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CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of Fabric (approx. 42")

FROM EACH 1/3 YARD OF 9 ASSORTED BLUE, YELLOW, AND LIGHT GRAY FABRICS (Fig. 1):

Cut (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

- From two strips, cut (2) 10 1/2" x 1 1/2" and (2) 9 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips, so you have 4 total of each size.
- From one strip, cut (4) 8 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips.
- From one strip, cut (4) 7 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips.
- From one strip, cut (4) 6 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips.

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip.

- Cut (3) 3" squares from one end of the strip.
- Separate the remainder of the strip into (2) 1 1/2" x approx. 32" strips.
- From both strips, cut (2) 5 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips, (2) 4 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips, and (2) 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips, so you have 4 total of each size.

*** (30) of each 1 1/2" strip size are needed for the quilt blocks, so you will have extras to mix and match during block assembly.**

FROM EACH 1/3 YARD OF 8 LOW VOLUME FABRICS (Fig. 2):

Cut (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

- From one strip, cut (4) 9 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips.
- From one strip, cut (4) 8 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips and (2) 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips.
- From one strip, cut (4) 7 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips and (2) 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips.
- From one strip, cut (4) 6 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips and (4) 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips.
- From one strip, cut (4) 5 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips and (4) 4 1/2" x 1 1/2" strips.

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip.

- Cut (3) 3" squares and (9) 2 1/2" squares.

*** (30) of each 1 1/2" strip size are needed for the quilt blocks, so you will have extras to mix and match during block assembly.**

FROM EACH 1/8 YARD OF 3 DARK GRAY FABRICS:
Cut (10) 2 1/2" squares.

FROM 1 YARD WHITE BORDER FABRIC:

- Cut (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.
- Cut (7) 3 1/2" x WOF strips.

FROM 1/2 YARD BINDING FABRIC:

- Cut (7) 2 1/4" x WOF strips.

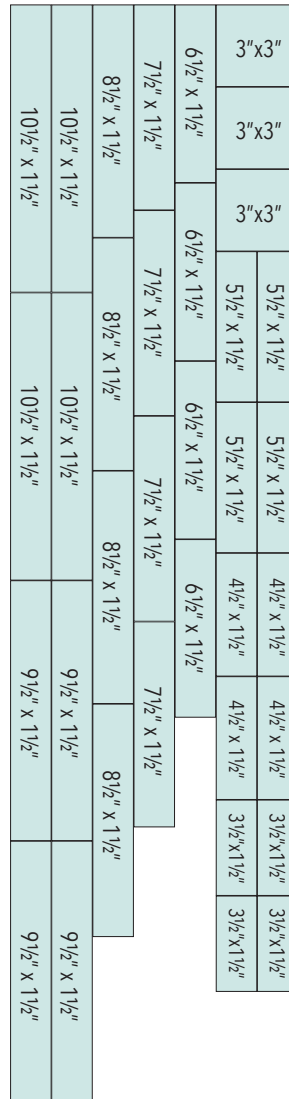
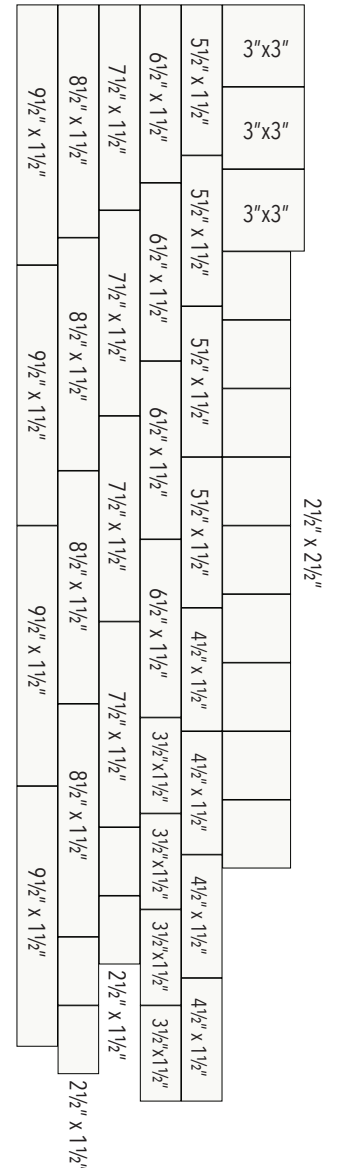

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Use a scant 1/4" seam throughout.

