WOF = Width of fabric | HST = Half Square Triangle | QST = Quarter Square Triangle

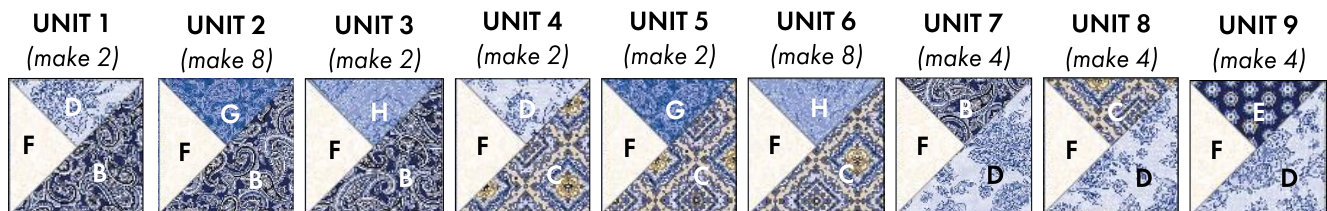
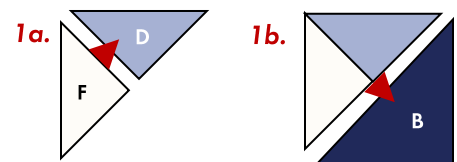
**Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern*

	SIDE TABLE G 17012-50 <i>Blue</i>	1-1/4 YDS	(1) 6-1/4" x WOF strip, subcut (3) 6-1/4" squares, crosscut twice for (12) QST (1) 5-7/8" x WOF strip, subcut (6) 5-7/8" squares, crosscut once for (12) HST (1) 4-7/8" x WOF strip, subcut (6) 4-7/8" squares, crosscut once for (12) HST
	TEA TABLE H 17013-50 <i>Blue</i>	5/8 YD	(1) 6-1/4" x WOF strip, subcut (3) 6-1/4" squares, crosscut twice for (12) QST (1) 5-7/8" x WOF strip, subcut (6) 5-7/8" squares, crosscut once for (12) HST (1) 4-7/8" x WOF strip, subcut (6) 4-7/8" squares, crosscut once for (12) HST

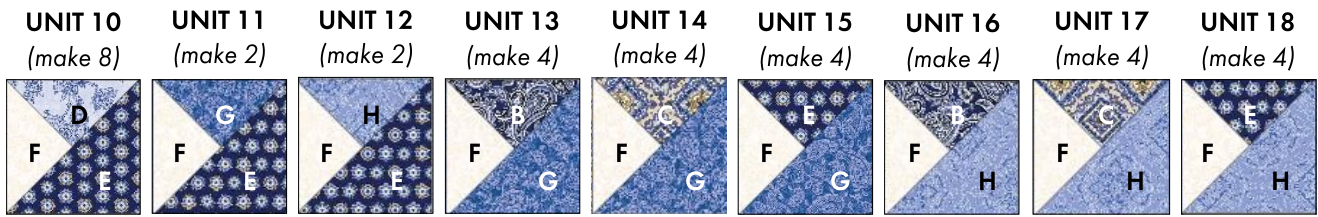
UNIT ASSEMBLY: *Refer to UNIT DIAGRAMS*

- Sew (1) F QST and (1) D QST together, then add (1) B 5-7/8" HST to create UNIT 1. Square to 5-1/2", make (2).
- Repeat step 1 using QSTs and HSTs shown to create remaining UNITS. Square all to 5-1/2", make number indicated.

