BATIK FAVORITES

Fabric Collection – *Line Work* Finished Size – 80" x 96" WOF = width of fabric

Requirements & Cutting Instructions:

80980-10 - Background	4 1/2 yds	Cut $19 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; sub-cut $80 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and $160 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles Cut $16 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; sub-cut $160 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares; join remaining six strips together end-to-end for Middle Border Cut $6 - 3$ " x WOF strips; sub-cut $80 - 3$ " squares; then cut each square diagonally once into 160 triangles

80985-99 Color Placement 2 (CP2)	1 1/3 yds	Cut $10 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; sub-cut $160 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares Cut $7 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips (set aside for Outer Border) Cut $9 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips (set aside for Binding)
81000-442 Color Placement 3 (CP3)	3/4 yd	Cut 3 – 4 ½" x WOF strips; sub-cut 20 – 4 ½" squares Cut 6 – 2 ½" x WOF strips (set aside for Inner Border)

Block Instructions:

- NOTE: Make two blocks using each of the 10 Color Placement 1 (CP1) fabrics. All seams sewn using ¼" seam allowance
 - Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on 2 2 ½" Background squares. Place one square on each side of a 2 ½" x 4 ½" CP1 rectangle. Sew on the marked lines. Trim ¼" from the line and press to the outer edges to complete Unit 1. Repeat to make eight Unit 1's for each of 10 CP1 fabrics.
 - 2. Using $1 2\frac{1}{2}$ " CP2 square and 2 Background triangles, line up the right angle of the triangle with the corner of the square. Sew and press. Line up another triangle to the diagonal opposite corner of the square. Sew and press.
 - Sew a CP1 triangle to the corner unit made in Step 2, matching centers, and press. Square up to 4 ½" to complete Unit 2. Repeat to make eight Unit 2's for each of the 10 CP1 fabrics.
 - 4. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on 4 2 ½" CP1 squares. Place one square in each corner of a 4 ½" CP3 square. Sew on the marked lines. Trim ¼" from each line and press to the outer edges to complete Unit 3. Repeat to make two Unit 3's for each of the 10 CP1 fabrics.
 - 5. Referring to the finished quilt image, arrange blocks in five rows of four blocks each. Sew blocks together to complete rows. Then sew rows together to complete quilt center.
 - 6. Join the 6 2 ½" x WOF Inner Border strips together end to end. Measure the length of the quilt top and cut two Inner Border strips. Sew to sides of quilt. Measure the width of the quilt top and cut two Inner Border strips. Sew to top & bottom of quilt top.
 - 7. Join the 6 − 2 ½" x WOF Middle Border strips together end to end. Repeat Step 6 to add Middle Border to quilt top.
 - 8. Join the 7 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Outer Border strips together end to end. Repeat Step 6 to add Outer Border.
 - 9. Join the 9 − 2 ½" x WOF Binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold strip in half wrong sides together across the length of the strip and press to prepare binding.
 - 10. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