LOG CABIN BLOCKS

1. There are 30 total blocks in this quilt— regardless of the direction turned in the final assembly, they are all pieced the same way, as shown in the diagram to the right (Fig. 3). For each block, mix and match Blue/Yellow/Light Gray fabrics and Low Volume fabrics to give a scrappy look.
2. Starting at the shortest log (2 1/2" x 1 1/2" Low Volume fabric), attach to the block center. **PRESS SEAM TO ONE SIDE** away from the center.
3. Work your way around the log cabin, in a clockwise order. The order is numbered in the block assembly diagram. As you go around a full 'round', double check your seam allowance and adjust as needed.
4. Repeat to make (30) log cabin blocks in assorted fabric arrangements. Assembled blocks measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2".

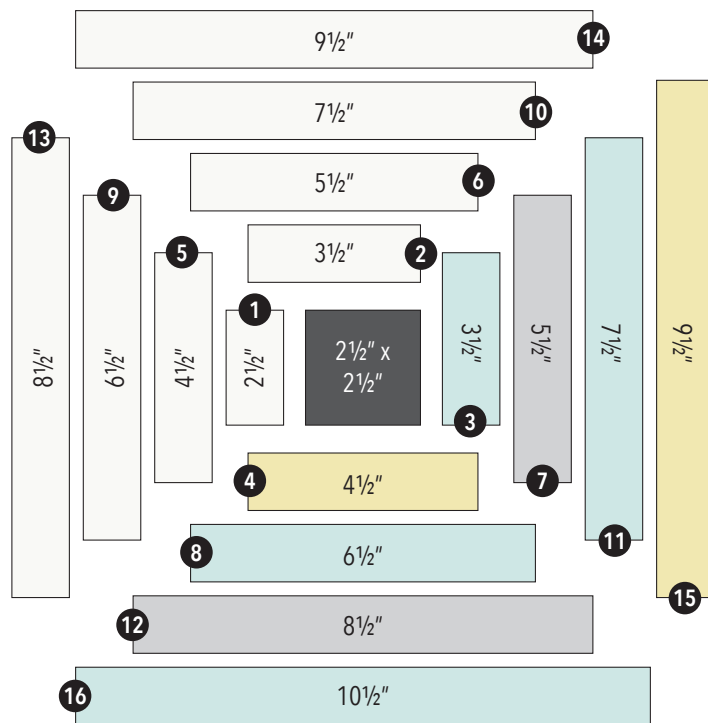




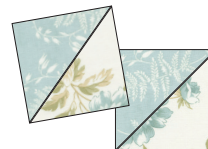
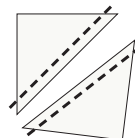
Fig. 4 - Examples of Finished 10 1/2" Blocks - Make (30)



HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) BLOCKS

1. Gather (24) 3" Squares of Blue/Yellow/Light Gray Fabrics (you will have extras leftover), and (24) 3" Squares of Low Volume Fabrics to make Half Square Triangles (HSTs).
2. Draw a diagonal line on the **WRONG SIDE** of each Low Volume square using a pencil or other marking tool. 
3. Layer one Blue/Yellow/Light Gray square and one Low Volume square **RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER (RST)** and pin to secure.

4. Stitch a scant 1/4" on either side of your marked line. 
5. Cut into two HSTs along center line. Press seams open, and trim HSTs to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square. You will have (48) HSTs total.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS (cont'd) Use a scant 1/4" seam throughout.

PATCHWORK BORDERS

1. Gather (70) 2 1/2" Squares of various Low Volume fabrics and (48) 2 1/2" HST Blocks, to make the patchwork border. Distribute fabrics for the top/left/right/bottom sides of the border to give a scrappy look.
2. For the TOP PATCHWORK BORDER, gather (18) 2 1/2" Low Volume Squares & (10) 2 1/2" HST Blocks. Piece as shown, making sure the HSTs in the strip point down and left. Press seams open or to one side. Finished border will measure 56 1/2" x 2 1/2".