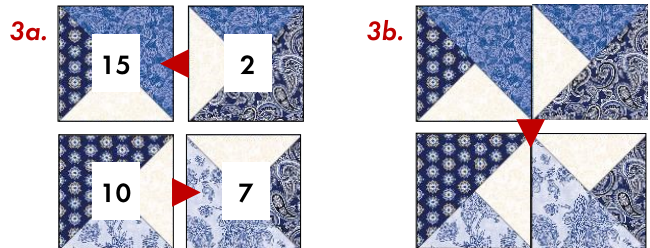
UNIT DIAGRAMS (continued)



BLOCK 1 ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

- Sew (1) each UNITS 2, 7, 10 and 15 together to create BLOCK 1A, being sure to note rotation of each unit. Square to 10-1/2", make (4).
- Repeat step 3 using UNITS labeled below to create remaining BLOCKS. Square all to 10-1/2", make number indicated.

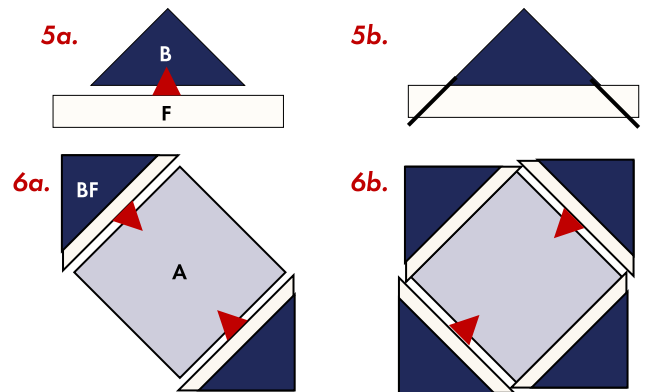

BLOCK 2 ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

- Find center of (1) B 4-7/8" HST and (1) F 1-1/4" x 9" strip. Match centers and sew together, then press open. Trim F ends as shown to complete BF HST, make (12).
- Sew (2) BF HSTs to opposing sides of (1) A 7-5/8" square, press, then repeat on remaining sides to create BLOCK 2A. Square to 10-1/2" (ensuring that there is 1/4" seam allowance beyond the A square points), make (3).
- Repeat steps 5 and 6 using F 1-1/4" x 9" strips, A 7-5/8" squares and 4-7/8" HSTs as labeled below to create remaining blocks. Square all to 10-1/2", make number indicated.

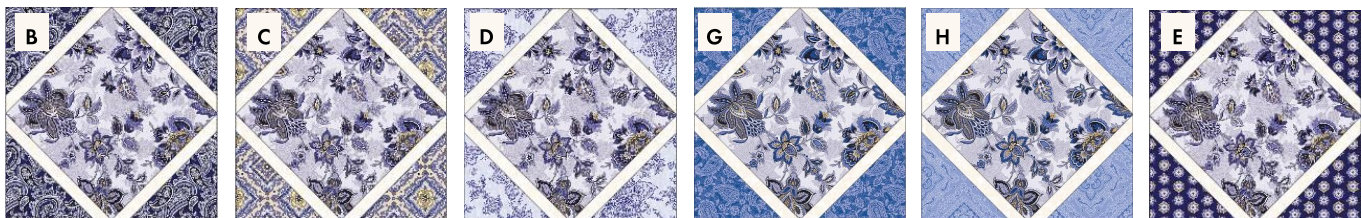

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

8. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

ROW 1: 1A–2A–1B–2B–1C

ROW 2: 2C–1D–2D–1E–2E

ROW 3: 1C–2F–1A–2A–1B

ROW 4: 2E–1F–2C–1D–2D

ROW 5: 1B–2B–1C–2F–1A

ROW 6: 2D–1E–2E–1F–2C

ROW 7: 1A–2A–1B–2B–1C

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

9. Sew (1) F 1-1/2" x (70-1/2") strip and (1) D 5-1/2" x (70-1/2") strip together to create **SIDE BORDER UNIT**, make (2). Sew to sides of quilt.

10. Sew together (2) A 5-1/2" squares, (2) F 1-1/2" x (5-1/2") strips and (1) D 5-1/2" x (50-1/2") strip, then sew (1) F 1-1/2" x (62-1/2") strip to bottom to create **TOP/BOTTOM BORDER UNIT**, make (2). Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with G fabric.
