
**Optional:** Embroidery floss to match fabric **L**.

For turned under edge appliqué: freezer paper or other template paper.

For raw edge appliqué: paper backed fusible webbing.

### FLOWER BLOCK/For Turned Edge Appliqué:


- 1. Arrange (6) **G** Petals alternating with (6) **I** Petals as shown. Sew (2) Petals together using an exact 1/4" seam, along the long straight edges, beginning the stitching at the corner of the seamline.
- 2. Join (12) Petals to form a ring in the same manner. Press under the seam allowance along the outer straight edges of the petals.






#### FLOWER BLOCK/For Raw Edge Appliqué:

- **4.** Arrange (6) **G** Petals alternating with (6) **I** Petals as shown. Fuse narrow strips of paper backed fusible web to the short outer edges. Sew (2) Petals together, using an exact 1/4" seam, along the long straight edges.
- 5. Join (12) Petals to form a ring unit.
- **6.** Prepare **A** center with paper-backed fusible web. Make (8).



### For Both Appliqué Methods:

- 7. Sew (1) C 5-1/2" square to upper edge of (1) K 5-1/2" square to make (1) C/K Unit A. Sew (1) C 5-1/2" square to lower edge of (1) K 5-1/2" square to make (1) C/K Unit B. Make (8) each.
- 8. Sew (1) C/K Unit A to (1) C/K Unit B to make a C/K square, matching seam in center. Make (8).
- **9.** Pin or fuse (1) petal ring unit centered on (1) **C/K** square, noting position of petals. Sew the outer edges in place using your preferred method. Make (4) of each orientation.
- **10.** Pin or fuse the prepared **A** Center on the petal ring. Sew along the outer edge using your preferred method. Make (4) of each orientation.






#### **BUTTERFLY BLOCK**


- Sew (1) F 5-1/2" square to lower edge of (1) K 5-1/2" square to make (1) F/K Unit A. Sew (1) F 5-1/2" square to upper edge of (1) K 5-1/2" square to make (1) C/K Unit B. Make (8) each.
- **12.** Sew (1) **F/K** Unit A to (1) **F/K** Unit B to make a **F/K** square, matching seam in center. Make (8).
- **13**. Trace the butterfly placement pattern to (1) **F/K** square at an angle so butterflies are about 1-1/4" from side edges and about 1" from top and bottom edges. Make (8).






- 14. Using your preferred method of appliqué, prepare (1) **G** fore wing and (1) **G** fore wing reversed, (1) **I** fore wing and (1) **I** fore wing reversed, (1) **D** hind wing and (1) **D** hind wing reversed, (1) **E** hind wing and (1) **E** hind wing reversed and (2) **L** bodies.
- 15. Pin or fuse the **D** and **E** hind wings in place. Sew in place along the edges.
- **16.** Pin or fuse the **G** and **I** fore wings in place. Sew in place along the edges.
- 17. Pin or fuse the **L** bodies in place. Sew in place along the edge. Embroider the antennae using matching thread or embroidery floss.









18. Following steps 14-17, make butterfly blocks using the fabrics indicated. Make (2) each.

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**


- **19.** Following the Quilt Layout on page 6, arrange the flower blocks alternating with the butterfly blocks. Sew together (5) **J** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips alternating with (4) blocks to make (1) block row. Make (4).
- **20.** Sew together (5) **H** 1-1/2" squares alternating with (4) **J** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips to make (1) sashing row. Make (5).
- **21.** Sew together (5) sashing rows alternating with (4) block rows.
- **22.** Sew (1) **B** 3" x 45-1/2" borders to each side of quilt. Sew (2) **B** 3" x 50-1/2 borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- **23.** Sew (1) **H** 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) **J** 1-1/2" squares to ends of (2) **H** 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders. Sew to the top and bottom of quilt.






**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **F** 2-1/4" strips.
