Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the Q 3-7/8" squares. With right sides together, layer the marked Q square with (1) B square. Stitch 1/4" from each side of the diagonal line, cut on the drawn line, press each unit open with seams toward the darker fabric, and trim dog ears. Make (24) 3-1/2" BQ HSTs.

2. Repeat Step 1 with the following 3-7/8" squares: Q, C, and D, to make (24) 3-1/2" HST of each type.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

- 3. Mark the 2" E squares as in Step 1. Noting the line orientation and with right sides together, layer a marked E square on the left short end of a 2" x 3-1/2" G rectangle, and stitch on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam line and press open. Similarly, stitch another E square to the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make (24) EG flying-geese units.
- Repeat Step 3 using the 2" G squares and the 2" x 3-1/2" Q rectangles to make (24) GQ flying geese units.
- 5. Sew the EG and GQ units together as shown to make (24) 3-1/2" EGQ UNIT. Press the seams toward the top.
- 6. Repeat Steps 3, 4 and 5 with fabrics indicated to make remaining UNITS. Make (24) 3-1/2" squares of each type.
 FHQ UNIT: F 2" squares, H 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, H 2" squares and Q 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
 AKQ UNIT: A 2" squares, K 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, K 2" squares and Q 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
- 7. Arrange the (4) BQ HSTs, (4) EGQ UNITs and (1) E 3-1/2" square into (3) rows. Sew rows together, pressing the seams in alternating directions, then sew the rows together and press seams open to form 9-1/2" BLOCK 1. Make (6).
- Repeat Step 7 using pieces indicated to create BLOCK 2 and BLOCK 3.
 - BLOCK 2: CQ HST—FHQ UNIT—F square BLOCK 3: DQ HST—AKQ UNIT—K square
- Sew (1) M triangle and (1) P triangle together, press the seam toward the darker fabric. Repeat using (1) N triangle and (1) P triangle, then sew unites together to create BLOCK 4. Press the seam open. Square to 9-1/2", make (17).





QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

10. Following the quilt photo for block placement and orientation, lay out (7) rows with (5) alternating blocks each. Sew the blocks in each row, then matching adjacent seams, sew the rows together in order.

BORDER ASSEMBLY:

- 11. BORDER 1: Sew the (6) 1-1/2" Q strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length (63-1/2"). Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length (47-1/2") and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 12. BORDER 2: Sew (4) 3-1/2" **R** strips in pairs end to end using a straight seam to make (2) long strips. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and trim (2) strips that size (71-1/2"). Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew the remaining (3) **R** 3-1/2" strips together. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Trim (2) border strips that length (53-1/2") and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 13. BORDER 3: Sew the (7) 1-1/2" J strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length (71-1/2"). Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length (55-1/2") and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with L fabric.
