## CENTER STAR BLOCK

1. Large Half-Square Triangle Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) M 13-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) C 13-1/2" square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press.
2. Large Quarter-Square Triangle Unit: Similar to HST unit assembly, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) CM HST unit, perpendicular to seam. Place HST unit, right sides together, with second HST unit, contrasting fabrics. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) OST units. Open and press. Trim units to $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square unfinished. Make 4.

3. SMALL QST UNIT

3. Small Half/Quarter Square Triangle Unit: Similar to step 1 and 2 large HST and OST unit assembly, make small units using $\mathbf{C}$ and $\mathbf{M} 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Trim OST units to $4-1 / 2$ " squares unfinished. Make 4.
4. Center Star Rows: Sew (1) M 4-1/2" square to each side of (1) CM small QST unit. Note proper rotation of QST unit. Make (2) Row 1 units. Sew (1) CM small QST unit to each side of (1) C 4-1/2" square. Note proper rotation of QST units. Make (1) Row 2.

MAKE 1 ROW 2 UNITS
5. Center Star Unit: Sew Row 1 units to top and bottom of Row 2. Square block to 12-1/2".
6. Star Block Rows: Sew (1) M 12-1/2" square to each side of (1) large CM QST unit. Note proper rotation of QST unit. Make (2) Row 3 units. Sew (1) CM large OST unit to each side of Center Star Unit. Note proper rotation of QST units. Make (1) Row 4.

MAKE 1 ROW 4 UNIT
7. Star Block: Sew Row 3 units to top and bottom of Row 4. Square block to 36-1/2" .

## PINWHEEL BLOCKS


8. Pinwheel HST Units: Similar to step 1 HST assembly make (4) AM HSTs, using A and M 4" squares. Trim HSTs to 3-1/2" square unfinished.
9. Pinwheel Square: Sew together (4) AM HSTs into a pinwheel unit as shown. Note proper rotation of HST unit. Square to $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
10. Pinwheel Block: Sew (1) M 1-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the opposite sides of pinwheel unit, followed by (1) M 1-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to top and bottom of pinwheel unit. Square block to 8-1/2" unfinished. Make 2.

11. Similar to AM pinwheel block assembly, make the following pinwheel blocks as shown.

## PINWHEEL BLOCKS

12. Pinwheel Side Borders: Sew together BM / FM / AM / BM and JM pinwheel blocks as shown. Make (2) units total.

13. Pinwheel Top/Bottom Border: Sew together DM / HM / LM / KM / EM / IM and HM pinwheel blocks as shown. Make (2) units total.

## QUILT TOP / BORDER ASSEMBLY

14. Inner Border 1: Sew (1) M 1-1/2" $\times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the opposite sides of center star block, followed by (1) M 1-1/2" $\times 38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom of star block.
15. Inner Border 2: Sew (1) G 1-1/2"x $38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (1) G 1-1/2" $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom of quilt center.
16. Pinwheel Border: Sew (1) Pinwheel Side Border to the opposite side of quilt center, followed by Top and Bottom Pinwheel borders. Note proper rotation and placement of border units.
17. Outer Border: Sew (1) G $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (1) G $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to to top and bottom of quilt center.


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using A 2-1/4" strips.
