

Cutting

Fabric 1 Grey Dots Cut pieces in the following order. See cutting guide on this page: Cut (1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip into: (1) 6-1/2" x 8" rectangle (2) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles (1) 6-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle (4) 3" squares (4) 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip into: (5) 2-1/2" squares (1) 2" x 8" rectangle (2) 2" squares Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips into: (2) 2" x 18-1/2" borders Sew three strips together, end to end. Subcut into: (2) 2" x 45-1/2" borders

Fabric 2 Orange tonal

(2) 8" x 12-1/2["] rectangles (16) 2" squares

Fabric 3 Black small print

(2) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles (8) 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles (2) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 4 Black tossed print

(1) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangle (1) 2" x 12-1/2" rectangle (1) 6-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle

Fabric 5 Black tonal

(4) 2-1/2" squares
(2) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
(1) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle
(1) 2" x 8" rectangle
(1) 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle
Cut (4) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.

Meowloween Runner Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Fabric is abbreviated as by number. For example, Fabric 1 is 'F1'.

Make the Pumpkin Blocks

1. Sew an F1 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to either side of an F3 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Press. Make 2

2. Mark a diagonal line on four F1 2-1/2" squares.

3. Place an F1 2-1/2" square, RST, on the top left corner of an F3 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle and sew on the diagonal line. Trim, leaving 1/4". Press toward F1.

4. Repeat step 3 on the opposite corner of the Step 3 unit. Make 2.

5. Place an F1 3" square, RST, on the lower left corner of an F2 8" x 12-1/2" rectangle and sew on the diagonal line. Trim leaving 1/4". Press toward F1.

6. Repeat on the opposite corner of the F2 rectangle. Make 2.


7. Mark a diagonal line on the F2 2" squares.

8. Place an F2 2" square, RST, on the left side of an F3 rectangle and sew on the diagonal line. Trim, leaving 1/4". Press toward F2.

9. Repeat on the opposite corner of the step 8 unit. Make 8.

10. Sew 4 Step 9 units together. Press. Make 2.

11. Lay the pumpkin sections out as illustrated to the right. Sew together. Press seams open. Make 2.





Make the Cat Blocks.

1. Mark a diagonal line on the F5 2-1/2" squares.

2. Place an F5 2-1/2" square, RST, on the left side of an F1 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle and sew on the diagonal line. Trim, leaving 1/4". Press toward F5.

3. Repeat on the opposite side of the Step 2 unit. Make 2 Ears units.

4. Sew the Ears units to the top of an F5 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle. Press.

5. Sew an F1 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the left side of one Cat Head. Press.

6. Sew an F4 2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of the other Cat Head. Then sew an F1 6-1/2" x 8" rectangle to the left side. Press.

Cat Block Left

7. Mark a diagonal line on the F1 2-1/2" square.

8. Place the F1 2-1/2" square, right sides together, on the upper left corner of the F5 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle and sew on the diagonal line. Trim, leaving 1/4". Press toward F5.

9. Lay the Cat Block Left sections out as illustrated to the right. Sew together. Press seams open. Make 1.



Ears: Make 2 2-1/2" x 6-1/2"

Cat Blocks (Continued)

Cat Block Right

1. Mark a diagonal line on the F1 2" squares.

2. Place an F1 2" square, RST, on the left side of an F5 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle and sew on the diagonal line. Trim, leaving 1/4". Press toward F1.

3. Repeat on the opposite side of the Step 2 unit. Make 1.

4. Sew the F1 2" x 8" rectangle to the F5 2" x 8" rectangle. Press toward F5.

5. Sew the Step 3 unit to the top of the F1/ F5 unit, making sure that F5 is on the right side. Press down. This is the cat's tail.

6. Sew the cat's tail section to the right side of the F4 6-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle. Press toward F4.

7. Sew the remaining cat's head to the step 6 unit. Press up. Make 1.




Top Assembly

- 1. Lay the blocks out as illustrated below.
- 2. Sew the F1 2" x 45-1/2" sashing to the top and bottom of the blocks. Press toward F1.
- 3. Sew the F1 2" x 18-1/2" side sashing to the sides of the runner top. Press toward F1.











Pumpkin Block

Finishing

1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and runner top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.

2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the runner top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the runner and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
