Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is $1 / 4$. Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1.

## Flower Centers and Blocks

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the F2-A squares.
2. Place an F2-A square, RST, over an F1-A square. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from either side of the marked line. Press. Trim to $2^{\prime \prime}$. Make 4 HSTs.
3. Sew the HSTs into pairs, as shown. Press.
4. Sew 2 matching HST pairs together. Press.
5. Mark a diagonal line on both F2-C squares.
6. Place an F2-C square, RST, over the bottom left corner of the F1-B rectangle. Sew along the diagonal mark. Trim 1/4" away from seam. Press away from the rectangle.
7. Repeat step 7 on the bottom right corner.
8. Sew the HST pairs from step 4 to the top of the step 7 unit. Press towards F1.
9. Make (3) F1/F2 flower units.
10. Repeat steps 1-9 to make the other flower centers, as shown to the right.
11. Sew an F2-D rectangle to the left and right side of the Flower Center 1 unit. Press away from center.

12. Sew an F2-E rectangle to the top and bottom of the step 11 unit. Press away from Steps 11-12 center.
13. Sew an F3-F rectangle to the left and right side of the step 12 unit. Press away from the center.
14. Sew an F3-G rectangle to the top and bottom of the step 13 unit. Press away from the center.


Steps 13-14
15. Sew an F4-H rectangle to the left and right of the step 14 unit. Press away from the center.
16. Sew an F4-I rectangle to the top and bottom of the step 15 unit. Press away from the center.
17. Repeat steps11-16 to make a total of 3 flower blocks. Block finishes at 14-1/2" square.
18. Repeat steps 11-16 to make the remaining flower blocks, as shown below.

## Heart Block Centers

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the F1-C and F1-K squares.
2. Place an F1-C square, RST, over the top left corner of the F4-J rectangle. Sew along the diagonal mark. Trim 1/4" away from seam. Press away from the rectangle. Make 2.
3. Repeat step 3 on the right top of the F4-J rectangle. Make 2.
4. Place an F1-K square, RST, over the bottom of the F4-J rectangle. Pay attention to the direction of the marked line. Sew along the diagonal mark. Trim 1/4" away from seam. Press away from the rectangle.

5. Repeat step 4, making sure to pay attention to the direction of the diagonal. Make 2.
6. Sew the steps 2-5 together, to make a heart. Press seam open. Make 3 total.
7. Repeat steps 1-6 to make the other heart centers.

## Heart Blocks

1. Sew an F1-D rectangle to the top and bottom of the heart center unit. Press away from center.
2. Sew an F1-E rectangle to the left and right side of the step 1 unit. Press away from center
3. Sew an F2-F rectangle to the top and bottom of the step 2 unit. Press away from the center.
4. Sew an F2-G rectangle to the left and right side of the step 3 unit. Press away from the center.
5. Sew an $\mathrm{F} 3-\mathrm{H}$ rectangle to the top and bottom of the step 4 unit. Press away


Steps 1-2
 from the center.
6. Sew an F3-I rectangle to the left and right side of the step 5 unit. Press away from the center.
7. Repeat steps 1-6 to make a total of 3 Heart 1 blocks. Blocks finish at 14-1/2" square.
8. Repeat steps 1-6 to make the remaining heart blocks, as shown below.

Row 2: Heart Block 3 - Flower Block 3 - Heart Block 4 - Flower Block 4
Row 3: Flower Block 2 - Heart Block 2 - Flower Block 1 - Heart Block 1
Row 4: Heart Block 4 - Flower Block 4 - Heart Block 3 - Flower Block 3
Row 5: *same as row 1

## Top Assembly

1. Lay out the quilt blocks as shown below. Make (2) of Row 1.
2. Sew blocks into rows. Press in one direction to nest seams.
3. Sew rows together. Press.
4. Sew the side borders to the quilt top. Press.
5. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt top. Press.


Bottom Border $2.5 \times 60.5$

## Finishing

1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
