

Fabric A: CAME 5040 B	3/8 yard
Fabric B: CAME 5041 B	1/4 yard
Fabric C: CAME 5041 P	1/4 yard
Fabric D: CAME 5042 BC	3/8 yard
Fabric E: CAME 5042 P	3/8 yard
Fabric F: SUE6 302 BB	1/2 yard
Fabric G: SUE7 303 EW	1 3/4 yards
Backing: CAME 5040 B suggested	1 3/4 yards
Batting	41" x 58"

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut two 4 1/2" strips. Using the 60° line on a clear, plastic ruler, cut the end of one strip at 60°. Using that edge, cut ten diamonds at 4 1/2" increments. You should be able to get 6-7 diamonds per strip. (Large Diamonds)

From Fabric B:

1. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Following the same process as for Fabric A, cut five 60° diamonds. (Large Diamonds)

From Fabric C:

1. Cut two 2 1/2" strips. (Strip Sets for Small Diamonds)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut five 1 1/2" strips; subcut two 1 1/2" x 29 5/8" strips from two strips. Sew remaining strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips. (4th Border)
2. Cut one 2" strip; subcut four 2" squares. (4th Border Cornerstones)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut four 1 1/2" strips; subcut two 1 1/2" x 25 5/8" strips and two 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips. If you are unable to cut 42 1/2" from one strip, sew remaining pieces from shorter strips to create a longer strip, then cut. (2nd Border)
2. Cut one 2" strip; subcut four 2" squares. (4th Border Cornerstones)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut five 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

From Fabric G:

1. Cut eleven 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 23 5/8" strips, two 1 1/2" x 27 5/8" strips, two 1 1/2" x 33 5/8" strips, two 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips, two 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips. (1st, 3rd & 5th Borders)
2. Cut one 2" strip; subcut eight 2" squares. (Border Cornerstones)
3. Cut two 2 1/2" strips. (Strip Sets for Small Diamonds)
4. Cut nine 3 1/2" strips; subcut fifty 3 1/2" x 6" rectangles. Cut twenty-five rectangles diagonally to create fifty triangles. Cut remaining rectangles **at the opposite angle** to create fifty reverse triangles. **Note:** triangles are cut oversized to allow for trimming completed block to size.

Piecing Instructions:

Small Diamond Blocks

1. Sew one 2 1/2" C strip to one 2 1/2" G strip. Press toward C. Repeat. Using the 60° line on a clear, plastic ruler, cut one end of strip sets at 60°. Using that edge, cut twenty segments at 2 1/2" increments.
2. Sew two Step 1 segments together to complete one pieced diamond; press. Repeat to make ten diamonds. (Figure 1)



Make 10.

3. Sew one 3 1/2" x 6" G triangle to opposite sides of one pieced diamond. Press seams open or toward triangles. Sew one 3 1/2" x 6" reverse triangle to remaining sides of diamond; press.

- Trim Step 3 block to 5 1/8" x 8 1/2" centering diamond within block. Seam allowance should be 1/4" away from all seam points. Repeat to complete ten blocks. (Figure 2)

Large Diamond Blocks

- Sew one 3 1/2" x 6" G triangle to opposite sides of one A diamond. Press seams open or toward triangles. Sew one 3 1/2" x 6" reverse triangle to remaining sides of diamond; press.
- Trim Step 1 block to 5 1/8" x 8 1/2" centering diamond within block. Seam allowance should be 1/4" away from all seam points. Repeat to complete ten blocks.
- Repeat Steps 1 & 2 using five B diamonds.

Quilt Assembly:

- Referring to Quilt Diagram, sew blocks into rows matching side points of diamond blocks. Press seams open.
- Sew rows together and press seams open.
- Draw a diagonal line on the back side of each 2" G square. With right sides together, place one marked square with one 2" D square. Sew 1/4" to each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the line and press toward D. Use a small ruler with a 45° line to square units to 1 1/2". Repeat to make eight half-square-triangle units.
- Repeat Step 3 using 2" E squares. (Figure 3)






Make 8 of each.
1 1/2" x 1 1/2" unfinished.

- First Border: Sew one 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" G strip to both sides of quilt center. Press toward G. Referring to Quilt Diagram for placement, sew one E/G half-square-triangle unit to both ends of each 1 1/2" x 23 5/8" G strip. Press toward the G strip. Sew one pieced strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward G strip.
- Second Border: Repeat Step 5 using 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" and 1 1/2" x 25 5/8" E strips.
- Third Border: Repeat Step 5 using 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" and 1 1/2" x 27 5/8" G strips with D/G half-square-triangle units.
- Fourth Border: Repeat Step 7 using 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" and 1 1/2" x 29 5/8" D strips.
- Outer Border: Sew one 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" G strip to both sides of the quilt. Press toward G. Sew one 1 1/2" x 33 5/8" G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt; press.

Finishing:

- Press backing fabric well.
- Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- Quilt as desired.
- Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners. If desired, mark and cut each corner with a rounded edge. Use a plate or other method to mark the curves. Be sure to center the curves using the miter seam as your guide.
- Join five 2 1/2" F binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
- Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.


