Patch of Sunshine

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

- Fabric A** - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" and (1) 4-1/2" squares
Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (9) 4-1/2" squares
- Fabric B** - Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (10) 4-1/2" and (4) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 2-1/2" squares
- Fabric C** - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares
- Fabric D** - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" squares. From remainder of strip, cut (2) 2" x 18" strips, subcut (16) 2" squares
Cut (5) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (4) 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders
- Fabric E** - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (64) 2-1/2" squares
- Fabric F** - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" and (4) 5" squares
- Fabric G** - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (80) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 22-1/2" borders
- Fabric H** - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut from each strip (1) 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" and (1) 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" borders for a total of 2 each length border
- Fabric I** - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" squares. From remainder of strip, cut (2) 2-1/2" x 22" strips, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares
- Fabric J** - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" borders

Fabric K - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares

Fabric L - Cut (5) 2" strips, subcut (16) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces and (64) 2" squares

Fabric M - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" and (8) 2-1/2" squares and (1) 2" x 3-1/2" piece

Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" x 9-1/2" pieces
Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (63) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders

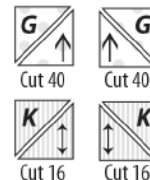
2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabrics A** and **F** 5" squares and **Fabrics C, D, I, and L** 2" squares.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 40 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares and a diagonal line in the opposite direction on 40 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares. Do the same with 16 each **Fabric K** 2" squares

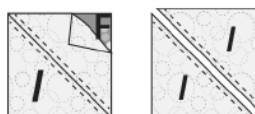


Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

3. On the wrong side of all **Fabrics I** and **M** 5-1/2" and all **Fabrics E** and **J** 2-1/2" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



4. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 5-1/2" square right sides together with a **Fabric F** 5-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 5" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 1a. In the same manner, make 4 Unit 1b with fabrics indicated.



Repeat 2 times for 4 units.



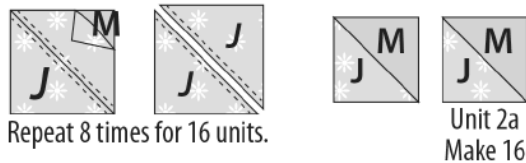

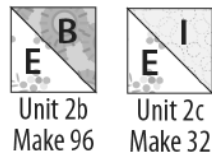

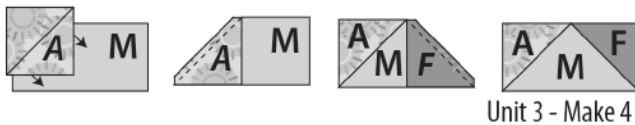
5. Arrange a marked **Fabric J** 2-1/2" square right sides together with a **Fabric M** 2-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 2" square. Make a total of 16 Unit 2a.



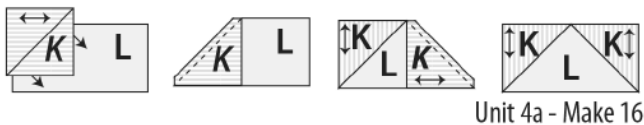
6. In the same manner, make 96 Unit 2b and 32 Unit 2c with fabrics indicated.



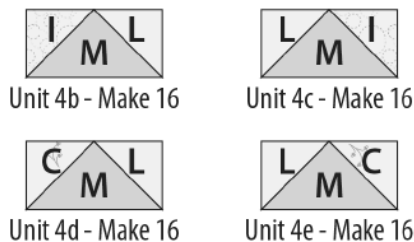
7. Arrange a marked **Fabric A** 5" square on an end of a **Fabric M** 5" x 9-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end with a marked **Fabric F** 5" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (5" x 9-1/2" unfinished).



