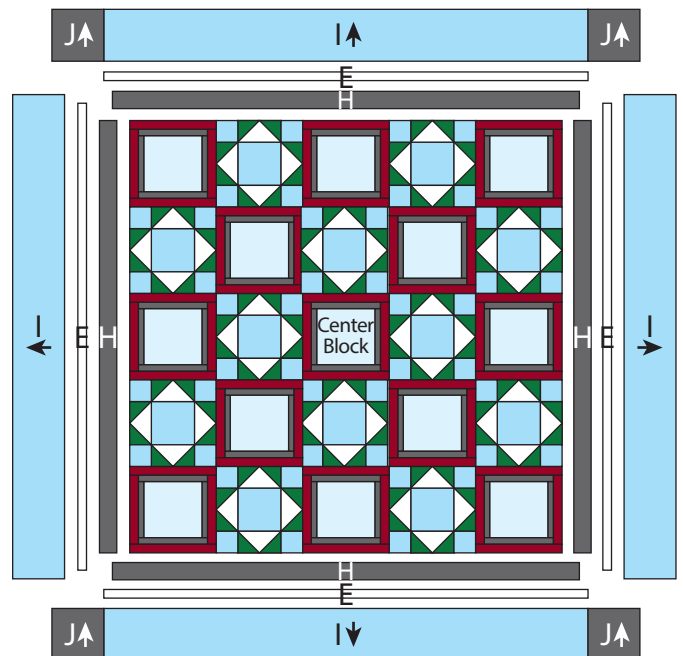
11. Sew (1) **E** 1-1/2" x (54-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **E** 1-1/2" x (56-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

12. Sew (1) **I** 6-1/2" x (56-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **J** 6-1/2" square to each end of (1) **I** 6-1/2" x (56-1/2") strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 68" x 68"
