## Cutting Instructions

| Qty | 6＂finished block | 12＂finished block |

| 4 | $11 / 2 \prime$ squares（ $A$ ） | $211 / 2$ squares（ $A$ ） |
| 8 | 2＂squares（B） | 3 ＂squares（B） |
| 8 | 2＂squares（C） | 3 ＂squares（C） |
| 8 | 2＂squares（D） | $3 "$ squares（D） |
| 4 | 2＂squares（E） | $3 "$ squares（E） |
| 4 | $11 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares（F） | $21 / 2{ }^{1 / 2}$ squares（F） |

## Piecing Instructions

## Step 1

On the wrong side of each B square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner as shown.
Place B and C squares right sides together. Stitch a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on both sides of the drawn line. Cut the square apart on the line to yield 2 HSTs, and press the seams to the darker triangles (C).


1 B square +1 C square $=2 \mathrm{~B} / \mathrm{C}$ HSTs

Repeat to make 8 B/C HSTs, 8 B/D HSTs, 4 C/D HSTs, 4 E/C HSTs, and 4 E/D HSTs.

Trim all HSTs to $1 \frac{112 \prime \prime}{\prime \prime}$ ( $6^{\prime \prime}$ block) or $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ( $12^{\prime \prime}$ block).


## Step 2

Lay out 1 A square, 2 B/C HSTs, 2 B/D HSTs, 1 C/D HST, $1 \mathrm{E} / \mathrm{CHST}, 1 \mathrm{E} / \mathrm{D}$ HST, and 1 F square as shown.

Join to make a unit measuring $31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ ( $6^{\prime \prime}$ block) or $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(12^{\prime \prime}\right.$ block). Repeat to make 4 units.


## Step 3

Join units as shown to make the full block.
Trim to $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ or $121_{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$.
