## FLOWER BLOCK

1. Blue Flower Unit: Sew (2) A 1-1/4" $\times 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides of (1) B 4 " tile square, as shown.
2. Leaf Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place square, right sides together (RST), at the top right corner of (1) $\mathbf{L} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal $\mathbf{A}$ corner triangle. Repeat with another $\mathbf{A}$ square at the bottom left corner of the same $\mathbf{L}$ rectangle to make a leaf unit. Repeat to make a mirror-imaged leaf unit, noting seam orientation.
3. Sew (1) A $1^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top, and (1) $\mathbf{A} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the bottom of sewn leaf unit from Step 2.
For the mirror-imaged unit, sew (1) A 1-1/2" $\times 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top of mirror-imaged unit, and (1) A $1^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the bottom.
4. Sew Leaf Units to the opposite sides of (1) $\mathbf{L} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to complete stem and leaf unit.
5. Sew Flower Unit to the top of Step 4 unit. Add (2) $\mathbf{A} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides to complete a Flower Block. Make (4).

6. Make a total number of Flower Blocks, pairing fabric B tile square with the indicated leaf print fabric, as shown:


## CHAIN BLOCKS

7. Sew (2) $\mathbf{A} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides of (1) $\mathbf{F} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to make a row unit.
8. Sew (2) F 1-1/2" squares to the opposite sides of (1) A 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make a row unit. Make (2).
9. Sew together row units from Steps 7 and 8 .
10. Sew (2) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides of Step 9 unit.
11. Sew (2) F 1-1/2" squares to the opposite sides of (1) A 1-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles row units. Make (2).

12. Sew together row units from Steps 10 and 11 to complete (1) Chain Block. Make (3).

13. Sew a total of (3) Chain Blocks for each of the following prints:


## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

REFER TO QUILT IMAGE FOR BLOCK PLACEMENT GUIDE.
14. Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew together (5) alternating Flower and Chain Blocks. Make (5). Row 1 is shown.

Rows 1, 3, 5 - (3) Flower Blocks / (2) Chain Blocks
Row 2, 4 - (3) Chain Blocks / (2) Flower Blocks
15. Sew together Pieced Rows to complete quilt center.


## BORDERS

16. Inner Border 1: Sew (2) A $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) A 2-1/2" $\times 34-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
17. Inner Border 2: Sew (2) E $2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 37-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
18. Inner Border 3: Sew (2) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) A 1-1/2" $\times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
19. Outer Border: Sew (2) $\mathbf{C} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) C $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to finish.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using J 2-1/4" strips.
