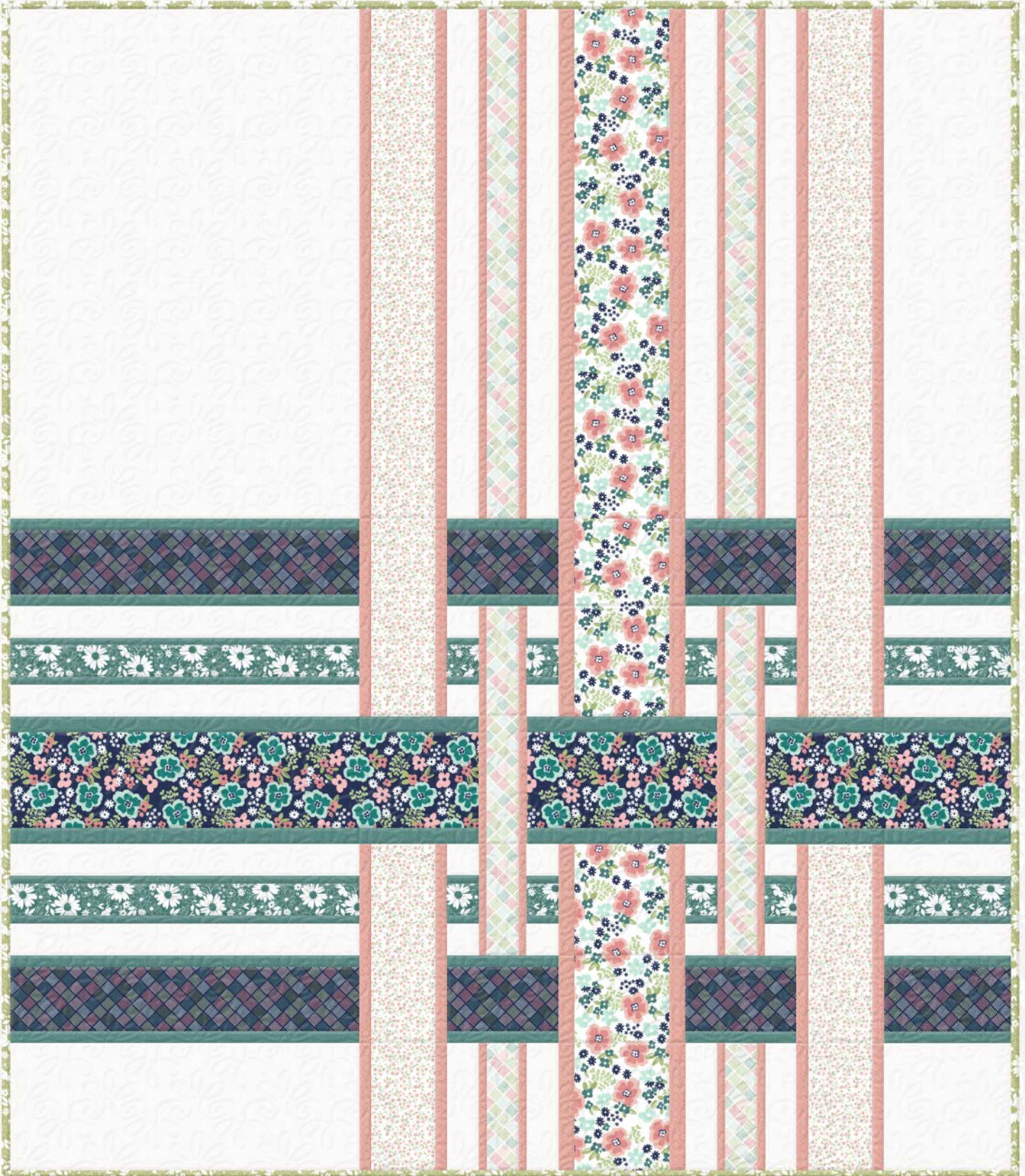


Juliette by Angela Nickeas



Throw Quilt 63" x 73"



Juliette

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (4) 4-1/2" strips

Fabric B - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips

Fabric C - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips

Fabric E - Cut (3) 4-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips

Cut (8) 1-1/4" strips

Cut (8) 1" strips

Fabric G - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric H - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips

Fabric I - Cut (1) 32-1/2" strip, subcut
(1) 22-1/2" x 32-1/2", (1) 8-1/2" x 32-1/2", and
(4) 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" pieces

Cut (1) 8-1/2" strip, subcut

(1) 8-1/2" x 22-1/2", (1) 8-1/2" x 8-1/2", and

(4) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces

Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips

Fabric J - Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips

Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips

Cut (4) 1" strips

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabric F**

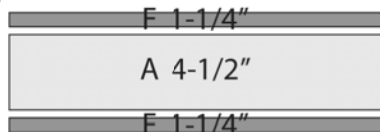
1-1/4" strips to long

sides of a **Fabric A**

4-1/2" strip. Make

a total of 4 **A/F** panels

(6" wide unfinished). From these panels, cut (2) 32-1/2", (2) 21", and (2) 13" long units.



