## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 61" $\times 73$ "

Please read all instructions before beginning the project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/ pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Sew with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise stated. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as noted in each step for best results. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless stated otherwise.

WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together
HST = Half Square Triangle

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics are from the Sweetbriar collection unless otherwise indicated.
(1) FQ-14020-21 Fat Quarter Bundle $5 / 8$ yard C14023-WINE Apples (includes binding) 1 yard C14024-CREAM Plaid $11 / 4$ yards C14020-BLUSH Main $15 / 8$ yards C120-LECREME Confetti Cotton Solid

## OTHER SUPPLIES

2 yards Wide Back backing fabric of your choice
Basic Sewing Supplies
Batting (69" $\times 81^{\prime \prime}$ )

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics and label all cuts as noted.


Sweetbriar Fat Quarter Bundle
Note: Remove the Cream Plaid Fat Quarter from the bundle as it will not be used. Take out the Blue Flower Scatter and Wine Apples Fat Quarter to use in the cutting instruction below.
From each of the remaining (18) Fat Quarters cut:
(1) $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ strip; subcut:
(6) $31 / 2$ " $\times 3^{1 / 2}$ " squares, label as Fabric Number and Cut A (e.g. 1A, 2A, etc.)
(2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut:
(9) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares, label as Fabric Number and Cut B (e.g. 1B, 2B, etc.)


## Wine Apples

From the Fat Quarter cut:
(1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut:
(6) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, label as 20A.
(5) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut:
(39) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, label 20B.

From the Yardage cut:
(7) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for Binding.

## Cream Plaid



Cut (13) $21122^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut:
(49) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, label C.


Blush Main
Cut (6) $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for borders.

## Le Creme Solid

Cut (5) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut:
(80) $21^{1 / 2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, label D.

Cut (11) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut:
(126) $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 3 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, label E.

## SEWING TECHNIQUES

General sewing techniques used in this pattern are shown below. These methods will be referenced throughout the pattern in their abbreviated form.

## 2-AT-A-TIME HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)

Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) HSTs. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HSTs to desired size.


## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Using the HST method, pair (1) A square with (1) E square. Label as Fabric Number and F (e.g. 1F, 2F, etc.). Repeat to make (12) F HSTs per Fat Quarter for a total of (240) HSTs. Trim HSTs to $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Lay out (9) 1B squares, (12) 1F HSTs, and (4) D squares as shown.

3. Sew the squares and units together into rows, pressing the seams as shown.
4. Sew the rows together, pressing the seams as shown to make (1) block.

5. Repeat steps 2-4 to make (20) blocks, using matching prints for each block (e.g., 2B squares, 2F HSTs, etc.)

Your block should measure $1012^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

6. Lay out the (20) blocks, C rectangles, and (30) 20B squares as shown on the quilt layout diagram.
7. Sew together the units to form rows. For odd rows, press seams toward the left and for even rows, press seams toward the right.
8. Sew the rows together to make the quilt center. Press seams toward the horizontal sashing.
Your quilt center should measure $501 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 621 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
9. Sew the (6) $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Blush Main strips together end-to-end and subcut into (2) 61 12" top/bottom borders and (2) $62 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ side borders.
10. Attach the side borders and press seams toward the borders.
11. Attach the top and bottom borders and press seams toward the borders.
Your quilt top should measure $61 \frac{112 "}{} \times 731 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Wine Apples binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
