| C |  | 52948B-9 | 1/2 | FOR BINDING: (5) 2-1/4" $\times$ WOF strips |
| F |  | 53638B-3 | 1/4 | (4) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew short ends together and cut (2) 1-1/2" $\times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) 1-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |

## MAKING THE OUILT

1. Lay out A 9-1/2" squares into (6) rows of (5) squares each, noting orientation of each square and using the Quilt Layouts on p. 2 and 3 for inspiration. Sew the squares into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt center.
2. Sew E $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew E $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 49-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom.
3. Sew $\mathbf{D} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew $\mathbf{D} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom.
4. Sew B 3-1/2" $\times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew B 3-1/2" $\times 57-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom.

## FINISHING

Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using C 2-1/4" strips.

## MAKING THE RUNNER

1. Lay out A $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares into (1) row of (6) squares, noting orientation of each square and using the Runner Layouts below for inspiration. Sew the squares into a row.
2. Sew F $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to short sides of the runner center. Sew F $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the long sides.
3. Sew B 2-1/2" $\times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to short sides of the runner. Sew B 2-1/2" $\times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the long sides.

## FINISHING

Layer runner top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using C 2-1/4" strips.