Make 4 A/F panels

2. Stitch **Fabric J**

1-1/2" strips to long

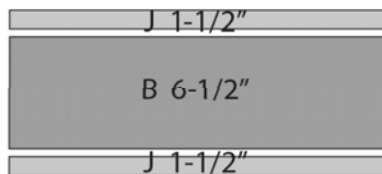
sides of a **Fabric B**

6-1/2" strip. Make

a total of 2 **B/J**

panels (8-1/2" wide

unfinished). From these panels, cut (1) 30", (1) 16", and (1) 12-1/2" long units.



Make 2 B/J panels

3. Stitch **Fabric F**

1-1/2" strips to long

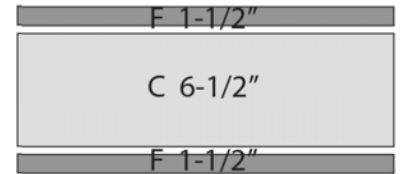
sides of a **Fabric C**

6-1/2" strip. Make

a total of 2 **C/F**

panels (8-1/2" wide

unfinished). From these panels, cut (1) 32-1/2", (1) 21", and (1) 13" long units.



Make 2 C/F panels

4. Stitch **Fabric F**

1" strips to long

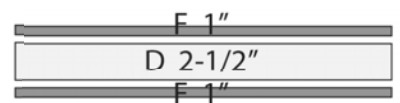
sides of a **Fabric D**

2-1/2" strip. Make

a total of 4 **D/F**

panels (3-1/2" wide unfinished). From these

panels, cut (2) 32-1/2", (4) 8-1/2", and (4) 7-1/2" long units.



Make 4 D/F panels

5. Stitch **Fabric J**

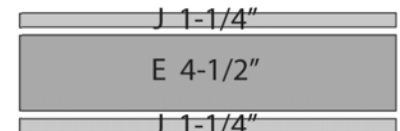
1-1/4" strips to long

sides of a **Fabric E**

4-1/2" strip. Make

a total of 3 **E/J** panels

(6" wide unfinished). From these panels, cut (2) 22-1/2", (2) 8-1/2", and (4) 7-1/2" long units.



Make 3 E/J panels

6. Stitch **Fabric J**

1" strips to long

sides of a **Fabric H**

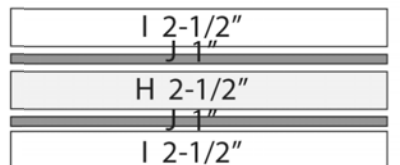
2-1/2" strip. Add

2-1/2" **Fabric I**

strips to each

side. Make a total of 2 **I/H/J** panels (7-1/2"

wide unfinished). From these panels, cut (2) 22-1/2", (2) 8-1/2", and (8) 2-1/2" long units.

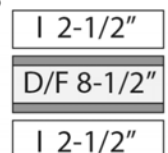


Make 2 I/H/J panels

7. Sew **Fabric I** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips to long sides of a 3-1/2" x 8-1/2"

D/F unit. Make 2 **Block 1**

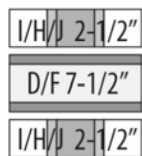
(7-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished).



Make 2 Block 1

8. Sew **I/H/J** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" units to long sides of a 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" **D/F** unit. Make 4 **Block 2** (7-1/2" square unfinished).



Make 4 Block 2

9. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of units, blocks, and **Fabric I** pieces.

10. Arrange the **Fabric I** 22-1/2" x 32-1/2", 8-1/2" x 32-1/2", and 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" pieces, 2 **A/F** 6" x 32-1/2" units, 2 **D/F** 3-1/2" x 32-1/2" units, and the **C/F** 8-1/2" x 32-1/2" unit in a row. Stitch together to complete Section 1 (32-1/2" x 63-1/2" unfinished).

11. Arrange blocks and units as shown in Section 2. Sew each **E/J** 6" x 7-1/2" unit to a **Block 2**. Stitch each **E/J** 6-1/2" x 22-1/2" unit to the **I/H/J** 7-1/2" x 22-1/2" unit. Repeat with the **E/J** and **I/H/J** 8-1/2" long units. Stitch together with **A/F** and **C/F** 13" long units to complete Section 2 (13" x 63-1/2" unfinished).

12. Arrange the **B/J** 30", 12-1/2", and 16" long units and 2 **D/F** 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" units in a row. Stitch together to complete Section 3 (8-1/2" x 63-1/2" unfinished).

