## Ribbon Flowers Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is $1 / 4$. Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1.

## Cut-away Corner Units

## Green CAC Units

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the E and F squares.
2. Place an F8-F square RST over the F7-D square. Sew on the marked line. Cut $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the stitching. Press. Make 24.
3. Repeat step 2 with F2-E squares and F4-C squares. Make 48.
4. Repeat step 2 with F2-E squares and F1-A squares. Make 24.

5. Lay out your cut-away corner squares as shown to the right.
6. Sew a F7 unit to a F4 unit. Press.
7. Sew a F4 unit to a F1 unit, paying close attention to the orientation. Press.
8. Sew these two pairs of squares together. Press. Make 24 Blue Corner units.

## Orange CAC Units

9. Repeat step 2 with F3-E squares and F5-C squares. Make 48.
10. Repeat step 2 with F9-F squares and F6-D squares. Make 24.
11. Repeat step 2 with F3-E squares and F1-A squares. Make 24.

## Short Stripe Unit

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the B squares.
2. Place a F2-B square RST over the top left corner of a F10 square, making sure the stripe is vertical. Sew on the marked line. Cut $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the stitching. Press.
3. Place a F3-B square RST over the top right corner of the F10 square. Sew on the marked line. Cut $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the stitching. Press.


F2-B - F3-B, F10-Square


Make 24

Tall Stripe Unit

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the $B$ squares.
2. Place a F3-B square RST over the top left corner of a F10 rectangle, making sure the stripe is vertical. Sew on the marked line. Cut $1 / 4$ " away from the stitching. Press.
3. Place another F3-B square RST over the bottom right corner of the F10 rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Cut $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the stitching. Press.
4. Place a F2-B square RST over the top right corner of the F10 rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Cut $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the stitching. Press.
5. Place another F2-B square RST over the bottom left corner of the F10 rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Cut $1 / 4$ " away from the stitching. Press.
6. Make 12 tall stripe units.


Upper: F3-B - F2-B F10-Rectangle Lower: F2-B - F3-B


## Quilt Blocks

1. Lay the units out into a row as illustrated to the right. Sew together. Press. Make 24
2. Sew a step 1 row to the left and right of a tall stripe unit. Press. Make 12.

Quilt Top Rows (facing page)

1. Lay out the quilt blocks as shown on p.7. Press in one direction. Make (2) Row As and (2) Row Bs.