3. For the BOTTOM PATCHWORK BORDER, gather (18) 2 1/2" Low Volume Squares & (10) 2 1/2" HST Blocks. Piece as shown, making sure the HSTs in the strip point up and right. Press seams open or to one side. Finished border will measure 56 1/2" x 2 1/2".



4. For the LEFT SIDE PATCHWORK BORDER, gather (17) 2 1/2" Low Volume Squares & (14) 2 1/2" HST Blocks. Piece as shown, making sure the HSTs in the strip point up and right. Press seams open or to one side. Finished border will measure 2 1/2" x 62 1/2".

5. For the RIGHT SIDE PATCHWORK BORDER, gather (17) 2 1/2" Low Volume Squares & (14) 2 1/2" HST Blocks. Piece as shown, making sure the HSTs in the strip point down and left. Press seams open or to one side. Finished border will measure 2 1/2" x 62 1/2".



INNER BORDERS

Gather (6) 1 1/2" x WOF White Inner Border strips. Remove selvages and join end to end. Subcut (2) 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" Side Inner Borders, and (2) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" Top/Bottom Inner Borders.

OUTER BORDERS

Gather (7) 3 1/2" x WOF White Outer Border strips. Remove selvages and join end to end. Subcut (2) 3 1/2" x 66 1/2" Side Outer Borders, and (2) 3 1/2" x 62 1/2" Top/Bottom Outer Borders.