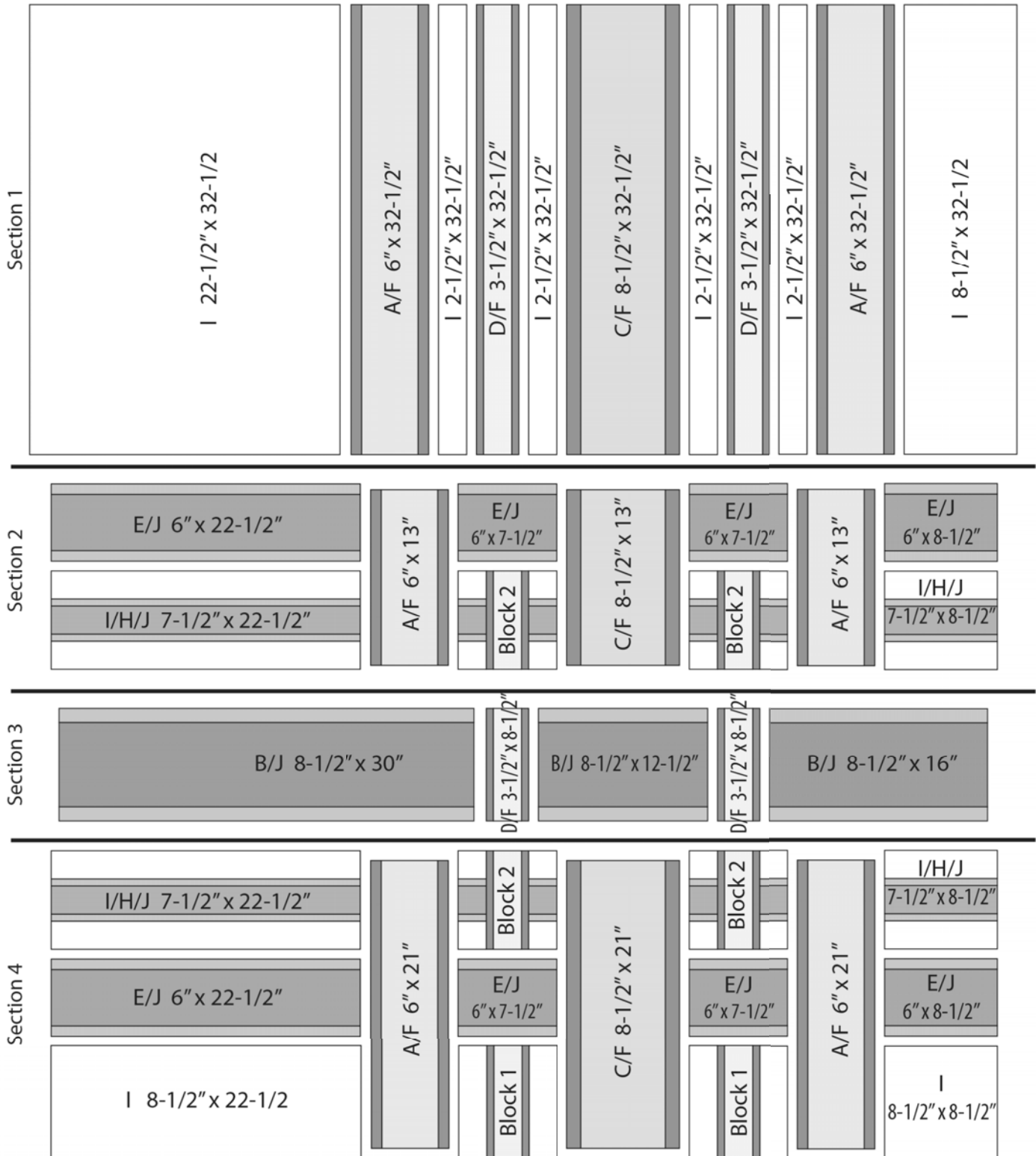
13. Arrange blocks, units, and **Fabric I** pieces as shown in Section 4. Sew the **E/J** 22-1/2" long unit between the same length **I/H/J** unit and the **Fabric I** 8-1/2" x 22-1/2" piece. Repeat with the 8-1/2" long **E/J** and **I/H/J** units and **Fabric I** square. Stitch each **E/J** 6-1/2" x 7-1/2" unit between a **Block 1** and **Block 2**. Stitch together with **A/F** and **C/F** 21" long units to complete Section 4 (21" x 63-1/2" unfinished).

14. The quilt measures approximately 63-1/2" x 73-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

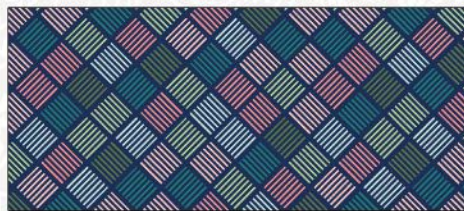
