A		53608-5 Ruby	3/8	STAR BLOCKS: (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2-1/2" squares (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. CORNERSTONES: (1) 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (14) 1-1/2" squares.
В		53603-1 Pine	1/2	CORNER AND SETTING TRIANGLES: (1) 12-5/8" square. Cut twice diagonally to yield 4 setting triangles. (2) 6-5/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to yield 4 corner triangles.
С		53608-2 Ivory	3/8	STAR BLOCKS: (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 2-1/2" x 1-1/2" rectangles and (24) 2-1/2" squares. (1) 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 1-1/2" squares.
D		53606-3 Black	1/4	STAR BLOCKS: (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (3) 2-1/2" squares. (1) 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (24) 1-1/2" squares.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- **1. Flying Geese Unit:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **D** 1-1/2" square. Place **D** square right sides together on the left side of (1) **C** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle. Stitch on drawn line. Trim 1/4" from sewn line and press open. Repeat for right side. Make (12) **CD** flying geese units.
- 2. Similar to CD flying geese units make AC units, using A 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles and C 2-1/2" squares. Make (12) AC large flying geese units.




3. Sew (1) **C** 1-1/2" square to right and left side of (1) **CD** flying geese unit. Make (6) **C/CD** units. Repeat step for **AC** flying geese units, using **A** 2-1/2" squares. Make (6) **A/AC** units.





4. Center Star: Sew (1) **CD** flying geese unit to opposite sides of (1) **D** 2-1/2" square. Sew (1) **C/CD** units to top and bottom.




Note rotation of units.

5. Star Block: Sew (1) **AC** flying geese unit to opposite sides of (1) Center Star unit as shown. Sew (1) **A/AC** unit to top and bottom. Square block to 8-1/2". Add (1) **E** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" sashing strip to each side of block.



Make (3) Star Blocks



6. Sashing Unit: Sew (1) **A** 1-1/2" square to both ends of (1) **E** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Make (2).



7. Sew together (3) A 1-1/2" squares and (2) E 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles as shown. Make (2) sets.




RUNNER ASSEMBLY Runner is assembled diagonally

8. Arrange Star Blocks, **B** Corner and Setting Triangles and **AE** sashing strips into five diagonal rows as shown. Sew rows together.



When runner top is sewn, carefully trim excess 1/4" away shown in diagram below. The dotted line is the sewing line and the solid line is the cutting line.



Runner Top should measure about 13" x 38".

BORDER ASSEMBLY

9. Sew (1) $\bf A$ 1-1/2" square to both ends of (1) $\bf E$ 1-1/2" x 13" rectangle. Make (2) $\bf AE$ units.



10. Inner Border: Sew (1) **E** 1-1/2" x 38" strip to each side of runner top, followed by (1) **AE** unit to top and bottom as shown.

11. Outer Border: Sew (1) **F** 4-1/2" \times 40" strip to each side of runner top, followed by (1) **F** 4-1/2" \times 23" strip to top and bottom to complete top.



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **E** 2-1/4" strips.
