Please read all instructions before beginning the project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please note that prewashing can shrink your fabric. Always verify after washing and drying that there is still 42" of usable width available. Shrinkage can affect the size of panel motifs and fussy cutting sizes may need to be adjusted.

Please check our website for any revisions before starting this project, www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with RST unless otherwise stated. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as noted in each step for best results. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless otherwise stated.

Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together SNF = Stitch and Flip

10" Square C14644-ORANGE Text Toss

1/4 Yard C14641-FOREST Smokey Toss

1/4 Yard C14642-FOREST Tree Stripe

% Yard C14645-FOREST Plaid

½ Yard C14644-BROWN Text Toss

% Yard C650-CREAM on Cream Dapple Dot

3/4 Yard C14644-CADET Text Toss

½ Yard C14645-BROWN Plaid (binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

1 % Yards Yards Wide Back backing fabric (suggested WB605-CHOCOLATE Shabby) Basic Sewing Supplies Batting (68" × 75")

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics and label all cuts as noted.



Smokey Bear Panel

Fussy cut (1) Panel 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", centered over the motif.



Orange Text Toss

Cut (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.



Forest Smokey Toss

Cut (2) 2 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as B.
- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as C.
- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as D.
- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as E.



Forest Tree Stripe

Cut (2) 2 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as F.
- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as G.
- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as H.
- (2) 2 %" × 4 %" rectangles. Label as I.



Forest Plaid

Cut (4) 3" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $3" \times 42 \%"$ strips. Label as J.
- (2) $3" \times 35 \%"$ strips. Label as K.



Brown Text Toss

Cut (4) 4" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $4" \times 42 \%"$ strips. Label as L.
- (2) $4" \times 35 \%"$ strips. Label as M.



Cream-on-Cream Dapple Dot

Cut (6) 2 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

- (8) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as N.
- (8) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as O.
- (8) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as P.
- (40) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as Q.

Cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips; subcut:

- (8) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as R.
- (8) 1 %" × 2 %" rectangles. Label as S.



Cadet Text Toss

Cut (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as T.
- (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $35 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as U.



Brown Plaid

Cut (7) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips for binding.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

General sewing techniques used in this pattern are shown below. These methods are referenced throughout the pattern in their abbreviated form.

STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance above the sewn line to ¼". Flip the small piece away from the bottom piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY


1. Using the SNF method, attach (2) Q squares to the top corners of (1) E rectangle. The unit should measure 2 %" $\times 4 \%$ ".




2. Sew (2) O rectangles and (1) Step 1 unit together as shown. The Row 1 unit for Block 1 should measure $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $12 \frac{1}{2}$ ".




3. Repeat steps 1-2 to make Rows 2, 3, and 4 for Block 1 using the pieces as shown below. Arrange the rows from top to bottom in numerical order. Sew the rows together to make (1) Block 1 Tree Unit that should measure 8 ½" x 12 ½".



4. Sew (2) N rectangles and (1) A square together as shown. The Trunk Unit should measure 2 %" × 12 %".



5. Sew (2) R rectangles, (1) Block 1 Tree Unit, and (1) Trunk Unit together as shown. Block 1 should measure 12 %" × 12 %".




6. Repeat steps 1-5 to make a second Block 1.






7. Repeat steps 1-5 using the pieces as shown below to make a total of (2) Block 2 that should measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ ".




QUILT ASSEMBLY

8. Sew (1) U strip, (1) K strip, and (1) M strip together as shown. Repeat to make a total of (2) Top/Bottom Borders that each should measure 12 ½" × 35 ½".



9. Sew (1) T strip, (1) J strip, and (1) L strip together as shown. Repeat to make a total of (2) Side Borders that each should measure 12 ½" × 42 ½".



10. Arrange (2) Block 1, (2) Top/Bottom Borders, (2) Block 2, (2) Side Borders, and (1) Smokey Bear Panel as shown. Sew the blocks, borders, and panel together in rows. Press. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt top. The quilt top should measure 59 ½" × 66 ½".

QUILT LAYOUT DIAGRAM

FINISHING

Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the Brown Plaid binding strips.
