Throw Quilt: 57" x 75-1/2"



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Hydrangea Mist

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 66" floral stripe borders, (2) 5-1/2" x 47-1/2" floral stripe borders, (2) 3" x 66" butterfly stripe borders, and (2) 3" x 48" butterfly stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 7" strip, subcut (6) 7" squares

Fabric D - Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 63" and (2) 2" x 47-1/2" borders

Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 56" borders

Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 39-1/2" borders

Fabric E - Cut (1) 7" strip, subcut (6) 7" squares
Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Fussy cut (4) 5-1/2" squares with motifs centered

Fabric G - Cut (1) 20" strip, subcut
(2) 6-1/2" wide x 20" tall pieces and
(2) 6-1/2" tall x 13-1/2" wide pieces

Fabric H - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (2) 2" strips
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 27" strips

2. Piecing Order:

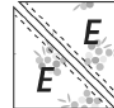
1. On the wrong side of all **Fabric E** 7" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



2. Arrange a marked **Fabric E** 7" square right sides together with a **Fabric C** 7" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 6-1/2" square. Make a total of 12 **Block 1**.

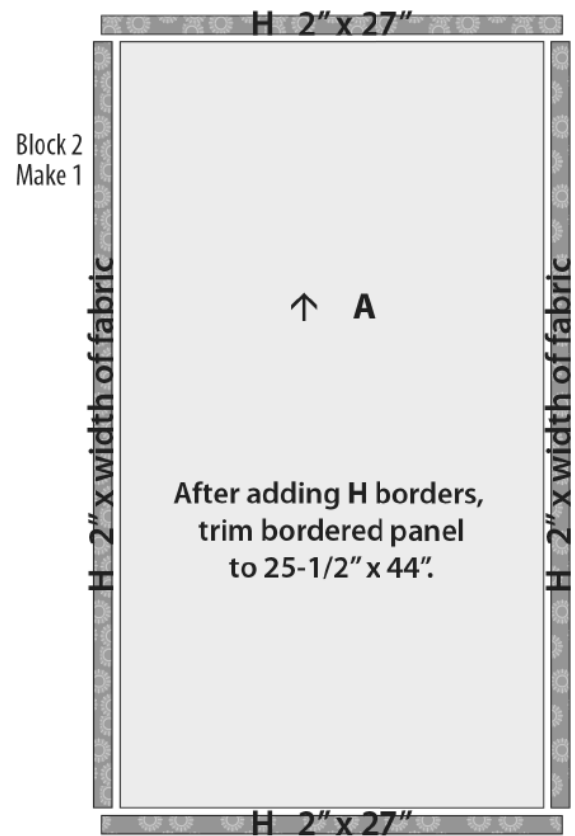


Repeat 6 times for 12 units.

3. Stitch **Fabric H** 2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2" x 27" **Fabric H** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 44" (unfinished)** to complete **Block 2**.



Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

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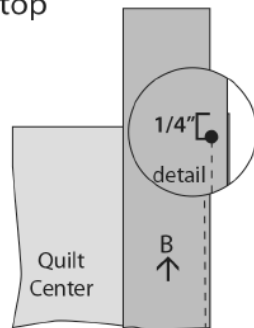
4. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks, **Fabric E** squares, **Fabric G** pieces, **Fabric F** squares, and borders.

5. Arrange 4 **Block 1** and a **Fabric G** 6-1/2" x 20" piece in vertical rows on right and left sides of **Block 2**. Stitch into rows (6-1/2" x 44" unfinished). Sew to right and left sides of **Block 2**.

6. Arrange 2 **Block 1**, 2 **Fabric E** 6-1/2" squares, and a **Fabric G** 6-1/2" x 13-1/2" piece in horizontal rows above and below **Block 2**. Stitch into rows (6-1/2" x 37-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of **Block 2**. Quilt center measures 37-1/2" x 56" unfinished).

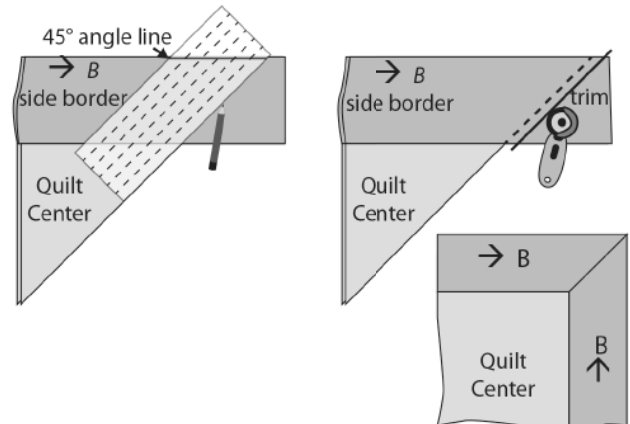
7. Sew **Fabric D** 1-1/2" x 56" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric D** 1-1/2" x 39-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