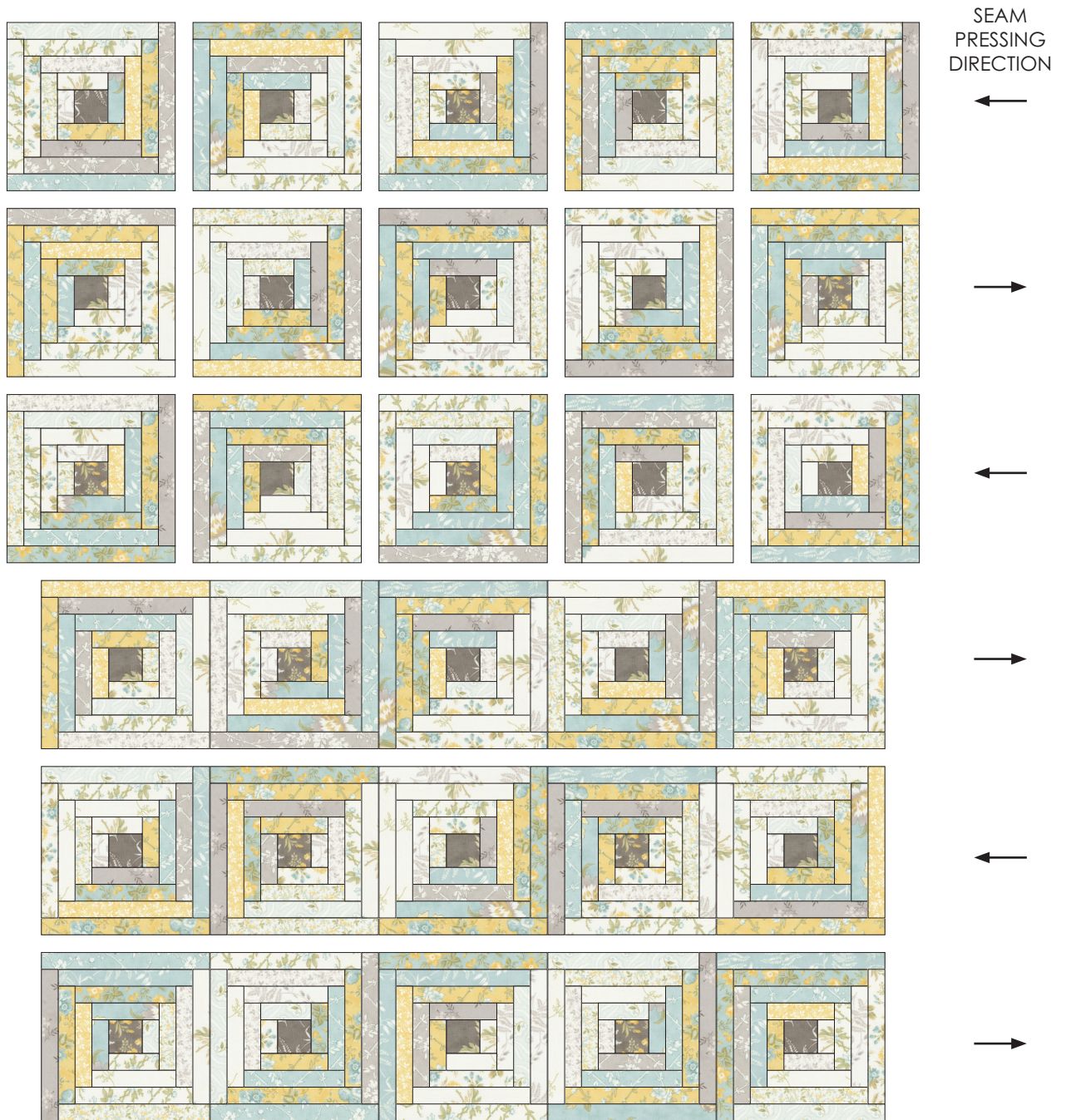
BINDING

Join (7) 2 1/4" x WOF Binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Fold in half and press wrong sides together.



FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS Use a scant 1/4" seam throughout.

1. Arrange Log Cabin blocks into 6 rows of 5 blocks each, rotating the block direction as shown to create diagonal stripes from the Blue/Yellow/Light Gray sections.
2. Sew blocks together into rows, pressing seams to the side in alternate directions row by row, as shown by arrows.
3. Join rows together, pressing seams open. Quilt center measures 50½" x 60½".



**FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS (cont'd)** Use a scant ¼" seam throughout.

4. Attach SIDE INNER BORDERS (1½" x 60½") to either side of quilt center, pressing seams toward borders.
5. Attach TOP & BOTTOM INNER BORDERS (52½" x 1½") to top and bottom of quilt center, pressing seams toward borders.
6. Attach LEFT & RIGHT PATCHWORK BORDERS (2½" x 62½") to either side of quilt center, pressing seams toward inner borders.
7. Attach TOP & BOTTOM PATCHWORK BORDERS (56½" x 2½") to top and bottom of quilt center, pressing seams toward inner border.s
8. Attach SIDE OUTER BORDERS (3½" x 66½") to either side of quilt center, pressing seams toward outer borders.
9. Attach TOP & BOTTOM OUTER BORDERS (62½" x 3½") to top and bottom of quilt center, pressing seams toward outer borders.

Finished quilt top measures 62½" x 72½".

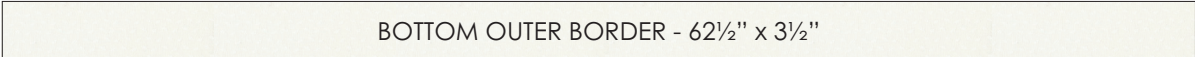

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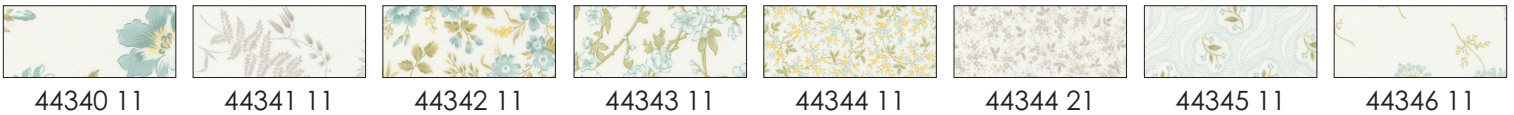
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FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1/3 YARD EACH - 9 ASSORTED BLUE, YELLOW, AND LIGHT GRAY FABRICS



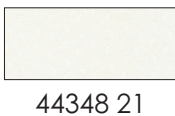
1/3 YARD EACH - 8 ASSORTED LOW-VOLUME FABRICS



1/8 YARD EACH - 3 DARK GRAY FABRICS



1 YARD - WHITE FABRIC FOR BORDERS



1/2 YARD - BINDING



4 YARDS - BACKING