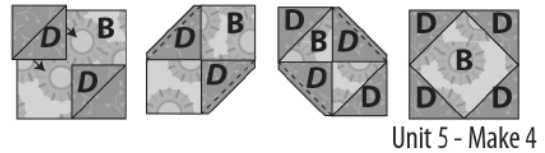
8. Arrange a marked **Fabric K** 2" square on an end of a **Fabric L** 2" x 3-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end. Make a total of 16 Unit 4a (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished). **NOTE: Refer to arrows for direction of Fabric K stripe when placing marked squares.**



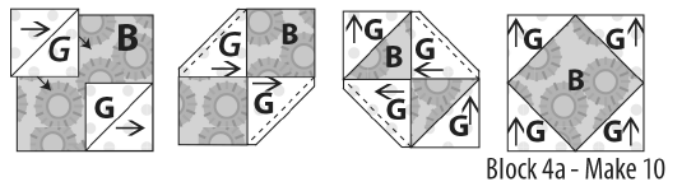
9. In the same manner, make 16 each Units 4b-4e with fabrics indicated.



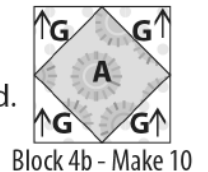
10. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric D** 2" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric B** 3-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 4 Unit 5 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



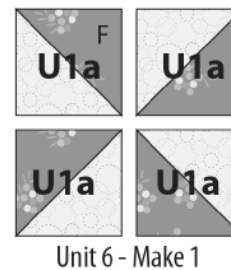
11. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric B** 4-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 10 **Block 4a** (4-1/2" square unfinished). **NOTE: Refer to arrows for direction of Fabric G print when placing marked squares.**



12. In the same manner, make 10 **Block 4b** with fabrics indicated.



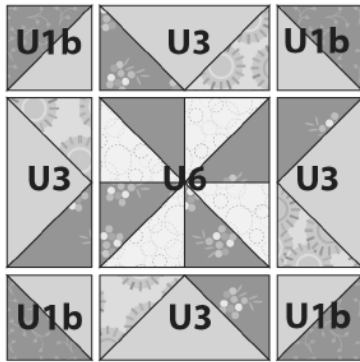
13. Arrange 4 Unit 1a in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Unit 6 (9-1/2" square unfinished).



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.*

14. Arrange 4 Unit 1b, 4 Unit 3, and Unit 6 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 1** (18-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 1

15. Arrange 4 Unit 2a, 4 Unit 4a, and 1 Unit 5 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 2** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



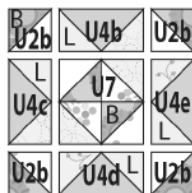
Block 2 - Make 4

16. Arrange 2 each Units 2b and 2c in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 16 Unit 7 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



Unit 7 - Make 16

17. Arrange 4 Unit 2b, 1 each Units 4b-4e, and 1 Unit 7 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 16 **Block 3** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 3 - Make 16

18. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

19. Sew **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" borders to right and left sides of **Block 1**. Add **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" borders to top and bottom of **Block 1** and side borders.

20. Sew **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x 22-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

21. Arrange 4 **Block 3** in vertical rows on right and left sides of quilt. Stitch blocks into side borders (6-1/2" x 24-1/2" unfinished). Stitch borders to right and left sides of quilt.

22. Arrange 2 **Block 2** and 4 **Block 3** in horizontal rows above and below quilt. Stitch blocks into top/bottom borders (6-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished). Stitch borders to top and bottom of quilt.

23. Sew **Fabric M** 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric M** 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

24. Arrange 5 each **Blocks 4a** and **4b** in horizontal rows above and below quilt. Stitch blocks into top/bottom borders (4-1/2" x 40-1/2" unfinished). Stitch borders to top and bottom of quilt.

