Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 62" white stripe borders, (2) 5-1/2" x 58" white stripe borders, and (2) 3" x 29-1/2" gingerbread on black stripe borders

Fabric B - Cut (3) 5" strips, subcut (17) 5" squares, (4) 3-1/4" squares, and (6) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (12) 2-3/4" squares Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (2) 5" squares, (4) 3-1/4" squares, and (2) 2-3/4" squares Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (30) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric D - Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (20) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric E - Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 3-1/4" square and (10) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric F - Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (4) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Fabric G - Cut (3) 5" strips, subcut (19) 5" squares, (4) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces, and (2) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (5) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 2-3/4" x 7-1/4" pieces, (24) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces, and (8) 2-3/4" squares Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 29-1/2" borders and (2) 1-1/2" x 27-1/2" borders **Fabric I** - Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (9) 3-1/4" squares

Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (4) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces and (20) 2-3/4" squares Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (4) 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 34-1/2" borders
Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabrics C**, **D** and **I** 2-3/4" squares and all **Fabrics B** 2-1/2" squares. in the same manner, mark **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares only as shown.





2. On the wrong side of all **Fabric I** 3-1/4" squares and all **Fabric G** 5" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line. Mark **Fabric G** 5" squares only as shown.





3. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 3-1/4" square right sides together with a **Fabric E** 3-1/4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 2-3/4" square. Make a total of 2 Unit 1a.









Do once for 2 units.

4. In the same manner, make 8 Unit 1b and 8 Units 1c with fabrics indicated.

5. In the same manner, make 4 Unit 2a with a marked **Fabric G** 5" square right sides together with a **Fabric C** 5" square. Centering seam, trim to 4-1/2" square (unfinished). In the same manner, make 34 Unit 2b with fabrics indicated.

Repeat 2 times for 4 units.

6. Arrange a marked **Fabric D** 2-3/4" square on 1 end of a **Fabric H** 2-3/4" x 5" piece as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on opposite side of the **Fabric H** piece with a marked Fabric I 2-3/4" square. Make a total of 10 Unit 3a (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished). In the same manner, make 10 Unit 3b and 4 each Unit 3c-3f with fabrics indicated.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.





















7. Arrange 2 Unit 1a and 2 **Fabric E** 2-3/4" squares in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 1 Unit 4a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 4b with fabrics and units indicated.






8. Arrange 1 Unit 4a, 2 each Unit 3a and 3b and 4 **Fabric B** 2-3/4" squares in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 1a** (9-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Block 1b with fabrics and units indicated.



9. Arrange 1 each Units 3c-3f, 2 Unit 1c and 2 Fabric H 2-3/4" x 7-1/4" pieces into 3 vertical rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 2** (9-1/2" square unfinished).


10. Arrange a marked Fabric B 2-1/2" square right sides together on the Fabric G side of a Unit 2a. Stitch along line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner open. Make a total of 4 **Block 3a** (4-1/2" square unfinished.

11. Arrange 1 each marked Fabrics G and B 2-1/2" square on corners of a Unit 2b as shown. Stitch along lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners open. Make a total of 34 Block 3b (4-1/2" square unfinished).



- 12. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 13. Arrange Blocks 1a, 1b and 2 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (27-1/2" square unfinished).
- 14. Sew **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 27-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 29-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 15. Sew Fabric A 3"x 29-1/2" borders to top and bottom.
- 16. Sew **Fabric I** 2" x 34-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add Fabric I 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 17. Arrange 9 **Block 3b** in vertical rows on right and left sides of quilt. Stitch into side borders (4-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished). Sew to right and left sides of quilt.
- 18. Arrange 8 Block 3b and 2 Block 3a above and below quilt. Stitch into top/bottom borders (4-1/2" x 40-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- 19. Sew **Fabric I** 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add Fabric I 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.


20. Center Fabric A 5-1/2" x 62" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and Fabric A 5-1/2" x 58" borders on top and bottom of quilt center, referring to quilt image for positioning of stripe. Stitch 1/4" borders to sides starting detail and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Α Do not trim. Press


21. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 22. The quilt measures approximately 54-1/2" x 58-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric J) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 23. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric I) and enjoy!!


