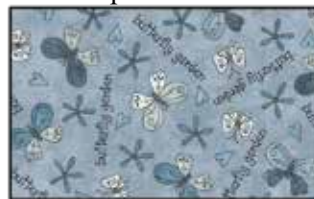

**Materials**

- 2/3 yard (0.61 m) Butterfly Blocks - Dark Blue (A) 3152-77
- 1 1/2 yards (1.38 m) Border Stripe - Cream (B) 3151-33
- 2/3 yard (0.61 m) Lazy Daisy Toss - Dark Blue (C) 3147-77
- 1/4 yard (0.23 m) Butterfly and Words - Light Blue (D) 3149-17
- 1/4 yard (0.23 m) Flower Stripe - Cream (E) 3146-33
- 1/4 yard (0.23 m) Medium Butterfly Toss - Cream (F) 3143-33
- 3/4 yard (0.69 m) Sprig Toss - Dark Blue (G) 3148-77\*
- 1/4 yard (0.23 m) Butterfly Wreaths - Light Blue (H) 3144-17
- 1/4 yard (0.23 m) Medium Butterfly Toss - Light Blue (I) 3143-17
- 1/4 yard (0.23 m) Butterfly and Words - Cream (J) 3149-33
- 1/4 yard (0.23 m) Tulip Toss - Cream (K) 3150-33
- 1/4 yard (0.23 m) Flower Stripe - Light Blue (L) 3146-17
- 1 3/8 yards (1.26 m) Butterfly Wreaths - Cream (M) 3144-33
- 4 yards (3.66 m) Butterfly Wreaths - Light Blue (Backing) 3144-17

\*Includes binding

**Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

**From the Butterfly Blocks - Dark Blue (A):**

- Fussy cut (6) 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles, centered on the blocks.

**From the Border Stripe - Cream (B):**

- Fussy cut (2) 10 1/2" x 50 1/2" x Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, centered on the stripes.

**From the Lazy Daisy Toss - Dark Blue (C), cut:**

- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.

**From the Butterfly and Words - Light Blue (D), cut:**

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

**From the Flower Stripe - Cream (E), cut:**

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles.

**From the Medium Butterfly Toss - Cream (F), cut:**

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

**From the Sprig Toss - Dark Blue (G), cut:**

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

**From the Butterfly Wreaths - Light Blue (H), cut:**

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

**From the Medium Butterfly Toss - Light Blue (I), cut:**

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

**From the Butterfly and Words - Cream (J), cut:**

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

**From the Tulip Toss - Cream (K), cut:**

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

**From the Flower Stripe - Light Blue (L), cut:**

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles.

**From the Butterfly Wreaths - Cream (M), cut:**

- (6) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 5 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips.

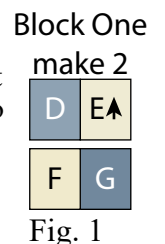
**From the Butterfly Wreaths - Light Blue (Backing), cut:**

- (2) 70" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 70" x 80" back.

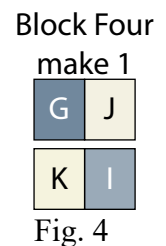
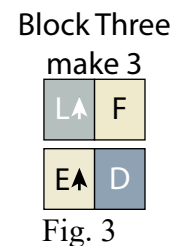
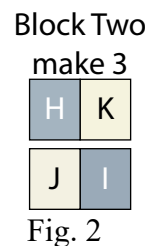
**Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the left side of (1) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric E rectangle to make the top row (Fig. 1). Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric F rectangle to the left side of (1) 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric G rectangle to make the bottom row (Fig. 1). Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" Block One rectangle (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Block One rectangle.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) Block Two rectangles, (3) Block Three rectangles and (1) Block Four rectangle.



3. Sew together (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric A rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric A rectangle and (1) Block Three rectangle lengthwise to make Row One (Fig. 5).

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 5 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Three and Row Five.

5. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 10 1/2" x 50 1/2" Fabric B strip lengthwise to make Row Two (Fig. 5). Repeat to make Row Four.

6. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 3-5, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 50 1/2" x 60 1/2" Center Block (Fig. 5).

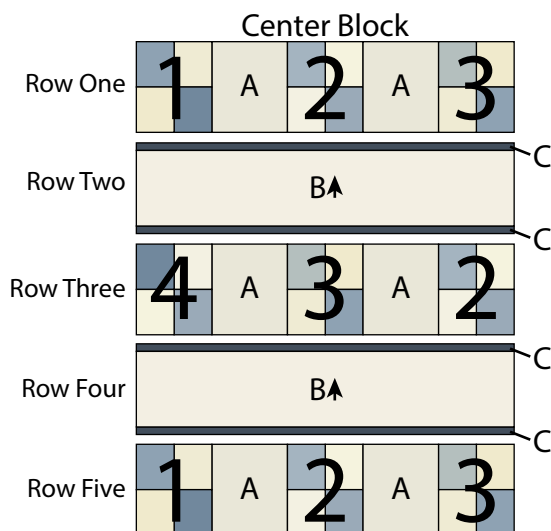

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

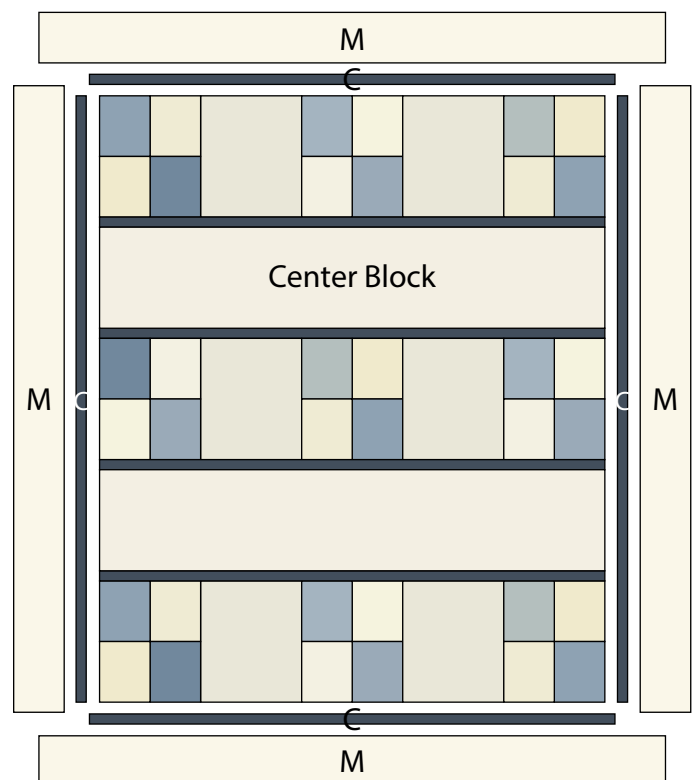
7. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 62 1/2" Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 62 1/2" Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

9. Layer and quilt as desired.

10. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

11. Bind as desired.
