Throw Quilt: 63" x 75"

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SENTIMENTS

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (10) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric B - Cut (1) 35" strip. Referring to quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (8) 2" x 35" strips. Sew 2 strips together end to end and trim to (1) 2" x 67" border. In the same manner, make a second 2" x 67" and (2) 2" x 55" borders.

Fabric C - Cut (4) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (40) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces
Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (20) 4" squares

Fabric D - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (40) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (7) 6-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (4) 6-1/2" x 63-1/2" borders

Fabrics F, J, and L - From each fabric:
Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (20) 4" squares

Fabric G - Cut (10) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (40) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces and (40) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (20) 4" squares
Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (40) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (7) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (80) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric K - Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (20) 4" squares
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

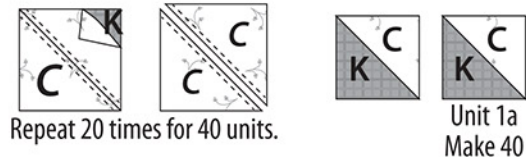
2. Piecing Order:

1. On the wrong side of all **Fabrics C, F, and H** 4" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.

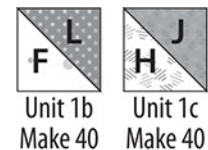


Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Arrange a marked **Fabric C** 4" square right sides together with a **Fabric K** 4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 3-1/2" square. Make a total of 40 Unit 1a.



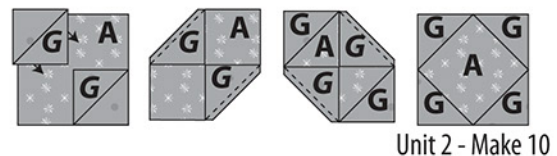
3. In the same manner, make 40 each Units 1b and 1c with fabrics indicated.



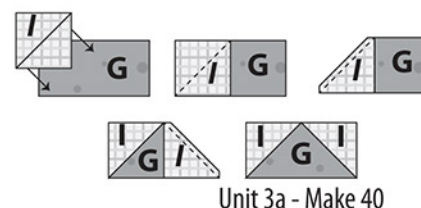
4. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabrics D, G, H,** and **I** 3-1/2" squares.



5. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric G** 3-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric A** 6-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 10 Unit 2 (6-1/2" square unfinished).



6. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 3-1/2" square on 1 end of a **Fabric G** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on opposite end of the **Fabric G** piece. Make a total of 40 Unit 3a (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).



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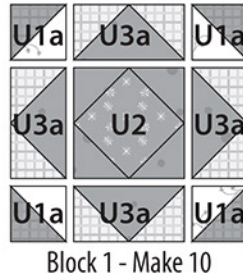
7. In the same manner, make 40 Unit 3b with fabrics indicated.



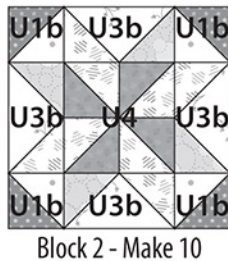
8. Arrange 4 Unit 1c in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 10 Unit 4 (6-1/2" square unfinished).



9. Arrange 4 Unit 1a, 1 Unit 2, and 4 Unit 3a in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 10 **Block 1** (12-1/2" square unfinished)



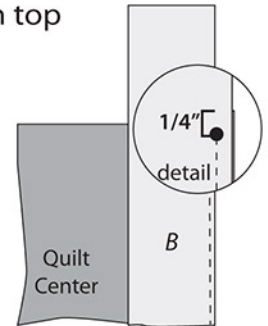
10. Arrange 4 Unit 1b, 4 Unit 3b, and 1 Unit 4 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 10 **Block 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

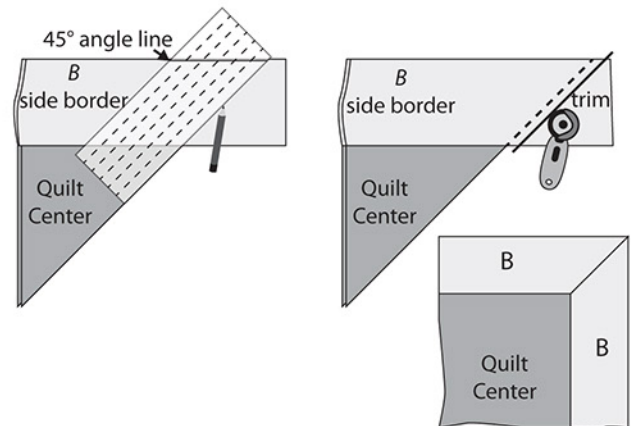
12. Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (48-1/2" x 60-1/2" unfinished).

