| E | (5) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 2" $\times 50$ " borders and <br> (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. |
| F | FOR BINDING: <br> (6) $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew short ends together. |
| G | (9) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips; sew short ends together matching stripes. Subcut (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders and <br> (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 46^{\prime \prime}$ borders. |

| I | Centering design, fussy cut: $23-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle |
| J | (5) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew short ends together. <br> Subcut (2) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 53^{\prime \prime}$ borders and <br> (2) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$ borders. <br> (10) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew short ends of (5) strips together. <br> Subcut (4) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, <br> (16) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (14) Bar Templates. |

## PATCHWORK BORDERS

1. Sew (1) C Triangle reversed and (1) D Triangle to opposite sides of (1) J Bar to make a rectangle unit. Rectangle unit should measure $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowances. Make 2.

2. Following step 1, make rectangle units using the fabrics as shown. Make the number indicated.

3. Arrange (8) J $1^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles alternating with (7) rectangle units noting position of fabrics and orientation of diagonal Bars. Note: some rectangular units are rotated $180^{\circ}$. Sew together the rectangles and rectangle units to make the left and right patchwork borders.
4. Sew (1) J $1^{\prime \prime} \times 46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of patchwork borders. Patchwork borders should measure 46-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowance. Make 1 each.

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## BORDERS

5. Following the Quilt Layout on page 5 , sew (1) D $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of I Panel. Sew (2) D 1-1/2" $\times 25-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of the quilt.
6. Sew (1) left and (1) right patchwork border to sides of quilt. Sew (2) B 2-1/4" $\times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of the quilt.
7. Sew (1) E 2" $\times 50$ " border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) E 2" $\times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of the quilt.
8. Sew (1) J $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 53^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) J $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of the quilt.
9. Trim ends of (2) $\mathbf{G} 3^{\prime \prime} \times 61^{\prime \prime}$ borders and (2) $\mathbf{G} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 47-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders diagonally. Sew
(1) $\mathbf{G} 3^{\prime \prime} \times 61^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of quilt beginning and ending stitching $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from edges of quilt. Sew (2) G 2" $\times 47-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of quilt in the same manner. Sew diagonal ends of adjacent borders together.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using six fabric F 2-1/4" strips.
