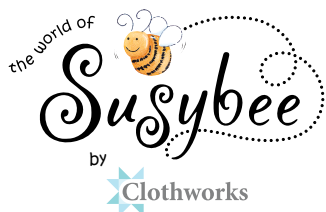

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

Finished quilt size: 44" x 50"

Suggested Backing: SB20415-815, 52" x 58" (3y of 42" wide fabric, horizontal seam)






Fabric & Cutting Chart

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting Directions
 Fabric A SB20417-760	1y (1 panel)	Quilt center (1) 34 1/2" x 40 1/2" rectangle, centering design.
 Fabric B SB20103-430	1/8y each	Border #2 blocks (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip from each fabric. Subcut (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
 Fabric D SB20171-845		
 Fabric H SB20268-820		
 Fabric C SB20103-760	5/8y, includes binding	a. Border #2 blocks (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. b. Binding (6) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a binding strip.

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 <p>Fabric E SB20053-106</p>	<p>3/4y</p>	<p>a. Inner border #1 (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 34 1/2" strips from (2) WOF strips. Use the leftovers to piece with remaining (2) WOF strips and subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.</p> <p>b. Inner border #2 (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (44) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.</p> <p>c. Inner border #3 (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.</p>
 <p>Fabric F SB20157-310</p>	<p>1/8y</p>	<p>Border #2 blocks (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.</p>
 <p>Fabric G SB20415-760</p>	<p>3/8y</p>	<p>Outer border (3) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.</p>

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Quilt Top Assembly





1. Inner border #1: Sew (2) 2 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric E strips to the left and right sides of 34 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric A quilt center. Sew (2) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric E strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

2. Inner border #2: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric E square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" print rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 2 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric E square at the opposite corner of the same print rectangle to make (1) flying-geese unit.

Refer to quilt image for unit placement guide, arrange and sew together units to make a pieced row. Make a total of (2) rows and sew to the top and bottom quilt center.



Make a total number of units in the following prints:

6 units Fabric F 	4 units Fabric B 	4 units Fabric C 	4 units Fabric D 	4 units Fabric H 
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3. Inner border #3: Sew (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric E strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

4. Outer border: Sew (2) 3 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric G strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
