

#### **BLOCKS**

#### 1. Block Side Units

Sew (1) R 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to the longside of (1) A to Q 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Make (48) total. Block side unit H/R is shown.



#### NOTE ROTATION OF UNITS.

2. Place (1) A 4-1/2" square and (1) H/R block side unit, right sides together. Line up top and right sides. Sew pieces together, stopping about 1" from bottom of square. Open and press.





LINE UP TOP AND **RIGHT SIDES.** NOTE R PLACEMENT.



STOP ABOUT 1" FROM BOTTOM OF SQUARE.



3. Sew (1) G/R unit to top of Step 2.




4. Sew (1) D/R unit on left side of Step 3.





 Sew (1) Q /R unit on the bottom, left side of Step 4.



 Finish sewing partial seam created in Step 2 to compete your block.

**7.** Refering to quilt image, repeat **Steps 2-6** to make (11) more blocks, varying fabric placement as desired.

QUILT ASSEMBLY REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM ON PAGE 5 FOR FOLLOWING STEPS.

- Block Rows: Arrange and sew together (3) Blocks and (2) R 2" x 12-1/2" rectangles. Make (4) Block Rows.
- **9.** Sew (1) **R** 1-1/2" x 39-1/2" strip to bottom of Rows 1-3, then sew rows together to to create quilt center.

BORDERS REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM ON PAGE 5 FOR FOLLOWING STEPS.

- **10.** Border 1: Sew (1) R 2" x 51-1/2" strips to sides of quilt.
- **11. Pieced Side Borders:** Sew together (17) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles as shown in quilt diagram. Make (2) units, sew one to each side of quilt. *Note proper orienation of borders.*
- 12. Border 2: Sew (1) R 2" x 54-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 13. Pieced Top/Bottom Borders: Sew together (17) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles and
  (2) R 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles as shown in quilt diagram. Make (2) units, sew one to top and bottom of quilt center. Note proper orienation of borders.
- **14. Border 3:** Sew (1) **R** 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" strip to left and right sides of quilt. Sew (1) **R** 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt.



#### QUILT DIAGRAM ASSEMBLY



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **R** 2-1/4" strips.
