

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Butterfly Blocks - Dark Blue (A):

• Fussy cut (6) 10 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles, centered on the blocks.

#### From the Border Stripe - Cream (B):

• Fussy cut (2) 10 ½" x 50 ½" x Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, centered on the stripes.

#### From the Lazy Daisy Toss - Dark Blue (C), cut:

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 52 ½" strips.

#### From the Butterfly and Words - Light Blue (D), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 5 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.

#### From the Flower Stripe - Cream (E), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles.

#### From the Medium Butterfly Toss - Cream (F), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 5 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.

#### From the Sprig Toss - Dark Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Butterfly Wreaths - Light Blue (H), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.

#### From the Medium Butterfly Toss - Light Blue (I), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.

#### From the Butterfly and Words - Cream (J), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.

#### From the Tulip Toss - Cream (K), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.

#### From the Flower Stripe - Light Blue (L), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles.

#### From the Butterfly Wreaths - Cream (M), cut:

• (6) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 5 ½" x 62 ½" strips.

#### From the Butterfly Wreaths - Light Blue (Backing), cut:

• (2) 70" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 70" x 80" back.

#### **Block Assembly**



Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D rectangle to the left side of (1) 5 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E rectangle to make the top row (Fig. 1). Sew (1) 5 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric F rectangle to the left side of (1) 5 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric G rectangle to make the bottom row (Fig. 1). Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 ½" x 12 ½" Block One rectangle (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Block One rectangle.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) Block Two rectangles, (3) Block Three rectangles and (1) Block Four rectangle.


- 3. Sew together (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 10 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric A rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 10 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric A rectangle and (1) Block Three rectangle lengthwise to make Row One (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 5 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Three and Row Five.
- 5. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 10 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric B strip lengthwise to make Row Two (Fig. 5). Repeat to make Row Four.
- 6. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 3-5, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 50 ½" x 60 ½" Center Block (Fig. 5).



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 7. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 8. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 62 ½" Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 62 ½" Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt
- 9. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 10. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 11. Bind as desired.



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
