BLOCK 1

Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) K 5" square. Place square, right sides together (RST), at a corner of (1) A 9-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal K corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional K 5" squares on the remaining corners of the same A square to complete Block 1. Make (17).



Draw diagonal line on wrong side of **K** square.



Sew on drawn line and trim 1/4" away from sewn line.



Open and press to reveal **K** corner triangle.



Add three more corner triangles. Make (17).

BLOCK 2


2. Unit 1: Similar to Step 1, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) K 2-3/4" square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) I 2-3/4" x 5" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal K corner triangle. Repeat with (1) additional K 2-3/4" square at the diagonally opposite corner of the same I rectangle to complete Unit 1. Make (4).

Unit 2: Repeat Step 2 using (2) K 2-3/4" squares and (1) B 2-3/4" x 5" rectangle. Make (4).












Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" and open to reveal **K** corner triangle. Repeat on diagonally opposite corner of **I**.

3. Sew (1) Unit 1 on top of (1) Unit 2. Make (4).




4. Sew together to make (1) Block 2, measuring 9-1/2" square unfinished. Make (4).







- 6. Alternating, arrange and sew (2) Block 1 and (3) Block 2 to make a pieced row. Make (4) row #1.
- 7. In the same way, arrange and sew together (3) Block 1 and (2) Block 2 to make a pieced row. Make (3) row #2.
- 8. Sew together pieced #1 and #2 rows to make quilt center.
- 9. Sew (2) K 2-1/2" x 63-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) K 2-1/2" x 49-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



QUILT ASSEMBLY



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **J** 2-1/4" strips.