13. Center **Fabric B** 2" x 67" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 2" x 55" borders on top and bottom of quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

14. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



15. Sew **Fabric E** 6-1/2" x 63-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric E** 6-1/2" x 63-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

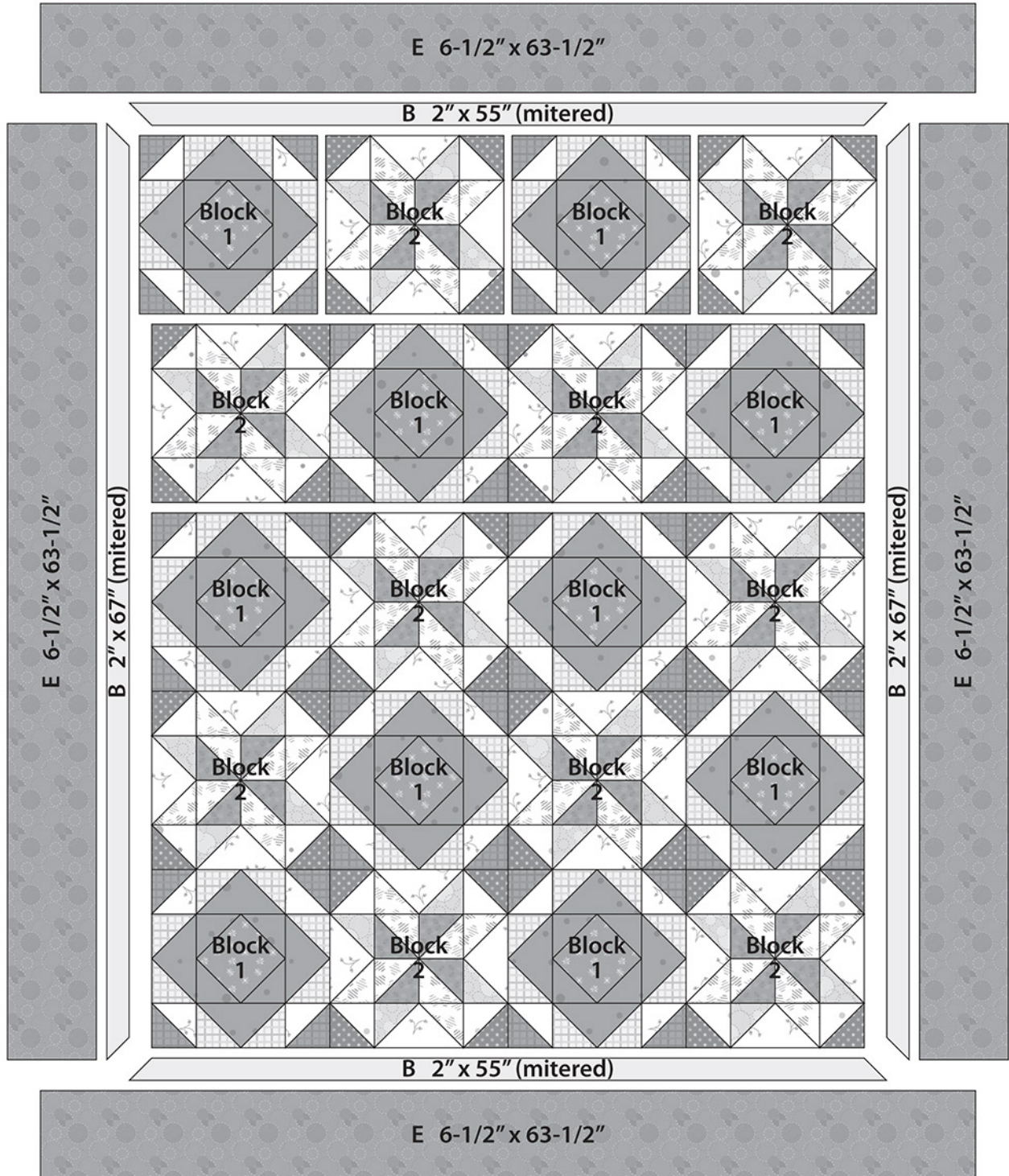
16. The quilt measures approximately 63-1/2" x 75-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

17. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric K**) and enjoy!!

Border measurements are the cut size.



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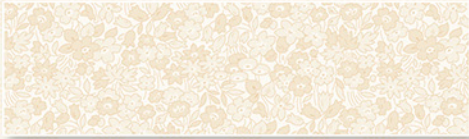
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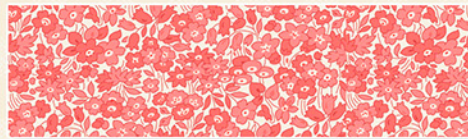

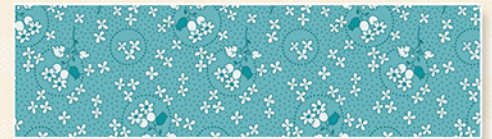