8. Center **Fabric B** 3" x 66" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 3" x 48" borders on top and bottom of quilt center noting orientation of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

9. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



10. Sew **Fabric D** 2" x 63" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric D** 2" x 47-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

11. Sew **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 66" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Stitch **Fabric F** 5-1/2" squares to ends of each **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 47-1/2" borders then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

12. The quilt measures approximately 57-1/2" x 76" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

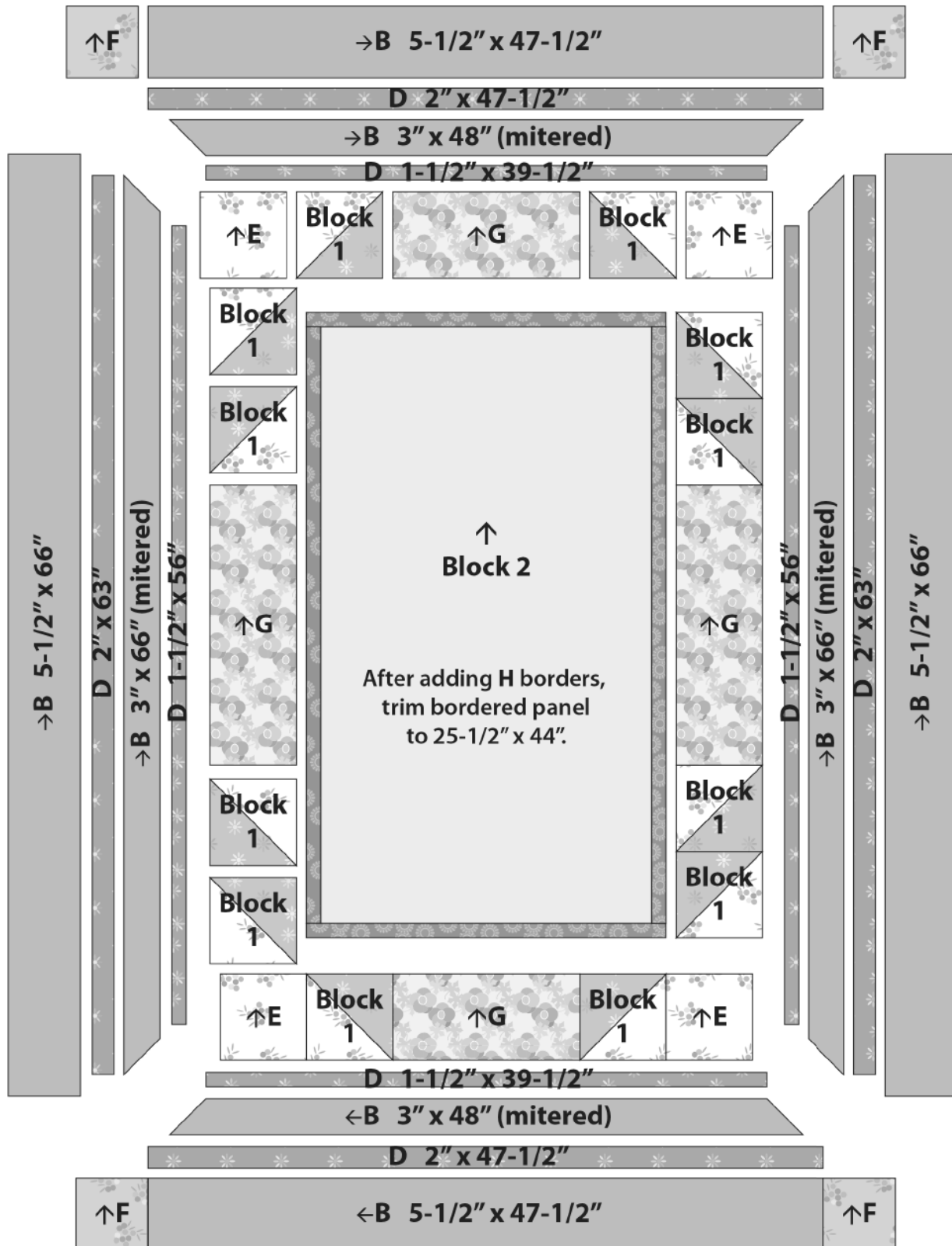
13. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!
