Please read all instructions before beginning the project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics are from the Woodsman collection unless otherwise indicated.

- 1 Woodsman Rolie Polie (1-RP-13760-40)
- 1 ⅓ yards Main Red (C13760-RED)
- 1/4 yard Trees Black (C13763-BLACK)
- 1 ¼ yards Plaid Black (C13766-BLACK)*
- 4 % yards Dapple Dot on White Barn Red (C645-BARNRED) *includes Binding

OTHER SUPPLIES

2 % yards WIDEBACK backing fabric of your choice Basic Sewing Supplies Batting (84" x 96")

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics and label all cuts as noted.

Woodsman Rolie Polie

Select (36) Rolie Polie strips and subcut (9) 2 %" squares per strip for a total of (270) 2 %" squares, label A.



Black Trees

Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips; subcut: (42) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, label E.



Black Plaid

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

Place (7) strips aside for the inside border, label F Place (9) strips aside for the binding.



Red Main

Cut (8) 5 ½" x WOF strips, place aside for the outer border, label G.



Dapple Dot on White Barn Red

Cut (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips, subcut:

(120) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, label B.

Cut (9) 6 ½" x WOF strips, subcut:

(120) 6 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles, label C.

Cut (8) 10 ½" x WOF strips, subcut:

(71) 10 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles, label D.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


SEWING TECHNIQUES


Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. Refer to the quilt photo for placement of the prints. Press seams as noted in each step for best results. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless stated otherwise.

Note: When aligning fabrics be cognizant of directional prints.

9-Patch Block

1. Lay out (5) A squares of the same print and (4) B squares as shown. Sew the squares into rows and sew the rows together to complete the 9-Patch Block. Press seams to the darker fabric. Unit measures 6 %" x 6 %" unfinished.







2. Repeat to make (30) 9-Patch Blocks.

9-Patch Borders

3. Lay out (2) A squares of the same print and (1) C rectangle as shown. Sew the A squares to the left and right sides of the C rectangle. Press seams to the dark fabric. 9-Patch Border will measure 10 ½" x 2 ½" unfinished.











4. Repeat to make (72) 9-Patch Borders.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

5. Lay out (1) 9-Patch Block and (2) 9-Patch Borders of the same print and (2) C rectangles as shown. Sew the (C) rectangles to the left and right side of the 9-Patch Block. Press seams toward the 9-Patch Block.





6. Sew the 9-Patch Borders to the top and bottom of the 9-Patch Block. Press seams toward the 9-Patch Borders.



- 7. The block should measure 10 %" x 10 %" unfinished.
- 8. Repeat to make (30) blocks.

Vertical Sashing

9. Lay out (1) block and (1) D rectangle as shown. Sew the D rectangle to the right side of the block. Press seams toward the 9-Patch Block.





- 10. Unit should measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- 11. Repeat to make (24) single sashed units.
- 12. Lay out (1) block and (2) D rectangles as shown. Sew the D rectangles to the left and right sides of the block. Press seams toward the 9-Patch Block.





- 13. Unit should measure 14 ½" x 10 ½" unfinished.
- 14. Repeat to make (6) double sashed units. The double sashed units will be the left column of your quilt top.

Horizontal Sashing

15. Lay out (1) D rectangle and (2) E squares as shown. Sew the E squares to the left and right sides of the D rectangle.



- 16. Unit should measure 14 ½" x 2 ½" unfinished.
- 17. Repeat to make (21) horizontal sashing units.
- 18. Lay out (3) horizontal sashing units and (2) D rectangles as shown. Sew the patches together to make a horizontal sashing row. Horizontal sashing row should measure 62 ½" x 2 ½" unfinished.

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QUILT ASSEMBLY

- 19. Referring to the Quilt Top Diagram for block and sashing placement, lay out the single and double sashed blocks, and horizontal sashing rows as shown.
- 20. Sew together the single and double sashed blocks to make (7) rows. Sew the horizontal sashing rows to the block rows to make the quilt center. Quilt center should measure 62 ½" x 74 ½" unfininished.

Note: Seam allowances vary, so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

- 21. Sew together (7) F strips end-to-end and cut (2) $74\,\%$ strips and (2) $66\,\%$ " strips. Sew the $74\,\%$ " strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Sew the $66\,\%$ " strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
- 22. Sew together (8) G strips end-to-end and cut (2) $78\,\%$ " strips and (2) $76\,\%$ " strips. Sew the $78\,\%$ " strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Sew the $76\,\%$ " strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Your quilt top should measure 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 88 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the Black Plaid strips.
