#### 1/4" Seam Allowance Check


To check if your seam is accurate, cut three  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" pieces from scrap fabric.

Sew the pieces together along the 3'' side, using what you believe is a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.

Press away from the center piece.

Measure.

The center piece should be exactly 1" wide.



## **Enchanted Forest**

If, when you measure, the center is less than 1", your seam allowance is too large. You need to move the needle to the right.

If it's more than 1", your seam allowance is too small and you need to move the needle to the left.

Consult your machine's owner's manual for instructions on moving your needle position.

Repeat this check until your center strip measures correctly.


KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS WOF=width of fabric
A	(1) 22½" x 42½" rectangle, fussy cut on panel motif
В	(12) 2½" x WOF strips. (9) 2½" x WOF strips for binding
С	(10) 11" squares, fussy cut on block motifs
D	(see below for cutting instructions)

#### Cutting Fabric D:

Cut an 8½" x length of fabric strip, centering on the bottom of the motif for the outer border.



From the remaining fabric, cut four 81/4" x 11" rectangles and six 87/8" x 11" rectangles as shown.





#### Assembly:

- 1. Stitch one fabric B 2½" x WOF strip to the top and bottom of the fabric A panel, preparing to miter corners.
- 2. Cut one fabric B  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip in half. Add a whole strip to each piece. Add to the sides of the panel, mitering corners.
- 3. Use the Assembly Diagram on page 5 to add the fabric C blocks and the fabric D  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11" and fabric D  $8\frac{7}{8}$ " x 11" blocks as shown. The four  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11" blocks are for the top and bottom rows, the six  $8\frac{7}{8}$ " x 11" blocks are for the sides. NOTE: Make sure all the fairies are facing the right way.
- 4. Cut one fabric B  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip in half. Add a whole strip to each piece and add to the top and bottom of the quilt, preparing to miter corners. Stitch four fabric B  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips together in pairs. Add to the sides of the quilt, mitering corners.
- 5. From the border print strip cut two  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 71" strips and stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt, preparing to miter corners. From the remaining border print strip, cut two  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 91" strips and add to the sides of the quilt, mitering corners.

#### Finishing:

- 6. Layer, baste and quilt as desired.
- 7. Bind with nine fabric B 2½" x WOF strips.
