
8 AT-A-TIME HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE CHEAT SHEET

This is a quick method for making half-square triangles (HSTs) when you need eight identical units. I like to make my half-square triangles a little bit larger and then trim them down to the exact size.

Use the table below to determine the size to cut your squares.

- Draw a diagonal lines on the wrong side of one square
- Place the square on top of another square, right sides together
- Sew ¼" on each side of each drawn line
- Cut the square into four equal quadrants
- Cut the quadrants apart on the drawn line
- Trim the HST units to the UNFINISHED size

All measurements are in inches