25. Sew **Fabric J** 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric J** 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

26. Sew **Fabric D** 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric D** 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

27. The quilt measures approximately 50-1/2" x 58-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric N**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

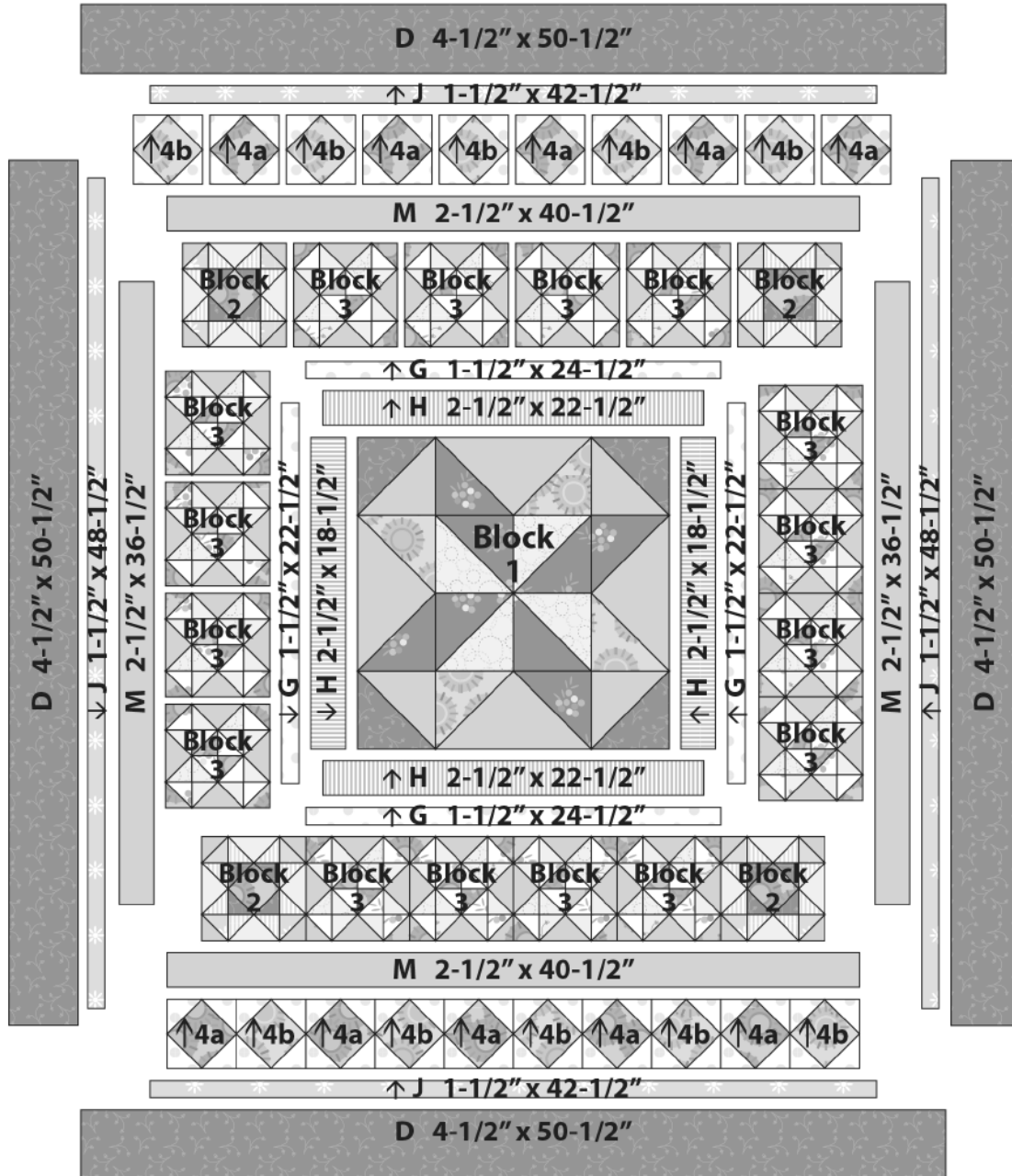
28. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!

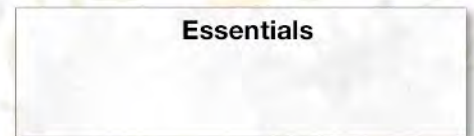

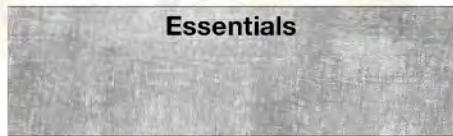
