Midnight Garden

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5" x 40-1/2" butterfly stripe borders

Fabric B - Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (2) 4" squares Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (3) 9-7/8" strips, subcut (9) 9-7/8" squares and (4) 5" squares Cut (2) 5" strips, subcut (16) 5" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (2) 4" squares and (2) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips

Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric E - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 9-7/8" squares

Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 6-1/2" square and (2) 5" squares

Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares

Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (2) 3" x 40-1/2" borders

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders

Fabric F - Cut (2) 9-7/8" strips, subcut (5) 9-7/8" squares, (2) 5" squares, and (2) 4" squares Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares

Fabric G - Cut (2) 9-7/8" strips, subcut (5) 9-7/8" squares

Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares Cut (3) 4" strips, subcut (28) 4" squares

Fabric H - Cut (2) 9-7/8" strips, subcut (5) 9-7/8" squares and (6) 4" squares Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (20) 4" squares

Fabric I - Cut (5) 4" strips, subcut (48) 4" squares

Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares and (1) 2-1/2" x 10" strip

Cut (7) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 69-1/2" borders

Cut (3) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 50-1/2" borders

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 2-1/2" x 10" strip and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders

Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

2. Piecing Order:

1. On the wrong side of all Fabrics B, D, and I and 2 Fabric H 4" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Arrange a marked **Fabric D** 4" square right sides together with a **Fabric F** 4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 3-1/2" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 1a.

Repeat 2 times for 4 units.

3. In the same manner, make 4 each Units 1b and 1c and 48 each Units 1d and 1e with fabrics indicated.

4. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabric I** 3-1/2" squares and Fabrics C, E, F, G, and H 5" squares.



5. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric I** 3-1/2" squares on opposite corners of the **Fabric E** 6-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners to complete Unit 2 (6-1/2" square unfinished).










Unit 2 - Make 1


6. Arrange 1 each Units 1b and 1c on opposite sides of Unit 2. Stitch into vertical rows and sew to sides of Unit 2. Arrange 2 Unit 1a and 1 each Units 1b and 1c in horizontal rows above and below



Block 1 - Make 1

Unit 2. Stitch into rows. Sew rows to top and bottom of Unit 2 to complete **Block 1** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

7. Arrange 1 Fabric B 3-1/2" square and 4 each Units 1d and 1e in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 12 Block 2 (9-1/2" square unfinished).

8. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric F** 5" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric C** 9-7/8" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Make a total of 5 Unit 3a (9-7/8" square unfinished).

9. In the same manner, make the number of Units 3b-3e listed with fabrics indicated.

10. On the wrong side of all Units 3a, 3c, and 3e, draw a







diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.

11. Arrange a marked Unit 3a right sides together on a Unit 3b, aligning seam allowances, with seams all parallel. Stitch along the two outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open (2) **Block 3a**). Make a total of 10 **Block 3a** (9-1/2" square unfinished).









Repeat 5 times for 10 units.

12. In the same manner, make 8 Block 3b (with Units 3c and 3d) and 10 Block 3c (with Units 3e and 3f) with the units indicated.









Repeat 4 times for 8 units.

NOTE: Only 9 Block 3a and Block 3c will be used in the quilt. Remaining blocks can be used to make a pillow.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.


- 13. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of strips, blocks, and borders.
- 14. Sew **Fabric I** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips to right and left sides of **Block 1**. Add **Fabric I** 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips to top and bottom of **Block 1** (14-1/2" square unfinished).
- 15. Sew **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips to right and left sides of bordered **Block 1**. Add **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips to top and bottom of bordered **Block 1** (18-1/2" square unfinished).
- 16. Arrange 2 **Block 2** in vertical rows on opposite sides of bordered **Block 1**. Stitch into side borders (9-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished). Sew to opposite sides of bordered **Block 1**.
- 17. Arrange 4 **Block 2** in horizontal rows above and below bordered **Block 1**. Stitch into top and bottom borders (9-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of bordered **Block 1**. Quilt center measures 36-1/2" square (unfinished).
- 18. Sew **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric E** 3" x 40-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

- 19. Sew **Fabric A** 5" x 40-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 20. Sew **Fabric I** 3" x 50-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric I** 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 21. Arrange 2 each **Blocks 3a**, **3b**, and **3c** in vertical rows on opposite sides of quilt. Stitch into side borders (9-1/2" x 54-1/2" unfinished). Sew to opposite sides of quilt.
- 22. Arrange 3 **Block 3a**, 2 **Block 3b**, and 2 **Block 3c** in horizontal row above quilt. Arrange 3 **Block 3c**, 2 **Block 3a**, and 2 **Block 3b** in horizontal row below quilt. Stitch into top and bottom borders (9-1/2" x 63-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- 23. Sew **Fabric I** 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric I** 3-1/2" x 69-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 24. The quilt measures approximately 69-1/2" x 78-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 25. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!
