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## SMALL TREE BLOCKS

## Flying Geese Units

1. Unit 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place square right sides together, at a corner of (1) C 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press. Repeat for opposite corner as shown.
2. Sew (1) $\mathbf{A} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to short sides of $\mathbf{A} / \mathbf{C}$ Flying Geese unit to make Unit 1.


Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" and open to reveal A corner triangle.
Repeat on opposite corner.

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3. Unit 2: Repeat step 1 (Flying Geese) using (2) A 2-1/2" squares and (1) C $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Add (1) A 1 " $\times 2-1 / 2$ " to short sides to complete Unit 2.
4. Unit 3: Sew (2) A 1-1/2" $\times 3$ " rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) | 1-1/2" square. UNIT 2

5. Sew Units 1-3 together, as shown, then add (1) $\mathbf{A} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top of sewn unit, trim to $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (5) A/C Small Tree Blocks.
6. Repeat Steps 1-5 to make following A/D and A/H Small Tree Blocks:

Step 6


Make (3) A/D


Make (4) A/H

## BIG TREE BLOCKS

7. Similar to Small Tree Block assembly make A/F and A/G Big Tree Blocks.

Unit 1: Use (2) A 2-1/2" squares and (1) G 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make a flying geese unit. Then add (2) $\mathbf{A} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the short sides to complete Unit 1.

Unit 2: Use (2) A 2-1/2" squares and (1) G 2-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make a flying geese unit. Then add (2) A $1^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the short sides to complete Unit 2. Make (2).

Unit 3: Use (2) A 2-1/2" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (1) I 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.


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8. Sew Units 1-3 together, as shown to complete A/G Big Tree Block, trim to $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (8).
9. Repeat Steps 7 and 8 to make (8) A/F Big Tree Block.


QUILT ASSEMBLY Refer to Quilt Diagram on page 5 for following steps.
10. INNER BORDER \#1: Sew (1) J $\mathbf{2 "}^{\prime \prime} \times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to long sides of $\mathbf{B} 33-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, followed by (1) $\mathbf{J} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom of quilt center.
11. SIDE PINE TREE BORDERS: Arrange and sew together (7) Tree Blocks as shown. Make (2) border units. Note proper placement of blocks. Sew border units to long sides of quilt center. Note proper rotation and placement of borders units.
12. TOP/BOTTOM PINE TREE BORDERS: Arrange and sew together (6) Tree Blocks and (2) A 8-1/2" squares as shown. Make (2) border units. Note proper placement of blocks. Sew border units to top and bottom of quilt center. Note proper rotation and placement of border units.
13. INNER BORDER \#2. Sew (1) J $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to long sides of quilt center, followed by (1) J $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom of quilt center.
14. OUTER BORDER: Sew (1) E 5-1/2" $\times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to long sides of quilt center, followed by (1) E 5-1/2" $\times 64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom to complete quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using J 2-1/4" strips.
